Tonight's Game: The Sounds play game one of a six-game series against the Iowa Cubs tonight at First Horizon Park. It is the only time the long time American Association and Pacific Coast League rivals will meet in 2024. Nashville is coming off a series split with Memphis, while the I-Cubs took four out of six games from Omaha. DL Hall gets another start on rehab assignment from Milwaukee. He'll face right-hander Dan Straily at 6:35 p.m. central time in Hit City.

DL Hall: The 25-year-old left-hander will make his eighth start for the Sounds this season. He is 0-1 with a 1.98 ERA (13.2 IP/3 ER) and 10 strikeouts. He took the loss in his last outing on July 4 vs. Memphis. Hall did not allow any earned runs - all three of the Redbirds tallies came home thanks in part to a couple of errors in the infield. He threw 61 pitches and 38 strikes - his start was also cut short in part to a rain delay. Hall was notably traded to the Brewers in the offseason trade for Corbin Burnes. He made his MLB debut in late 2022 and made 29 appearances (one start) before the trade. He made four starts for the Brewers before being placed on the injured list on April 21 with a left knee sprain. The Valdosta, Georgia native was drafted 21st overall in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Orioles. He entered the 2024 season as the fifth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to Baseball America.

Dan Straily: The 35-year-old makes his 13th appearance and 12th start for Iowa. He is 1-4 with a 4.95 ERA (56.1 IP/31 ER) in his first season back in the Cubs organization. Straily got his first win of the season in his last start on July 2 at Omaha, holding the Storm Chasers scoreless through five innings. He struck out a season-high eight batters on 74 pitches (47 strikes). He signed with Chicago-NL on April 27 to a minor league contract, two days after initially signing a deal with the independent Long Island Ducks. Straily pitched for the Lotte Giants in the Korea Baseball Organization last season, finishing 3-5 with a 4.37 ERA - he was released on July 18, 2023. Straily has pitched in the Majors with Oakland (2012-14), Chicago-NL (2014), Houston (2015), Cincinnati (2016), Miami (2017-18) and Baltimore (2019). Straily has faced the Sounds once while with Fresno, then the affiliate of the Astros, on May 24, 2015. He got the win that day in California, working seven innings of three-run baseball with nine hits and six strikeouts. This is Straily's 16th season of professional baseball. He was originally selected by Oakland in the 24th round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of Marshall University.

Brewer Goes Bang: Outfielder Brewer Hicklen launched a two-run shot to take the game on Saturday night. It was his 16th homer of the season. Hicklen is tied for eighth (with 8 others) in home runs among International League leaders. HE also ranks fifth in slugging (.570), stolen bases (25) and sixth in OPS (.960).

McLovin It: Starter Evan McKendry took his second win in as many starts this month on Saturday. After bouncing between the bullpen and starting rotation after coming off the injured list in May, he has settled down in back-to-back starts, going 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA (10.2 IP/2 ER), nine strikeouts, a 1.03 WHIP and .184 opponent batting average. He's also had plenty success at First Horizon Park, boasting a 1.19 ERA (22.2 IP/3 ER), 0.79 WHIP and .157 opponent batting average at home.

Back in Black: Tyler Black stayed hot in the series against Memphis on Saturday, adding a pair of hits and RBI in the 4-1 win. Since being optioned by Milwaukee on June 30, Black is batting .400 (8-for-20) with five RBI, four walks, three hit by pitch and four runs scored.

Familiar Face: Former Sound Thomas Pannone is scheduled to start against Nashville on Friday night. Pannone made 11 appearances (9 starts) with Nashville last season, going 3-1 with a 2.70 ERA (53.1 IP/16 ER). He signed a minor league contract with the Cubs on December 14, 2023.

Hot Collins: Isaac Collins extended his hitting streak with a knock in the eighth inning on Friday night. The switch hitter is batting .344 (11-for-32) with five doubles, a homer, three RBI, four walks, three runs and a .447 on-base percentage since the streak began on June 27. Collins leads the league with 23 doubles and in the top 10 in the IL with 37 extra-base hits (3rd), a .398 on-base percentage (8th) and 51 runs scored (10th).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 727-626 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,319-2,146 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.
