The Baysox collected their second straight win over the Flying Squirrels in a 6-4 victory on Friday night. RHP Peter Van Loon made his season debut after being activated from the 60-day IL and threw 4.1 scoreless innings with six strikeouts. Bowie used three fielder's choices to plate home three of its six runs on the night. Jud Fabian drove in a pair of runs and TT Bowens swatted his ninth homer of the season. Cameron Weston finished out the game with a four-inning save.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B Samuel Basallo was selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game on Tuesday and will represent the Orioles at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX on Saturday, July 13. The Orioles No. 2 prospect is the 14th Baysox player in franchise history to be named to the All-Star Futures Game and is the first since Adley Rutschman was named in '21. The 19-year-old has reached base safely in 33 of his last 35 games dating back to May 21, including in his last 13 straight. After his team-leading 21st multi-hit game of the year on Thursday, Basallo is batting .340 with 5 HR and 13 RBI against Richmond this year.

ON-BASE BENCOSME

IF Frederick Bencosme has reached base in 19 consecutive games, which is a new career-best on-base streak and is tied for the second longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League. The Orioles No. 26 prospect is tied with Samuel Basallo for the longest on-base streak on the team this season.

WELCOME MATT

OF/1B Matthew Etzel was the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of So. Miss. The 22-year-old is slashing .278/.369/.813 in his first 21 games at Double-A, including his first two Double-A homers at Reading last week. His 37 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is ninth-most in all of MiLB.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF Jud Fabian is tied for second among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season. Amongst all Double-A players, his 13 homers is tied for ninthmost. The Orioles No. 11 prospect hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and hit five in June.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B Dylan Beavers has reached base in 57 of 68 games played in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 6 prospect is tied for the team-lead in OBP (.345) and leads the team in walks (39), tied for the 4th-most in the Eastern League.

SHOVING THE SHOVE

After recording a 4.28 ERA in May, Bowie's pitching staff recorded the seventh-lowest ERA in all of Double-A in June (3.51). The Baysox have recorded the most strikeouts in all of Double-A (803). The bullpen continues to take a large load as they have thrown the most innings in all of Double-A (390.0) with a respectable 3.72 ERA and the third-lowest WHIP in Double-A (1.19)

SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

The Richmond Flying Squirrels finished the first half in fourth in the Southwest Division with a record of 34-35. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants lost five of six to open the second half against Somerset but have won nine of 12 against Bowie in the season series. Richmond's active roster includes only three of the Giants' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Trevor McDonald (No. 12), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP John Michael Bertrand makes his 16th start of the season and his fourth against Bowie this season. The 26-year-old southpaw has dominated Bowie in three starts this season. In 20 innings thrown, he has allowed no runs and only three hits and four walks. Baysox hitters are batting just .051 against Bertrand. The former Notre Dame left-hander threw seven shutout innings against Bowie on Monday after previously throwing 13 no-hit innings in his first two starts against the Baysox.

The- "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión "M" or "Fun Cup" "M" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organizations Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain basebal team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia an New Zealand in 2011.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.
