Today's Game: Nashville takes on Memphis in game two of the six-game series at AutoZone Park. The Sounds ran away with a 15-2 win in six innings after a steady rain forced the contest to be called early. Evan McKendry will get the start and will face Michael McGreevy on the bump.
Evan McKendry: The 24-year-old makes his 11th start as a Sound and third of the season. He is the first Sounds pitcher to reach three starts in 2024 despite not getting the nod on Opening Day. McKendry enters the day tied for eighth in innings pitched in the league (along with 2023 Sound Thomas Pannone who now is with the I-Cubs). He worked the first quality start of the season for Nashville in his last outing on April 4 vs. St. Paul (6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 3 K). McKendry is holding right-handed batters to a .148 average (4-for-27) and .148 on-base percentage. He was originally selected by the Rays in the ninth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Miami.

Michael McGreevy: The 23-year-old prospect is also making his third start of the season. McGreevy, who was taken in the first round with the 18th pick of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft by the Cardinals, is $0-1$ with a 7.00 ERA (9.0 IP/7 ER) in the beginning of his second campaign with Memphis He took the loss on April 5 at Indianapolis, lasting 4.0 innings and giving up five runs (all earned) on eight hits and two walks with two strikeouts. McGreevy enters the day with the highest opponent batting average (.372) and hits per nine innings (16.00) among qualified pitchers in Triple-A. He made two starts against the Sounds in 2023 and went $0-1$ with a 9.00 ERA ( $11.0 \mathrm{IP} / 11 \mathrm{ER}$ ). He worked a quality start on July 1 in Memphis ( $6.0 \mathrm{IP}, 6 \mathrm{H}, 3 \mathrm{R}, 3 \mathrm{ER}, 1 \mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{~K}$ ) and took the loss on September 10 (5.0 IP, 7 H, 8 R, 8 ER, 4 BB, 5 K). The San Clemente, Calif. native attended UC Santa Barbara from 2019-2021 after going undrafted out of San Clemente High School.

About Last Night: The Sounds had three big innings, including a seven-run top of the sixth inning, to cruise to a 15-2 win. It was the most runs scored by Nashville since taking down Jacksonville 17-3 on July 21, 2023 and the most scored in a road victory since beating Louisville 17-2 on September 21, 2022. The Sounds had not scored that many runs in a game at Memphis since the 2019 season (17-11 on June 26, 2019) and in a game shorter than nine innings since a $19-0$ win at Colorado Springs on August 4, 2011 in game one of a doubleheader. It's the first time the Sounds have scored 15 runs in a
game shorter than seven innings since at least 2005.

Getting the Brush Out: Janson Junk worked efficiently and effectively in yesterday's start, picking up his first complete game win since May 5, 2019 with Advanced-A Tampa at Florida (5.1 IP, 3 H, 1 R, $1 \mathrm{ER}, 1 \mathrm{BB}, 8 \mathrm{~K}$ ). He worked three scoreless out of the gates and allowed just a pair of runs in the 5.2 innings of work before the game was called an out away of six full frames. Junk's fastball found the corner of the zone throughout the night, working three strikeouts and nine groundouts in the victory.

Something Brewing: Brewer Hicklen extended his team-longest hitting streak to seven games and on-base streak to nine games with a two-run homer in the sixth inning last night. He's batting . 346 (9-for-26) with four doubles, one triple, one homer, five RBI, five walks, five stolen bases and seven runs scored during the hitting streak. It's tied for the longest active hitting streak in the league along with Jacksonville's Jose Devers and Norfolk's Connor Norby. Only Norfolk's Heston Kjerstad and Kyle Stowers have had longer hitting streaks this season at eight. Hicklen's nine game on-base streak is tied for the fourth longest in the league.

Wiemermobile Off and Running: Outfielder Joey Wiemer doubled, plated a couple and scored twice in last night's $15-2$ win, extending his hitting streak to five games. After a slow start to the season, Wiemer is batting . 320 ( 9 -for-39) with three extra-base hits, five RBI, six walks and six runs scored this month (. 452 OBP, .972 OPS).

Bullpen Beat: The Sounds bullpen continued to be the best at the Triple-A level despite not getting an opportunity last night. Nashville relievers have four wins on the season and boast the best ERA (1.29), WHIP (0.93) and opponent batting average (.145) at the Triple-A level. Enoli Paredes (5.0 IP), Harold Chirino (3.2 IP), Rob Zastryzny (4.0 IP), Nick Bennett (4.0 IP) and Darrell Thompson (2.0 IP) have yet to allow an earned run in multiple appearances this season. The pitching staff as a whole has the lowest opponent batting average (.188) at the Triple-A level and the lowest ERA (2.94).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 688-588 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,280-2,108 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

McKendry became the first Sound to have a quality start in the first six games of the season since Paul Blackburn on April 9, 2017 at Round Rock (4th game of season...Blackburn took the loss in $6.0 \mathrm{IP}, 2 \mathrm{R}, 1 \mathrm{ER}$ ).
AGAINST OPPONENT: McKendry has made four starts against Memphis, with all coming in the 2023 season ( 3 with Durham and 1 with Nashville). He is 3-0 with a 3.22 ERA (22.1 IP/8 ER).
