NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The Storm Chasers opened the 2026 season 0-4, won 3 straight series and then lost back-to-back series, but are trending up, coming off a series split in Indianapolis.

After suffering a season-opening weekend sweep in Louisville, the Storm Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, with series wins over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis ... Omaha proceeded to lose 7 straight games to open a stretch from April 22 to May 8 where the team went 3-11 ... however, the Chasers have won 5 of their last 7 and have a chance to win this week's series today.

Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, the Chasers had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.

Omaha's 82.8% success rate (48-for-58) ranks 5th in the International League and 10th at the Triple-A level.

John Rave leads Omaha in steals (11) ... Gavin Cross has 9 steals in as many tries while Tyler Tolbert has swiped 8 bags and Kameron Misner has 7 stolen bases ... Cross and Tolbert are 2 of 4 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught this year.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

The Storm Chasers are seeing 3.987 pitches per plate appearance, 6th-most in the International League and 10th at the Triple-A level.

Among 114 Triple-A players with 150+ plate appearances this year, Kameron Misner is 9th in pitches seen/PA (4.391) while John Rave ranks 10th (4.355).

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

Omaha is tied for the 8th-best fielding percentage in the International League with a .980 mark (1st: Louisville & Rochester, .987), committing just 29 errors in 43 games.

The clean play extends throughout the roster - 5 of the Storm Chasers' 16 qualified fielders (min. 60.0 inn.) have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, while another 6 of those 16 have committed just 1 error on the season.

Omaha's 38 double plays turned are tied for the 10th-most of any Minor League team ... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10 or more double plays, led by Abraham Toro's 24, tied for the 10th-most of any Minor League player ... after turning 34 double plays in the first 30 games between March and April, Omaha has turned 4 double plays in 14 May games.

GENTRY GIANT

This week, former Storm Chasers outfielder Tyler Gentry returns to Werner Park for his first games as a visitor, after playing the last 3 seasons with Omaha.

Released by the Royals in March, Gentry signed with the Tigers on April 11 ... his 336 games with Omaha between 2023 and 2025 rank 5th-most in the club's Storm Chasers era (since 2011) ... since 2011, he ranks 3rd for Omaha in walks (162), 6th in homers (41), 7th in doubles (69), 7th in RBI (164) and 8th in total bases (490).

PITCH, PLEASE

Of recent, Omaha's pitching staff has seen success, including last week in Indianapolis and specifically from the starting rotation.

Omaha's pitching staff held Indians hitters to a .150 average (24-for-160), the best by a Storm Chasers pitching staff since 2021 ... last week's 1.98 ERA (10 ER in 47.1 IP) and 0.96 WHIP (17 BB + 26 H) were the 2nd-best.

Across the Storm Chasers' first 34 games of the 2026 season, the starting pitchers did not throw a quality start, only finishing 5.0 innings 5 times ... the Chasers have gotten 3 quality starts in the last 9 games, tied for the most of any Triple-A team in that stretch ... however, none of the 3 quality starts have been won by Omaha.

COMEBACK KIDS

Yesterday was Omaha's 10th comeback win of the season and the Storm Chasers' 3rd comeback win of this week's series

The Chasers have trailed in each of their 3 wins this week over the Mud Hens ... Omaha did not have a lead in the series until Wednesday's walk-off win, then overcame brief Toledo leads in Thursday and Saturday's wins.

Wednesday and Thursday's walk-off wins mark the 5th time in Werner Park history (since 2011) that the Chasers walked off back-to-back games and the first time since March 2024 ... it was the 5th time Omaha has had two straight walk-off wins come courtesy of the same player ... however, this is the first time in Werner Park history the same player has had the walk-off hit in consecutive games.

HENRY'S HUNCH

- ROAD TO OMAHA:** Williams is back in Omaha for his second stint with the Storm Chasers after making his Triple-A debut last May ... he allowed 9 ER in 8.0 innings (10.13 ERA) across his 2 starts at Triple-A last year (May 27 to June 5) ... in 20 appearances (18 starts) since returning to Double-A, he posted a 4.16 ERA (45 ER in 97.1 IP) for the Naturals.
- STRENGTH AND STAMINA:** Williams has gotten off to a hot start in 2026, allowing 2 earned runs or less while going 5.0+ innings in 4 of his last 6 starts ... following his stretch with the Storm Chasers in 2025, Williams went back to Northwest Arkansas (AA) and has pitched 5.0+ innings in 13 of his last 18 starts at Double-A.

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, MAY 9 @ FRISCO

- Made his 7th start of the season for Northwest Arkansas ... retired the first batter he saw, then allowed a solo home run to **Dylan Dreiling** in the 1st inning ... worked a 1-2-3 inning in the 2nd but allowed another solo home run to Dreiling in the 3rd inning ... Frisco hit a trio of singles in the 4th inning, bringing home a 3rd run, but Williams struck out the final 2 batters of the inning ... pitched a perfect 5th inning and did not return for the 6th.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 7 starts for Northwest Arkansas before his promotion to Omaha ... worked a 4.72 ERA (18 ER in 34.1 IP) with a 1.37 WHIP ... 3 of his 7 starts went 5.0+ innings with 1 or less runs allowed.

CAREER NOTES

- Spent most of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also made a pair of starts for Omaha ... among Royals Minor League pitchers, ranked 5th in innings pitched (115.1), tied 6th in strikeouts (106) and tied 6th in starts (21).
- Opened the year with the Naturals and threw 5 quality starts over his first 8 appearances ... made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers on May 28 vs. St. Paul (MIN) ... in 2 starts for Omaha and allowed 9 ER in 8.0 IP (10.13 ERA) before returning to Northwest Arkansas on June 6 to finish his season.
- In Northwest Arkansas, totaled 21 appearances (19 starts) and worked a 4.24 ERA (51 ER in 108.1 IP) with 100 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP throughout the season ... named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for his start on July 2 @ Springfield (STL), tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit and 7 strikeouts

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire **2024** season with Quad Cities (A+) ... appeared in 22 games (21 starts) with a 3.68 ERA (42 ER in 102.2 IP) and 92 strikeouts at High-A ... 7 of his 21 starts were scoreless, including his last 3 of the season, for a career-high 21.0-inning scoreless streak that stretched into April **2025**.
- Split the **2023** season between the Royals and Padres organizations ... opened the year with San Diego's Single-A affiliate, the Lake Elsinore Storm, but the Padres traded him to Kansas City at the trade deadline ... after the trade, made 5 starts for Columbia (A) and posted a 3.38 ERA (9 ER in 24.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts for the Fireflies.
- Made his professional debut at the start of the **2023** season with Lake Elsinore after San Diego drafted him in the 3rd round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Duke University ... made 12 starts for the Storm before his trade to the Royals, working a 5.74 ERA (27 ER in 42.1 IP) with 40 strikeouts for Lake Elsinore ... missed the **2022** season as he recovered from Tommy John surgery.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Attended Duke University (**2019-2021**), where he appeared in 9 games (7 starts) over 3 seasons with the Blue Devils (ACC), going 3-3 with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER in 37.2 IP) and 45 strikeouts ... only pitched one full season in Durham (**2021**) due to the COVID-19 pandemic shortening his freshman campaign (**2020**) and Tommy John surgery in December **2021**, keeping him out of action his junior year (**2022**).
- Lettered in both baseball and basketball all 4 years at Darien High School (CT) ... was a team captain for the basketball team his senior season.
- Father David played collegiate baseball at Davidson College from **1987** to **1991**.
