RHP Bradley Blalock (O-O, 6.48) vs. TBD

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes and Aces have split the first four games of the series after Reno's 17-11 win yesterday ... Bradley Blalock is expected to take the hill for Albuquerque while Reno has yet to name a starter.

DUKE CITY HR RECORD: Sam Hilliard belted his 80th home run in an Isotopes uniform yesterday - passing Mike Busch (Dukes, 1993-96) for the most in Albuquerque professional baseball history.

HR/AB: Hilliard has 80 home runs in 1,148 at-bats with Albuquerque, a ratio of one long ball every 14.35 official at-bat.

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Hilliard has 225 RBI with Albuquerque, which ranks third among career leaders in team history. Jordan Patterson (2016-18) is second with 229 RBI.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard swatted three hits last night to extend his on-base streak to 16, every game he's played in 2025. It's tied for the second-longest active on-base streak in the PCL and tied for the fourth-longest overall streak ... Dating back to 2024, has a 24-game on-base streak in Triple-A (June 11-19, 2024).

THREE-BAGGER: Hilliard's two triples yesterday marked the Sean Bouchard on March 31, 2024 vs. El Paso). He was the third to do so against Reno: Raimel Tapia (Sept. 1, 2017) and Josh Fuentes (May 20, 2018).

XBH: Albuquerque recorded 11 hits last night with nine going for extra bases, their most in a contest since Sept. 13, 2024 vs. Las Vegas (also nine) ... The Aces compiled 10 extra-base hits, most by an opponent since the Express also recorded 10 in Round Rock on Aug. 17, 2024.

@ RENO: Friday marked the second-most runs allowed by the Isotopes in Reno. Albuquer dopped the series opener 22-8 on Aug. 10, 2012 before winning the final three games of that set.

HITS ALLOWED: Reno finished with 21 hits last night, the 50th time in Isotopes history the pitching staff allowed 20 or more knocks. It tied for the most relented to the Aces with the aforementioned game in 2012.

OPPOSING HITTER: A.J. Vukovich became the second opposing player to collect five hits in a game this season (also: Scott Kingery, April 1 vs. Salt Lake). He also homered twice, the third time in 2025 an opposing player had a two-homer game (also: Zack Short – April 11 at SUG, Luis Campusano – April 17

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel doubled and collected three RBI last night, first time during his pro career he has driven in three runs in back-to-back games ... Has 10 RBI this series ... Over his last 11 games, is slashing .357/.400/.667 with seven doubles, two homers, 16 RBI and five walks.

YF: Yanquiel Fernandez doubled yesterday and has a hit in his last five games. Over those last five contests, is 9-for-22 with four homers, two doubles and seven RBI.

HOME RUN LEADERBOARD: Yanguiel Fernandez has seven homers on the year, tied for the most in all of MiLB.

THE VET: Austin Nola went 2-for-4 with a double yesterday, his third consecutive multi-hit contest. It is the first time he has done so since Aug. 4-7, 2020 when he played for the Seattle Mariners. ... Has four multi-hit games in 2025.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson legged out his first triple as an Isotope yesterday, while also driving in two runs, his second multi-RBI game of the campaign (also: April 10 at Sugar Land) ... Has a hit in nine of his last 10 contests

BOONIE: Trevor Boone has driven in 12 runs across his first seven games this season, including eight over the last three games. Additionally, Boone went deep for the third time in his test even across the test event. last seven contests at Reno.

JC: Julio Carreras picked up a hit last night, and is 8-for-13 with three runs batted in over his last three games.

VEEN: Zac Veen played in his first game with Albuquerque since being sent down Thursday and connected on two hits for his fourth multi-hit contest in nine games with the Isotopes.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Warming Bernabel is 7th in RBI (21) and 9th in slugging (.569) ... Ryan Ritter is T-2nd in walks (20) ... Yanquiel Fernandez is T-1st in homers (7) and 10th in slugging (.563) ... Sam Hilliard is 1st in triples (3), 5th in slugging (.603) and 9th in OPS (.959).

BIG INNING: The Aces' five-run first inning yesterday marked the biggest opening frame against Albuquerque since Las Vegas plated seven on Sept. 13, 2024.

RENO TIES: Connor Kaiser was Albuquerque's primary shortstop each of the last two seasons, playing in a total of 180 games. John Curtiss, currently on Reno's IL, compiled a 3.96 ERA in 43 relief outings for the Isotopes in 2024. Scott

guiding	NUCLEI NOTES SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach Notched his 1,000th career						

SKI guid Ălbu managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona-the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
