#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

**LAST TIME OUT:** Eddy Rodriguez singled home Shalin Polanco in the bottom of the ninth inning to give the Bradenton Marauders an 8-7 victory over the St. Lucie Mets for their eighth-straight win. Bradenton stormed out of the gates scoring five runs in the opening inning, including four on an Esmerlyn Valdez inside the park grand slam. Michael Kennedy tossed six innings for the second straight start as Landon Tomkins earned his first victory of the season out of the bullpen. For the Marauders, it was their fourth walk-off win of the season and second of this week against the Mets.

**WE CALL THAT A WINNING STREAK:** Friday night's walk-off victory over St. Lucie marked the Marauders' eighth-straight win. Bradenton had three streaks of six-plus wins last season with their longest streak lasting from April 14 - April 21 at seven games. It's the longest winning streak since Bradenton won nine-straight games from 7/3/22 - 7/13/22. The Marauders also won nine straight from 5/25/21 - 6/3/21 (franchise record) en route to capturing the 2021 Low-A East Championship. Only the Jersey Shore BlueClaws (PHI, A+) have an active winning streak longer than Bradenton (9). The longest streak this year in Minor League Baseball is owned by the Akron RubberDucks (CLE, AA) who won 10 straight from 4/21 - 5/2.

**KING OF THE HILLS:** Since April 17, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff is tied for the best ERA in Minor League Baseball at 2.39 with the Birmingham Barons (CWS, Double-A). The Daytona Tortugas are not far behind as well (CIN, Single-A) at 2.47. So far in the month of May, Bradenton has allowed just 16 earned runs in 81.0 innings, which is good for a 1.78 ERA and the second-best in MiLB. The Pensacola Blue Wahoos (MIA, Double-A), have a 1.67 ERA to lead the way.

**THE OFFENSE HAS ARRIVE:** During the Marauders' eight-game winning streak, the offense has scored 50 runs for an average 6.3 per game. Overall, the team is slashing .271/.356/.450 while ranking second in the FSL in average and slugging percentage. Bradenton's team batting average on the season has been raised from .176 to .201 over the past eight games. After Bradenton hit 10 home runs in 22 games in April, so far in May, they've connected on nine blasts in nine games.

**"RALPH" KEINER DELGADO?:** Keiner Delgado became the first Marauder this season to homer in back-to-back games on Thursday night. Delgado was recently acquired as the player to be named later in the JT Brubaker deal with the New York Yankees last week. The 20-year-old infielder has hit a HR in three of his five games with the Pirates organization, slugging a grand slam for the FCL Pirates in one game before earning his promotion to Single-A.

**ED, ED, AND EDDY:** Over the last seven games, Eddy Rodriguez has been hard to stop at the plate. The 20-year-old is 11-for-25 with three doubles, seven RBIs, four walks, and six runs scored while collecting a hit in all seven contests. Rodriguez delivered a walk-off RBI single on Friday night to extend the Marauders' winning streak to eight games.

**STUDY OF FORESTRY:** Over the last 13 games, INF Garret Forrester is slashing .385/.500/.590 with five doubles, one HR, five RBIs, eight walks, and seven runs scored. Since April 24, the former Oregon State Beaver has hits in eight of those 12 games while tallying two or more hits in five contests. In the last two Tuesday games versus Fort Myers and St. Lucie, Forrester has recorded a season-high three hits. Among qualified hitters in the FSL, Forrester leads all batters in OBP.

**BLANKED:** The Marauders blanked the St. Lucie Mets 4-0 on Tuesday to pick up their fifth shutout win of the season and their third in their previous five games. The first two came against the Clearwater Threshers before Bradenton pitched back-to-back shutouts last week against Fort Myers. The five shutouts on the year are tied for the second-most in MiLB only trailing the Daytona Tortugas and Akron RubberDucks (CLE, AA) who have six.

**GOT EM!:** Hunter Furtado picked off Kevin Villavicencio in the eighth inning on Friday night for the Marauders 11th pickoff of the season. As of Saturday, the Marauders are currently tied for first in MiLB, with the Fredericksburgh Nationals (Single-A, WAS) who also have 11. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

**HEATING UP:** Esmerlyn Valdez hit an inside the park grand slam on Friday night to extend his on-base streak to 12 games. During the streak, Valdez is hitting .308/.438/.641 with four doubles, three home runs, 13 RBIs, six walks, and nine runs scored.

**CLOSE QUARTERS:** Friday's win versus St. Lucie marked their 13th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 6-7 record in those games with 21 of their first 31 (67.4%) games having been decided by three runs or less.
