ONE MORE TIME: Today marks Biloxi's final game at Trustmark Park in 2023... In 2023, the Shuckers broke the franchise record for the most runs scored at Trustmark Park in a season, scoring 68 in 14 games entering today, an average o 4.9 per game... The Shuckers broke their previous high of 59 runs (4.9 per game), set in 12 games during the 202' season... The Shuckers have combined for six home runs in their 14 games, tied with 2019 for the third-most at the park in franchise history.

MARTINEZ MARCHES ON: Over nine games in Double-A, 1B Ernesto Martinez has reached in all nine and has drawn a walk in seven of the games... Over that span, Martinez has drawn a walk in 26% of his plate appearances... Since being promoted to Double-A on August 7, Martinez leads all Double-A hitters with a .529 on-base percentage.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS: OF Jackson Chourio brought home his 74th RBI of the year with a fielder's choice or Friday, tying OF Corey Ray (2018) for the most in a single-season in franchise history (since 2015)... Chourio is one of 29 Southern League players to reach 70 RBI in a season since 2015.

WES HOMERS INTO HISTORY: With a 111 MPH home run to left-center on Friday, C/1B Wes Clarke became the fourth player in franchise history (since 2015) to hit at least 20 home runs in a season... Clarke joins OF Corey Ray (27, 2018), C/OI Jakson Reetz (22, 2022) and INF Cam Devanney (20, 2022)... Clarke enters today with the third-most home runs out of any player in the Southern League.

CLOSING IN ON HISTORY: OF Jackson Chourio enters today three home runs away from becoming the first teenager in Double-A or Triple-A to record 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season since OF Delmon Young in 2005 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB).

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: Entering today, the Biloxi Shuckers would qualify for the 2023 Southern League Playoffs, their first appearance since 2019... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division... The Shuckers have a one-game lead on the Montgomery Biscuits and a four-game lead on the Blue Wahoos for the division lead... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

TODAY'S STARTER // LHP NICK BENNETT [3-3, 4.77]: LHP Nick Bennett will make his third start of the year and his first since June 3 against Pensacola at MGM Park... On Wednesday against the M-Braves, Bennett went 1.1 innings on a season-low eight pitches... Today marks Bennett's 50th career start.
