RECORDS FALL AS CARDS TOP MISSIONS 3-2: Four Cardinal pitchers combined to rack up 15 strikeouts and made a three-run top of the 5th inning stand as Springfield defeated the San Antonio Missions 3-2 on Saturday night at Nelson Wolff Stadium. With Trent Baker's strikeout of Romeo Sanabria leading off the bottom of the 4th was the Cards' 1,264th this season which is a new franchise record. Baker picked up his first win since June 1 and tied a career high with 9 K, and Matt Svanson matched a Springfield record with his 27th save of the season. **Svanson** is 27-for-27 in save opportunities this season. Nathan Church extended his hitting streak to 10 with a single in the 1st inning.



OPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander Daniel Camarena makes his 1st start for the Missions this season... Pitched a scoreless inning of relief on Tuesday in the series opener...In 11 relief appearances with San Antonio this season is 0-2 with a 4.09 ERA...Began the season with Triple-A El Paso where he made 14 apperances (7 starts) and went 1-6 with a 9.75 ERA...Spent the 2023 season with the Missions and made 25 apperances (17 starts) going 1-7 with a 6.20 ERA...Missed the entire 2022 season due to Tommy John surgery...Spent most of the 2021 campaign at Triple-A El Paso going 6-7 with a 4.75 ERA in 22 apperances (19 starts)...Made 6 relief appearances with the Padres and went 0-1 with a 9.64 ERA...In his 2nd MLB game on July 8, 2021, famously hit a grand slam off Max Scherzer at Petco Park...Signed by the Padres as a MiLB Free Agent in February, 2020...Spent time in the Yankees, Twins, Giants and Cubs organizations...Originally selected by the Yankees in the 20th round of the 2011 draft out of Cathedral Catholic in San Diego...31 years old

CARDS CLOSE OUT 2024 REGULAR SEASON IN THE ALAMO CITY: Springfield hits the road for the final series of the regular season before beginning the postseason next week. The Cards meet the San Antonio Missions (Double-A, San Diego Padres) for a six-game series at Nelson Wolff Stadium. The Cardinals and Missions split a six-game series at Hammons Field from August 6-11.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

HISTORIC CARDS MAKE HISTORY AGAIN: With their 2-1 win over the Missions on Wednesday, the Springfield Cardinals collected their 78th victory set a new franchise record for wins in a season. The 2024 club surpassed the 2012 & 2017 teams who each won 77 games. The wins record caps a season that has seen the Cards notch several franchise firsts:

- » Springfield has won 42 road games this season to set a new franchise record, eclipsing the 38 road wins in 2008.
- » The Cards began the season with a franchise record 9-game winning streak.
- With the Trent Baker's strikeout of Romeo Sanabria to start the bottom of the 5th inning on Saturday at San Antonio, the Cards' pitching staff set a new franchise record in strikeouts, eclipsing the previous record of 1,263 set in 2019.
- » With an average of .331, Bryan Torres is on pace to break the record for highest batting average held by Tyler Minges who hit .324 in 2005.
- » Matt Svanson tied Mark Worrell (2006) and Chris Perez (2007) with his 27th save of the season on Saturday night at San Antonio.
- » Cooper Hjerpe and Andrew Marrero combined to throw the first no-hitter in franchise history in a 5-0 win in game one of a doubleheader on June 20 at Corpus Christi.
- » Chandler Redmond set the new franchise record with his 60th home run in a Springfield uniform.

GRINDIN': All season long, the Cardinals have been one of the toughtest teams to strike out in Minor League Baseball. The Birds have whiffed 1,004 times in 137 games and have a strikeout rate of just 19.1%. Both of those numbers rank as 2nd-best in the minor leagues. The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (High-A, MIL) have the fewest whiffs in MiLB (946 in 131 G), while the Reno Aces (Triple-A, ARI) have the lowest K-rate at 19.07%.

HOLDING 'EM DOWN: While the 2024 campaign has been a roller coaster ride of sorts for the Cardinal pitching staff, the Birds' arms have been at their best since the beginning of August, compiling a 3.38 ERA over their last 38 games, a mark that is 4th-best in the Texas League. Through the end of July the Cardinals sported a 4.64 ERA, 9th in the circuit.

LOOKING FOR THE BIG HIT: Despite a productive night on Saturday going 2-for-4, Springfield has struggled with runners in scoring position over their last 7 games. Since last Saturday, September 7 against NW Arkansas the Cardinals are batting .145 (9-for-62) with runners in scoring position, and are just 3-for-32 (.094) over their last 3 games in San Antonio.

YEAGER BUMBS: Cardinals INF **RJ Yeager** has been a consistent producer for Springfield in the middle of its lineup all season long. With his solo shot on Friday night, **Yeager** set a new career high with 15 HR. He is top-15 in the Texas League in both HR and RBI (64).

CARDS WELCOME BIG BAT BACK INTO FOLD: Cardinals C Jimmy

Crooks was activated from the IL on Tuesday, putting perhaps Springfield's most productive hitter back into the middle of the lineup. At the time he was placed on the IL August 27, **Crooks** was leading all qualified hitters the Texas League with a .359 average, 10 HR and 39 RBIs since June 23. **Crooks** is 4-for-13 with a double in the first 3 games of the series.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals OF **Nathan Church** has been swinging a hot bat down the stretch in the 2024 regular season. **Church** has hit safely in all 10 September games and has notched multiple hits in two of his last three. For the month, the UC Irvine product is batting .359 (14-for-39) and has 7 BB and an OBP of .457. **Church** was named the Caridnals Minor League Player of the Month in April when he hit .349 with 3 HR, 18 RBIs and a .914 OPS.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 27-for-27 and his 52 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer is 3-0 with a 1.50 and is 16-for-16 in save opportunities. **Svanson** had a run of 19 apperances without allowing an earned run snapped on Sunday, September 1 at Wichita when he allowed 2 ER on 4 H in the 8th inning of Springfield's 5-2 win. The Cardinals are 59-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


