JACKSONVILLE SURRENDERS THREE HOMERS IN LOSS

Both Dane Myers and Tristan Gray cranked home runs on Saturday, but it wasn't enough as the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Charlotte Knights 11-2. Myers got the scoring started for the Jumbo Shrimp in the bottom of the second with his first home run of the season to make it 1-0. Charlotte took command of the game, scoring two in the third, two in the fifth, one run in the sixth inning and thanks to a Brett Phillips grand slam, six runs in the ninth. Gray's sixth homer of the season came in the bottom of the ninth but the Jumbo Shrimp couldn't overcome a nine-run deficit.

GRAND THEFT OTTO

The Miami Marlins claimed **Otto López** off waivers from the San Francisco Giants on April 4 and promptly optioned him to Jacksonville. The Montréal native has been almost impossible to retire since that point. Over his first six games with the Jumbo Shrimp, López is 13-for-24 (.542/.593/.875/1.468) with two doubles, two home runs. five RBIs, three walks and four runs scored. He has reached base multiple times in five of his six games with Jacksonville.

'PFN PAIS

Jacksonville's bullpen has excelled of late. Over the club's last six games, Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to yield just six runs on 18 hits in 25.1 innings (2.13 ERA) with 32 strikeouts against nine walks. On the season, Jacksonville's bullpen has posted a 4.11 ERA, which ranks seventh in the International League. Jumbo Shrimp relievers have retired 32 of the 40 first-batters they have faced (80.0 percent), far above the baseball-wide average of roughly 70.0 percent.

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Tristan Gray**, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City for a series that began on April 2. The Missouri City, Texas native homered in five consecutive games from April 2-6, the longest such streak for a Jacksonville hitter since Peter O'Brien went vard in six straight games from June 6-11, 2018. Over the last 10 games, six of which came against Durham, Gray is a combined 11-for-38 (.289) with a double, six home runs, 10 RBIs, four walks and nine runs scored.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Outside of a 10-0 loss to Gwinnett on March 31, a 6-2 defeat to Durham on April 5, another 6-2 loss to Charlotte on Thursday and an 11-2 loss last night, all 10 of Jacksonville's contests in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 8-2 in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won seven of their last 11 games. All seven of those victories have come by three runs or fewer, with opponents outscoring Jacksonville by a narrow 50-45 margin. Relatedly, those 45 runs scored rank fifth-fewest in Triple-A during this stretch. The Jumbo Shrimp's 3.99 ERA ranks seventh in Triple-A during this stretch.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 14 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 51 runs (3.6 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 19for-113 (.168/.296/.283/.579, ranking 30th, 29th, 29th and 30th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 87 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

-Made one relief appearance on March 31 versus Gwinnett.

2023 SEASON

-Between the Rookie-level FCL Braves, Double-A Mississippi, Triple-A Gwinnett and Triple-A Indianapolis in 2023, posted a 4-6 record and 5.42 ERA in 34 games, including 14 starts (78.0 IP, 70 H, 53 BB, 81 K).

-Last season in Triple-A, he went 1-3 with a 7.20 ERA in 10 starts (35.0 IP, 35 H, 26 BB, 36 K, .259 BAA). As a reliever, he was 2-2 with a 4.35 ERA in 18 appearances (31.0 IP, 28 H, 20 BB, 32 K, .239 BAA).

-Muñoz posted extreme platoon splits in Triple-A. He held right-handed hitters to a .217/.329/.357/.686 line in 170 plate appearances. Left-handed batters slashed .291/.418/.545/.963 against him in 134 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit just .213/.346/.354/.700 against Muñoz, but with runners on base, they batted .286/.391/.524/.915 against him.
