**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 5-4. **Shane Matheny** opened the scoring with a three-run homer in the first inning. **Logan Wyatt** added an RBI double in the second to open a 4-0 lead. In the top of the fourth, James Wood hit a solo home run to close the score to 4-1. It was the only hit allowed over five innings of work by Richmond starter **Spencer Bivens.** Matheny hit his second homer of the game in the sixth, a solo shot, to extend the Richmond lead to 5-1. In the ninth, the Senators scored three runs on an error, but **Tyler Myrick** got a strikeout to strand the potential tying run at third.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The two teams met for a six-game set in Harrisburg from April 11-14, with the Senators winning four-of-six, including three games by one run. The Flying Squirrels won five-of-six at The Diamond from June 20-25 to close the first half. Richmond dropped two-of-three in Harrisburg from July 14-16 coming out of the All-Star Break. Richmond is 2-2 against the Senators in the second half.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 28-19 in their last 46 games since June 18 and snapped a three-game skid with Tuesday night's win. Over the last 52 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.90 ERA (64 ER/198.2 IP) and have allowed 15 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.78 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 400.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 541.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.62 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A and the 10th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

**THE SENATORS** are 12-4 in their last 16 games dating back to July 28, including going 5-1 against the RubberDucks at FNB Field last week. They have won four consecutive series. Since July 28, they are leading the Eastern League with a .290 batting average (159-for-549) and with 98 runs scored (6.2 runs per game). Harrisburg's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF James Wood (No. 2, No. 7 overall), SS Brady House (No. 3, No. 63 overall), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 4), 3B Trey Lipscomb (No. 15), RHP Cole Henry (No. 17), C Israel Pineda (No. 21), OF Jacob Young (No. 24), LHP DJ Herz (No. 5) and LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospect list includes nine Harrisburg players, including Wood (No. 2, No. 7 overall), Hassell (No. 8), Lipscomb (No. 16), Henry (No. 19), Pineda (No. 22), Parker (No. 26) and Young (No. 30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his sixth Double-A start and his first against the Senators. Last Thursday against the Baysox, he threw five innings and allowed one run in a no-decision. In his last two starts, since August 4, Bertrand has a 0.90 ERA (1 ER/10. IP/8 SO/3 BB). He has allowed two-or-less earned runs in four-of-his-five Double-A starts. Bertrand did not allow an earned run over his final two starts for the High-A Eugene Emeralds, spanning 10 innings of work. In his last five High-A starts, Bertrand went 3-0 with a 0.72 ERA (2 ER/25.0 IP). During his time with the Emeralds from May 9-July 13, Bertrand led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.95) and BAA (196), held the second-best ERA (2.92), was second in wins (5) and ranked fourth in innings pitched (49.1). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five relief appearances. Bertrand pitched three seasons at Furman before spending his final two seasons at Notre Dame. Last year, he was an All-American with the Irish before being selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the MLB Draft. *For more on Bertrand, see page two*.

FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander DJ Herz makes his third Eastern League start. In his Senators debut on August 5 at Erie, he worked Fur harmsburd Left-hander DJ Herz makes his third Eastern League start. In his Senators debut on August 5 at Erie, he worked 2.1 innings and allowed five runs (four earned) in a loss. He last took the mound last Friday and tossed 4.2 scoreless innings, allowing one hit. Herz was traded to the Nationals on July 31 along with SS Kevin Made from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for 3B Jeimer Candelario. Herz was selected in the eighth round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Cubs out of Sanford High School in North Carolina. He first reached Double-A last July with the Tennessee Smokies, going 1-4 with an 8.24 ERA in nine starts. Herz was selected as an MiLB.com Cubs Organization All-Star in 2021 and 2022. This year in the Southern League prior to the trade, he went 1-1 with a 3.97 ERA in 14 starts.

**STARTING STRONG:** Against the Curve on the last road trip beginning August 1, Richmond starting pitchers opened the set throw-ing 20 innings without allowing a run until the third inning on August 5. Flying Squirrels starters have a 2.06 ERA (12 ER/52.1 IP) over the last 12 games since August 2. In that stretch, **Carson Seymour** is 1-0 with a 0.61 ERA (1 ER/14.2 IP), **Spencer Bivens** has a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) and **John Michael Bertrand** has a 0.90 ERA (1 ER/10.0 IP). **Wil Jensen** also threw four scoreless innings in his start on August 10.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 29 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are tied for first place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, even with the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the divi-sion's first half. Richmond is one game ahead of third-place Bowie and Harrisburg. Akron is in fourth, two games behind first place, and Altoona is in sixth, four games back. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (357,843) and average attendance (6,390) this year. They are also 14th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 43 times in his last 19 games since July 25 (23 hits and 20 walks), hitting, 354 (23-for-65) with four homers, five doubles, two triples and 16 RBIs adding a .500 on-base percentage. On Tuesday night against the Senators, Matheny homered twice, a three-run shot in and a solo home run, and added a double in a three-hit, four-RBI performance. It was the third two-homer game of his Richmond career, joining performances on May 1, 2022 against Bowie and May 12, 2022 at Harrisburg. He also had a two-homer run game on August 25, 2019 with High-A San Jose at Stockton. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 128 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

DONNIE'S IN HIS ELEMENT: Donovan Walton has hit safely in each of his seven games since being assigned to Richmond last week, combining to hit .375 (9-for-24) with a double, three walks and three RBIs, adding two stolen bases. In his 15 games for the Flying Squirrels this season, he is batting .327 (16-for-49) with two homers and nine RBIs. Covering his two stints with Rich-mond, Walton has reached base in 14 consecutive Eastern League games and has hit safely in eight straight games.

**GLOW SHOW:** Over his last 26 games since July 1, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .310 (27-for-87) with four homers, seven doubles, 20 RBIs and nine walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On July 29 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is hitting .389 (7-for-18) in his last six games since August 2 with the double at the set of the RIM. two doubles, three walks and six RBIs.

**DLD FRIENDS:** Harrisburg's roster includes two former Flying Squirrels players. First baseman Frankie Tostado was selected by the Mariners in the minor-league phase of December's Rule 5 Draft and later traded to the Nationals. In 2021 and 2022, Tostado played 177 games for the Flying Squirrels, batting .264 with 104 RBIs. His 25 career homers with Richmond are tied for fifth-most in a career in franchise history. Reliever Patrick Ruotolo joined the Senators after being signed by the Nationals as a free agent on July 1. He spent parts of three seasons with Richmond (2018, 2021, 2022), going 4-2 with a 2.45 ERA and 16 saves in his 64 appearances. On May 13, 2021 at Harrisburg, Ruotolo worked the ninth in the Flying Squirrel's first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history. Other former Flying Squirrels playing in the Eastern League this year include outfielder Diego Rincones (2021-22) with Erie, pitcher Gray Fenter (2022) with Somerset and pitcher Matt Seelinger (2021) with Reading.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 5 - on IL), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 7), RHP **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 12), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 16), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and **Jose Cruz** as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
