**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The final home stand of the regular season continues, as the Quakes host the Visalia Rawhide (AZ) in the second game of a six-game series. Tonight is Bark in the Ballpark, sponsored by Raising Cane's, as four-legged friends are welcome to the ballpark with the purchase of a \$3 Pet Pass. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE RAWHIDE:** Today's game is the 26th of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the 11th of 15 at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 12-13 against the Rawhide in 2024, 5-5 here at home.. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 7-5 here at home.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes earned their seventh shutout of the year, as Rancho downed Visalia by a final of 2-0 on Tuesday night at LoanMart Field. Cameron Decker hit a first-inning homer (10) and Zyhir Hope had an RBI ground-out in the sixth to supply the Quakes with just enough offense, as they were held to a season-low two hits on the night. Eriq Swan fired four innings to get the ball rolling, while Joseilyn Gonzalez (5-1), Noah Ruen and Evan Shaw combined for the final five innings, with Shaw picking up his first career save, helping Rancho win for the fourth time in their last five games overall. Visalia starter Nate Savino (0-4) allowed one run on one hit over five innings of work.

**END OF AUGUST:** With a 13-14 record, the Quakes finished August below .500. On the positive side, their pitching staff had their lowest monthly ERA at 4.54. Starting September, Rancho was sixth in the league with a 5.34 ERA overall. August bats struggled though, with their second lowest monthly batting average at .243. Wilman Diaz led the team with a batting average of .330, while Cameron Decker led the team with 28 RBIs over 24 August games. Jose Meza, Zyhir Hope and Decker all had five home runs to lead the team in August round-trippers.

**TWO BACK WITH FIVE TO PLAY...MUST WIN FOUR OF FIVE:** Rancho's win last night means the Quakes are two back of Visalia and they must win four of the remaining five games in this series in order to make the 2024 Cal League Playoffs. The playoffs will open next Tuesday in either Visalia or Rancho Cucamonga, as one of those two teams will host the First Half South Division Champion Lake Elsinore Storm in game one of the best-of-three. Games two and then three (if necessary) will take place in Lake Elsinore next Thursday and Friday, respectively. The North Division Playoffs are already set, as San Jose hosts Modesto next Tuesday in game one of the best-of-three.

**HYUN-SEOK JANG:** Hyun-Seok Jang makes his fifth start, after joining the team from the recently-completed Arizona Complex League, his second start against Visalia. In his lone game against the Rawhide, he allowed one hit and two walks while striking out a career-high-tying seven in three scoreless innings in a no-decision on August 15. In his last start, he allowed just one hit and one walk with three strikeouts over two scoreless innings in a no-decision at San Jose on August 29. He enters this start with nine consecutive scoreless innings over his last three starts. Jang went 1-2 with an 8.14 ERA over 13 games (10 starts) and 24.1 innings pitched in the ACL. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 15th best prospect.

**WILKIN PAREDES:** Lefty Wilkin Paredes makes his 16th start of the year for the Rawhide and third against the Quakes. In three starts against the Quakes, he's 2-1 with a 8.04 ERA, allowing 14 runs on 20 hits over 15.2 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed four runs (two earned) on six hits over 5.2 innings in a no-decision vs Fresno on August 28. Paredes was signed to an international free agent contract in January, 2023, out of the Dominican Republic, but did not debut until this year.
