YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels stranded 11 runners on base and lots to the SeaWolves, 6-5. Richmond went 1-for-13 with runners in scoring position. Erie opened a 2-0 lead in the second inning with a two-run double by Dane Myers. **Tyler Fitzgerald** hit a solo homer in the fourth to close the gap to 2-1. In the bottom of the fourth, Quincy Nieporte brought in a run with a sac fly and Myers added an RBI single to push the Erie lead to 4-1. Richmond scored a run on an error in the fifth to move the score to 4-2. Andre Lipcius extended Erie's lead to 5-2 in the fifth with an RBI single. In the top of the sixth, **Frankie Tostado** clubbed a solo homer to center, his first of the season. **Sean Roby** brought in a run with a sac fly in the seventh to pull the score to 5-4. Kerry Carpenter opened Erie's lead to 6-4 in the bottom of the seventh with an RBI groundout. Tostado hit an RBI single in the ninth, but Richmond stranded two runners on base.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This series is the only trip to Erie for the Flying Squirrels. The two teams will play twice in Richmond this season, including a six-game series from June 7-12 and another from September 13-18.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped three-of-four in the series. In last week's series, the Flying Squirrels dropped their home opener before winning four-of-the-next five games against the Curve at The Diamond. Last season, the Flying Squirrels went 57-56, their first winning season since 2015, and finished fourth in the Double-A Northeast's Southwest Division.

THE SEAWOLVES have won three-of-four this week after dropping four-of-six in last week's series. Erie's pitching staff has thrown two shutouts this season, including a 2-0 win on Opening Day and a 3-0 shutout last Wednesday at Somerset. Erie's roster includes seven of MLB.com's Top-30 Tigers prospects, including catcher Dillon Dingler (4), infielder Gage Workman (11), RHP Reese Olson (17), outfielder Daniel Cabrera (22), infielder Andre Lipcius (26), RHP Garrett Hill (27) and RHP Austin Bergner (30). Last year, the SeaWolves went 64-55 and finished third in the Double-A Northeast's Southwest Division, 8.5 games out of a playoff spot.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Tristan Beck** makes his third start of the season. He started the Flying Squirrels' home opener against Altoona on April 12 and allowed three runs (two earned) over four innings in a loss. In his second start on Sunday afternoon against the Curve, he worked five innings and allowed two runs with six strikeouts. Beck made four starts for Richmond last year before going on the injured list with a back strain on June 9. Beck began a rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League in August and made two relief appearances for Low-A San Jose. Beck was selected in the fourth round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Stanford by the Atlanta Braves. He was traded to the Giants on July 31, 2019 along with RHP Dan Winkler in exchange for RHP Mark Melancon. Beck was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 30 Giants prospect entering the 2022 season. **For more on Beck, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander A.J. Ladwig makes his first start of the season with Erie. He began the year with Triple-A Toledo and made one start, taking the mound on Opening Day against Rochester. In that outing, he allowed four runs over 3.2 innings in a loss. Ladwig has made 50 starts for Erie dating back to 2017, combining to go 17-15 with a 4.51 ERA. He was selected in the 11th round of the 2014 MLB Draft by the Tigers out of Wichita State. Ladwig last faced Richmond on September 18, 2021, allowing four runs over six innings in a win.

COMEBACK KIDS: The Flying Squirrels have come from behind in each of their last five wins. On April 13 against the Curve, they trailed, 5-1, in the fourth before scoring eight runs to pull away for a 10-6 win. On April 14, the Curve held a 3-0 lead in the first and a 4-2 lead before three runs by Richmond in the seventh led to a 5-4 victory. On April 16, Altoona opened a 4-0 lead in the fourth, but Richmond scored scratched back with runs in the fourth and sixth before taking the lead with four in the seventh and adding two in the eighth in an 8-4 win. On Sunday, the Curve led, 2-0, in the fifth, but the Flying Squirrels scored a run in the bottom of the fifth and tied the game in the eighth to force extras before **Will Wilson** launched a walk-off grand slam in the 10th for a 6-2 win. In the second game of Thursday's double-header, Erie scored two in the first, Richmond took a 3-2 lead in the top of the fifth, Erie tied the game in the bottom of the fifth, but the Flying Squirrels pushed across five runs in the seventh for an 8-3 win.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 21 home runs this season, which is the most in the Eastern League and leads all of Double-A. After hitting three homers in the season-opening series at Bowie from April 8-10, the Flying Squirrels hit 12 home runs over six games in their first homestand against Altoona last week. They added four homers in the two games of Thursday's double-header in Erie and went deep twice on Friday night. Last Wednesday, the Flying Squirrels set the franchise record for homers in an inning with four in the fourth, and set a team record with five homers in the game. **Sean Roby** is leading the league with six homers on the season, including five in last week's series. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 223 home runs.

A ROBUST WEEK: **Sean Roby** was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday after his performance during last week's six-game series against the Curve. In his five games, Roby hit .467 (7-for-15) and led the league with five homers and nine RBIs while adding five walks in five games played. He went 3-for-5 and homered twice last Wednesday with three RBIs. Last Thursday, he hit a two-run, go-ahead homer in the eighth inning in a 5-4 win. After he was out of the lineup on Friday, Roby returned on Saturday and added three more hits, including two homers, and drove in four runs in the Flying Squirrels' 8-4, comeback win. Roby is 0-for-8 in this series with five strikeouts, two walks and a sac fly.

SHANE TRAIN: **Shane Matheny** is batting .381 (8-for-21) with a double, a homer and three RBIs in his eight games played this season. On Friday, he reached base four times, picking up a double and two walks. Although he doesn't have enough plate appearances to qualify for the league leaderboard, Matheny is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .536 on-base percentage and is third with a 1.107 OPS. He sits third on the team with seven walks.

SAY HEYWARD: **Jacob Heyward** is hitting .333 (10-for-30) on the year with three multi-hit performances in his 10 games played. Over his last three games, Heyward is batting .556 (5-for-9) with an RBI and a walk. For the year, Heyward has walked three times, stretching his Richmond career franchise record to 117.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is leading the Eastern League in home runs (6), tied for second with 12 RBIs, third in SLG (.778), third in OPS (1.191) and tied for second in total bases (28). **Solomon Bates** and **Ryan Walker** are tied for second in wins (2). **Jake Dahlberg** is fourth in strikeouts (21) and tied for fifth in innings pitched (14.1). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for seventh in innings pitched (14.0).

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: On March 3, **Dennis Pelfrey** was named the new manager for the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Last year in his first season as a manager in affiliated baseball, he led the Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Pelfrey, 44, played six professional seasons in independent baseball from 1999-2004. He began his coaching career at South Grand Prairie High School in Texas in 2006, a position he held through 2015. He continued that role as he began his professional coaching career in 2011 with the Gary SouthShore RailCats, where he spent four seasons. Pelfrey landed his first managerial job in 2015 with the Florence Freedom of the independent Frontier League, a role he held for five seasons through 2019. He was hired by the Giants entering the 2020 season to manage High-A San Jose before the season was canceled due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. Under his direction last year, the Emeralds went 69-50 before topping Spokane in the High-A West Championship Series.

REWRITING THE RULES: New experimental rules are in effect during the Flying Squirrels' season. With runners on base, pitchers will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. The size of the bases has increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square in an attempt to reduce injuries. Defensively, teams must have a minimum of four players on the infield and two infielders complete on either side of second base.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tristan Beck** (30), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
