SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

DOUBLING UP ON THE FUN: Due to Thursday's rainout, the Shuckers are set to play their fifth doubleheader of 2023... At home, the Shuckers have split and swept a doubleheader this year... They swept their last doubleheader at home on May 11 against Rocket City.

ON TO THE SECOND HALF: With Pensacola's 3-1 win on Wednesday night over the Tennessee Smokies, the Blue Wahoos clinched their second straight Southern League South Division First Half title... The first half ends on Sunday, with the second half starting on June 28 when the Shuckers take on the Mississippi Braves... The winner of each half in the divisions will meet in the Divisional Championship Series at the conclusion of the regular season.

ROCKETING UP THE CHARTS: INF Tyler Black tallied his 39th stolen base on Wednesday afternoon against the Lookouts... He enters today with the second-most stolen bases by a Shuckers player in a single BLX SINGLE-SEASON SB LEADERS

season, 14 away from breaking **OF Johnny Davis'** franchise record of 52, set during the 2017 season... Black's next stolen base will make him the second Shuckers player to reach 40 in a season, and the 16th Southern League player to reach the mark since 2005. 3. Corey Ray, 37 SB, 135 GP (2018)

JUST PLAY THE HITS: OF Carlos Rodriguez enters today with a .292 average, fourth-best in the Southern League and second-best in the Brewers' system... Over 16 games in June, Rodriguez is hitting a team-best .362 (17-47) with nine walks and four strikeouts... In 2023, his 13.9% strikeout rate is the lowest out of all qualified batters in the Southern League and the ninth-lowest in Double-A.

GRAND THEFT BASES: The Shuckers enter today with 124 stolen bases this season, the most in the Southern League and the second-most in Double-A... The Shuckers are one of four teams, along with the Portland Sea Dogs (130, BOS), Somerset Patriots (118, NYY) and the Arkansas Travelers (117, SEA) to swipe at least 100 in 2023... Biloxi is currently on pace for 263 stolen bases, one shy of the Birmingham Baron's Southern League record of 264, set in 1989 in a 144-game season.

HOW ABOUT THAT BLOOD PRESSURE?: Wednesday's 2-1 win over the Lookouts marked Biloxi's 33rd game decided by two runs or less in 2023... Entering today, 51% of the Shuckers' games have been decided by two runs or less, including each of their last four.

TODAY'S GAME ONE STARTER // RHP JUSTIN JARVIS (6-3, 3.32): Brewers' No. 30 prospect, RHP Justin Jarvis, makes his 13th start of the year, and his first home start since tying his career-high with seven innings on June 4 against Pensacola... Jarvis' 8.1% walk rate and 3.96 FIP are both the sixth-best in the Southern League out of all qualified pitchers.

TODAY'S GAME TWO STARTER // RHP TOBIAS MYERS [3-2, 5.43]: RHP Tobias Myers will make his 13th start of the year after going six innings last time out against Montgomery with seven strikeouts... The start marked the first time that Myers had completed six innings since May 12 against Rocket City... Today marks Myers' 107th career start.
