Happy Birthday: Today is reliever Hunter Breault's 25th birthday; Breault was drafted by the A's out of Oregon in the 20th and final round in 2021. This is his second season in the Midwest League.

Playoff Outlook: Bleak. With eight games remaining in the first half, Lansing trails division-leading Lake County by five games. Only the top team in each division clinches a playoff berth. If the season ended today, Lake County and West Division-leading Wisconsin would earn postseason spots. The won-lost records for every team will reset on Friday, June 21.

Prospecting: The Locos boast five MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10), first baseman Will Simpson (No. 25), southpaw Will Johnston (No. 28) and outfielder Brayan Buelvas (No. 30).

Home Cooking: The Lugnuts have the best home offense in the Midwest League, ranking 1st in batting average (.278), OBP (.373), slugging percentage (.423), OPS (.796), runs (178, averaging 5.7 per game), hits (282, 9 per game), total bases (430) and triples (17), and ranking 2nd in walks (144) and stolen bases (48). (If you're wondering, the Lugnuts' offense on the road has the 3rd best batting average at .240 and is 1st with 11 triples, 2nd with a .385 slugging pct. and 2nd with a .715 OPS.)

Pride of Palo Alto: Henry Bolte is 4th in all of Minor League Baseball in runs scored (52), scoring three runs in the opener yesterday. Bolte ranks 1st in all of High-A in total bases (115) and is tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (29), tied for 3rd in RBIs (44), tied for 4th in triples (5), tied for 6th in doubles (15), 6th in hits (63), 8th in OPS (.942) and tied for 9th in stolen bases (23).

A'round the A's: 2022 Lugnuts slugger Tyler Soderstrom has homered in back-to-back games for the Oakland Athletics and now has three home runs and a 123 OPS+ for the A's in 26 games... in Triple-A, 2018 Nut Ryan Noda homered and Brady Basso tossed five innings, striking out six in an 8-4 win over Salt Lake (RIP, Steve Klauke)... that game also saw 2022-2023 Nut Grant Holman fire a scoreless inning, giving Holman 22 scoreless innings this season between Double-A and Triple-A... speaking of Double-A, the Midland RockHounds improved to 34-24 with a 4-2 win over Wichita, thanks to five scoreless innings from Jack Cushing... lastly, the Single-A Stockton Ports routed Lake Elsinore, 10-4, with DH Nelson Beltran going 3-for-5 with three RBIs and a pair of runs scored in an 11-hit effort.

Welcome to the Show: Southpaw Brady Basso, who pitched for the Nuts in 2021, underwent Tommy John, and returned successfully last season, became the third former Lansing player this season to reach the Majors on May 31 (joining Max Schuemann and Brett Harris). Brady is the 187th Major League Lugnut in franchise history.

2011: Jake Marisnick went 4-for-5 with a two-run HR and 4 RBIs, Matt Nuzzo was 3-for-5 w/ 3 R and 3 RBIs, Markus Brisker was 3-for-6 and Balbino Fuenmayor was 3-for-5 in a 20-hit 12-6 victory at Cedar Rapids. The Kernels committed four errors; Lugnuts SS Gustavo Pierre committed three errors himself, giving him 36 errors for the year.

2012: The TinCaps defeated the Lugnuts, 1-0, in one hour and 54 minutes at Parkview Field. It was a heartbreaker for Nuts starter Jesse Hernandez (8 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 8 K), who allowed a run on a sacrifice fly in the first inning but didn't allow his first hit until Travis Whitmore's infield single off Hernandez's glove leading off the bottom of the 8th.

In a Nutshell: Goes by Li'i ("lee-ee") with friends and family; opened the season in a tandem with Eduardo Rivera (now in Stockton), replaced by Will Johnston on April 29... had only made one start, a spot start, before being given the starting opportunity this season... Notable splits:

Last Time Out: Plunked the first three batters of his professional career... allowed four runs in the 1st (including a two-run HR from Leonardo Bernal) and three runs in the 5th (including a two-run double from Bernal) in a 10-5 Lugnuts loss to Peoria... this was the Lugnuts' only loss of the six-game series... has now allowed 13 runs in the first inning this year (with opposition batting .529/.568/.765 in the 1st).

Back Home: Signed for \$75,000... high school teammates with current Lugnuts teammate Hunter Breault, who was one year older at Kamehameha-Kapalama H.S... graduated HS with 3.5 GPA... played club ball for Team California Baseball, top 10 nationally ranked... First Team All-State as junior (0.95)... 2022 - junior year at Hawai'i: First Team All Big West, ranking 3rd in the conference in ERA (1.90) and leading Hawai'i in strikeouts (88)... notable Rainbow Warriors in the pros include Cleveland's Cade Smith, Seattle's Josh Rojas, longtime infielder Kolton Wong and former Brewers closer Chuck Crim.

The Aloha State: The most career MLB games for any Hawaiian: former A's catcher Kurt Suzuki, 1,635, who also owns the most career homers (143); among pitchers, Charlie Hough's 25-year career stands alone. Former Lugnuts from Hawai'i include Dustin Antolin (also from Mililani) and Bryson Namba. 2009 lights-out closer Matt Daly is the only other Lugnut in team history to play ball at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa.

Minor League Path: Made pro debut in the Arizona Complex League in 2022 with a pair of scoreless innings, moving up to Stockton for two relief appearances by year's end... spent all of 2023 with the Ports, serving as their relief ace (11 saves in 15 chances) and only allowing three home runs in 61 1/3 innings... limited left-handed batters to .198 batting average / .530 OPS; right-handers hit .305 with .753 OPS.

In a Nutshell: Excelled in his Lugnuts debut on May 2 vs. South Bend, becoming the club's 11th different starting pitcher this year and the 939th all-time player to put on the Lansing uniform... replaced the demoted Eduardo Rivera and tossed five scoreless two-hit innings, striking out six Cubs... followed up with eight strikeouts in three hitless innings with his mother in attendance at Great Lakes, May 8... grew up idolizing Max Scherzer... enjoys the great outdoors... notable splits:



Prospecting: Rated the A's No. 28 prospect and No. 13 pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline... grades: fastball 50, slider 45, change-up 55, control 50, overall 40... they write, "With low expectations, Johnston began his first full season of pro ball at age 23 with Single-A Stockton, but he threw so well out of the gate he earned a quick promotion up to High-A Lansing at the end of April... Johnston has shown a better feel for his three-pitch arsenal than some expected given his college numbers. He adds and subtracts from his fastball, throwing it typically in the 89-94 mph range, though he's shown in the past the ability to reach back for a 95 or 96-mph heater on occasion. The pitch has played up a bit because he can pitch north and south with it. His best pitch is now his split-changeup, which flashes plus and can be a true out pitch at times. His low-80s breaking ball can be on the slurvy side, but it can be effective."

Stockton Sensation: Opened 2024 with the Class A Ports... made two relief appearances and two starts, facing 46 batters and whiffing 26 of them ... debuted with 4 2/3 hitless innings with eight strikeouts on April 6... followed up with three perfect innings with 7 K on 4/12.

Gig 'Em: Majored in finance at Texas A&M... pitched primarily out of Aggies' bullpen; career stats: 6-4, 5.77 ERA, 66 G, 8 GS, 8 SV, 98 1/3 IP, 57 BB, 132 K... finest year at College Station was in 2022: 3.25 ERA, 23 G, 2 GS, 4 SV, 36 IP, 2 HR, 18 BB, 49 K... struggled in 2023 to 5.89 ERA due to 9 HR and 31 BB in 47 1/3 IP, though he struck out 70 batters... drafted following his fourth season at A&M... joined fellow Aggies Micah Dallas (8th round, 2022) and Nathan Dettmer (5th round, 2023) as Aggies drafted by the A's, and one of seven Aggies drafted overall in 2023... signed for \$150,000... notable Aggies in the pros include Chuck Knoblauch, Davey Johnson, Wally Moon, Michael Wacha, Ross Stripling and A.J. Minter.
