Fightin's Version

The Fightin Phils continue the first week of the season's second half with game five of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox at home. It is the eighth-of-nine matchups between the teams this season and fifth-of-six in Reading. The teams saw each other the first weekend of the season from Apr. 5-7 in Bowie. Reading won the first game, then dropped the final two contests at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie leads the season-series 4-3.

All too Well

The Fightin Phils rode multiple crooked numbers to a 10-3 win on Friday night over the Bowie Baysox. Reading got three runs in the bottom of the second thanks to a three-run home run from Ethan Wilson. The R-Phils then put up five-more runs in the bottom of the fifth in an innings that featured a home run from Marcus Lee Sang and Robert Moore. Reading then added two more in the seventh to jump up 10-3. Robinson Pina went six innings and allowed two runs, with six strikeouts en route to his team-best ninth win of the season. The Fighitn Phils put up a season-best eight extra-base hits in the win, while also with the win, Reading clinched a winning month of June as the R-Phils are 13-10 this month with two games left to play.

Hitting Home Runs in "Style"

After hitting three home runs on Friday night, Reading continues its season-high with home runs in 13 games in a row. This comes after also hitting home runs in seven-straight games from June 4-11. The only game since June 4 Reading has not hit a home run in was June 12, so they have homered in 20-of-21 games. The 13-game home run streak is Reading's longest such streak since homering in 13-straight games from June 21-July 3. of the 2019 season. Dating back to the 2005 season, the Fightin Phils have not homered in 14 games in a row.

A Pina Love Story

Fightin Phils Ace Robinson Pina earned the win with six innings of two-run ball on Friday night. Pina has been stellar in June, posting a 4-0 record, and 2.51 ERA, over five starts. That included a seven-inning, complete-game shutout on June 8 vs Harrisburg. It was a start that won him Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors. Pina holds the lead for the most wins in the Eastern League with nine. His other Eastern League ranks are: 8th ERA (3.46), 8th SO (76), T-1st CG (1), T-1st SHO (1) and T-2nd WPCT (.800). Pina currently sits second in the Eastern League with an 8.44 strikeout-to-walk ratio on the season. The only player ahead of him is Lachlan Wells at 8.83. Matt Osterberg also ranks fifth at 3.50. Amongst qualified Eastern League pitchers, Pina's 10.11 strikeout-per-nine ratio ranks eighth.

Enchanted Marcus

With a hit last night, Marcus Lee Sang is currently riding an active team-best 13-game on-base streak. It also is his personal-best on-base streak for the season. He also had a 12-game on-base streak from Apr. 26 to May 12. Over his current 13-game on-base streak, Lee Sang is slashing .264/.310/.528, with an .838 OPS. He's added 10 runs, two doubles, four home runs and nine RBI over the streak, dating back to June 12.

No More Home Run "Blank Space" For Wilson

Ethan Wilson homered on Friday night for the second-straight game. Prior to his first home run of the season on Thursday night, Wilson had gone 53-straight games without hitting a home run, with his last coming on Aug. 31, 2023, at home against New Hampshire.

Bowie enters tonight after finishing in fifth place in the Eastern League's Southwest Divison for the first half with a 32-36 record. They are second in the Southwest Division with a 2-2 record in the second half of the season. Bowie most recently dropped five-of-six at home against the Altoona Curve. Following this week, Bowie heads home for three against Richmond, then three at the Flying Squirrels. Bowie's roster features nine players ranked amongst the Baltimore Orioles' top-30 prospects: Samuel Basallo (2), Dylan Beavers (7), Seth Johnson (10), Jud Fabian (12), Max Wagner (14), Trace Bright (16), John Rhodes (23), Alex Pham (24) and Frederick Benscome (27).

The Anti-Hero

Righty Cameron Weston makes the start tonight for Bowie. This season Weston is is 2-5, with a 3.13 ERA over 10 appearances and six starts (37.1 IP, 25 H, 13 BB, 47 SO). Weston last pitched June 23 against Altoona and took the loss over three innings. He allowed three runs, but just one-earned, on six hits, with one walk and two strikeouts against the Curve. Weston made four starts with High-A Abeerden to start the season, going 1-0, with a 0.54 ERA over four starts, before getting called up on Apr. 30. He split 2023 between the FCL-Orioles and Aberdeen, going 3-1, with a 3.35 ERA over 13 games and three starts. Baltiomore drafted him in the eighth round of the 2022 draft out of Michigan. Weston is from Canonsburg, PA, which is just outside of Pittsburgh.
