DE LOS SANTOS WALKS IT OFF: The Delmarva Shorebirds evened the series with the Augusta GreenJackets and won their first game of the second half with a 4-3, come-from-behind victory in ten innings. After falling behind 1-0 in the third, the Shorebirds tied the game on an infield single by **Angel Tejada** to make it 1-1. The GreenJackets took the lead back with two runs in the sixth, but the Shorebirds slowly worked their way back with a solo home run by **Brayan Hernandez** in the seventh followed by a sacrifice fly by **Noelberth Romero** in the eighth to score the tying run. After both teams left a runner in scoring position in the ninth, the game was forced into extras where **Hugo Beltran** set the table for Delmarva by pitching a scoreless tenth. **Anderson De** Los Santos then won the game with one out in the bottom half with a single into left, completing the comeback win to force a rubber match on Sunday

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Alfred Vega toes the slab for the final game of the series against Augusta and he'll face right-hander **Jared Johnson**. Johnson was selected by the Braves in the 14th round of Smithville High School in Mississippi in 2019. He mostly pitched in Augusta in 2021 but missed all of 2022 with an injury. The right-hand-er has mostly worked as a bullpen arm but has slowly been integrated as a starter as he has began the game in his last two outings.

BACK LIKE HE NEVER LEFT: Trendon Craig has had an instant impact for the for the Shorebirds since rejoining the team on June 9 after two months on the IL. In 11 games since returning, Craig has a batting average of .317 (13/41) and has collected 4 doubles, a triple, 2 home runs, and 6 RBI, while also stealing 5 bases. Craig has the longest on-base run by a Shorebirds this season of 16 games that was snapped on Friday against Augusta.

MOVING UP THE LADDER: Samuel Basallo's strong first season in affiliated baseball has elevated him to inside the Top 100 overall prospects for Baseball America as he comes in at No. 80 on the mid-season list. Basallo is now ranked the No. 7 prospect in a deep, Oriole's farm system and he is one of eight Baltimore prospects currently in the top 100.

GETTING OVER THE HUMP: The Shorebirds have played in a lot of close games this season and will look for better fortunes in the second half. Through the first 67 games, Delmarva is 4-11 in one-run games and are 5-33 in games where they are either tied or behind after seven innings. The Shorebirds are also 2-5 in extra innings, scoring just one run in extras in those five losses combined.

STARTING FRESH: Delmarva will look to turn the page into the second half after a tough ending to the first. The Shorebirds entered May 28 down just one game in the standings but since then are 5-18, the worst mark in the league in that span, falling to 12 games behind first-half champion Down East.

CLEANING UP THE DEFENSE: Since May 9, the Shorebirds defense has been up-and-down as they've committed a Carolina league-high 63 errors. Those 63 hiccups in the field have resulted in 37 unearned runs, also the most in the league during in that span.

ANOTHER ONE GOES UP: Starting pitcher Juan Nunez is the latest Delmarva player to earn a promotion to High-A Aberdeen. He is now the sixth member of the Shorebirds' Opening Day Roster to move up, joining Jack-son Holliday, Maxwell Costes, Creed Willems, Douglas Hodo, and Reese Sharp.

LET'S TURN IT AROUND: The Shorebirds are hoping to get back on track with the second half set to begin this week against a team that had their number in 2022, the Augusta GreenJackets. Last season, the affiliate of the Atlanta Braves were 11-1 against the Shorebirds including a six-game sweet at Perdue Stadium in early August.

TODAY'S STARTER: Alfred Vega draws the start in the series finale as the Shorebirds look to secure a series win against Augusta on Sunday.

LAST OUTING (6/18 @ SAL): Vega took the last time out as a reliever as the Red Sox jumped on him for four runs in his first inning of work in the fifth to put the Shorebirds behind and snap an 18.1 scoreless innings streak Vega had going. After allowing the four runs in the fifth, Vega did not allow any in the next two.

vs. AUGUSTA: This will be the first time Vega will face the Augusta GreenJackets.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched just 7 times last season and twice as a starter for the Yankees FCL team in Tampa. Gave up just 2 earned runs in 15.2 innings and struck out 22 compared to 4 walks. Was left unprotected as a Rule-5 eligible player where he was then selected by the Orioles last December

HOME COOKING: Alfred Vega has thrived this season at home as own an ERA of 0.77 at Perdue Stadium, allowing just 1 earned run in 11.2 innings. He has pitched mostly on the road this season, but Vega's only earned run allowed in Salisbury this year came in relief against the Salem Red Sox on April 26.



FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019. He is the brother of current Oakland A's Outfielder J.J. Bleday.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

HITTING COACH



Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.

Collin Murray is the Shorebirds Development Coach and this is his second season as a coach in Delmarva and in the Orioles' organization.
