### Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 293-275 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints scored the first run of the game, which would go as their only run in an 11-1 loss to Columbus on Friday night. Yunior Severino drove in the Saints' lone run with an RBI double, breaking the single-season franchise record. The Clippers then scored two runs in the fourth, three in the fifth and blew it open with a six-run sixth inning. The Saints went without a hit from the third through the seventh innings. Austin Martin went 2-for-3 in his first game back with St. Paul after being optioned from the Major Leagues.
