Taking the Show on the Road

The Fightin Phils continue a two-week road trip on Thursday night at the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is the 15th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and ninth-of-12 at Mirabito Stadium. Binghamton leads the season-series 8-6.

Looking Back

The Fightin Phils dropped the second game of this week's series 3-2, thanks to a two-run ninth inning from the Rumble Ponies. Reading scored a run in the second and another in the sixth to grab a 2-1 advantage, with both of the R-Phils' runs coming on groud-ball double plays. Christian McGowan was strong on the mound, allowing just one-unearned run over four innings, while allowing two hits, three walks and striking out five. Konnor Ash (2 IP) and Andrew Walling (1.1 IP) each had scoreless outings in relief. Cristian Hernandez cleaned up a jam in the eighth inning, but surrendered two runs in the ninth to take the loss.

Mr. Otto-Matic

Otto Kemp's on-base streak reached 20 games following a base hit in the ninth inning of Wednesday night's game at Binghamton. Kemp became the first Fightin Phils to surpass a 20-game on-base streak since Oliver Dunn had a 22-game on-base streak from May 26 through June 22, of 2023. Carlos De La Cruz also had a 38-game on-base streak from May 12-June 25, of 2023.

Like Jordan, Going Back-to-Back-to-Back

The Fightin Phils hit three-straight home runs in the bottom of the fifth inning in last Saturday night's game against the Fisher Cats. Gabriel Rincones Jr. (10) launched a solo shot, then Otto Kemp (10) homered and Trevor Schwecke (5) followed with a blast to left. It was the first time Reading homered in three-straight at bats since June 7, 2016 at Akron. It was done by Jorge Alfaro, Dylan Cozens and Rhys Hoskins. Reading also homered for three times in an inning for the third time this season, with all of those instances coming after the All-Star Break.

Fresh Prospect Rankings

MLB Pipeline released their newsest prospect rankings last week. Seven members of the current Reading roster were included in within the Phillies Top-30 Prospects: Justin Crawford (3), Gabriel Rincones Jr. (11), Jean Cabrera (13), Christian McGowan (22), Caleb Ricketts (24), Moises Chace (26) and Otto Kemp (28). Cabrera and Kemp are new to the rankings after not being ranked at the begining of the season. Five former Fightin Phils were in the top-30 as well: Andrew Painter (2), Mick Abel (6), Seth Johnson (15), Griff McGarry (21) and Carlos De La Cruz (25). The Phillies also had four prospects included amongst the MLB Top 100: Aidan Miller (29), Andrew Painter (34), Justin Crawford (58) and Starlyn Caba (90).

New Arms Looking Strong

The Fightin Phils have had a trio of new starters added to their rotation over the last month who have all found early success. Eiberson Castellano who will start on Sunday, won his Double-A debut on July 21 at Portland and has turned in two quality starts so far. Castellao has gone five innings in all of his outings, not allowing more than two-earned runs. He also struck out 10 hitters in his last start this past Sunday against New Hampshire. Saturday's starter Moises Chace won his Double-A debut after allowing just one run over five innins. Chace was acquired, along with Seth Johnson for Gregory Soto from the Baltimore Orioles. Thursday night's starter Braeden Fausnaught went five-strong innings in his Double-A debut last Wednesday against New Hampshire. Fausnaught is from nearby Danville, which is 71 miles away from Reading. He also played his college baseball at West Chester University, which is 45 miles from Baseballtown.

Up Next

After this week, the Fightin Phils remain on the road and head to Somerset to take on the Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 22, 2014: At Reading, the Fightin Phils improve to 10-2 in extra-inning games by beating Erie, 4-3, in 12. Raywilly Gomez hits a 2-run homer, his only HR of the season, to tie the game in the 9th before Peter Lavin's RBI single wins it in the 12th.

Rumbling Into Binghamton

Binghamton enters tonight after finishing in second place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 35-32 record. They are fourth in the Northeast Division with a 24-22 record in the second half of the season. Binghamton most recently dropped five-of-six at home against Portland. Following this week, Binghamton goes to Hartford. Binghamton's roster features five players ranked amongst the New York Mets' top-30 prospects: Jett Williams (2), Ryan Clifford (4), Nolan McLean (9), Kevin Parada (25) and Alex Ramirez (26).

Ponies Pitche

Righty Jonathan Pintaro makes his third start at the Double-A level tonight. So far, Pintaro is 1-2, with a 4.63 ERA over three starts. On Aug. 16 vs Portland, he allowed three-earned runs over six innings, with five strikeouts, in a loss. He went 0-3, with a 2.50 ERA over nine games and seven starts with High-A Brooklyn, prior to his call-up to Double-A. Pintaro signed with the Mets in June of this season. The 26-year old spent 2023 with the Glacier Ranger Riders in the Pioneer League, going 5-6, with a 6.95 ERA. He played collegiately at Shorter University in Rome, Georgia, from 2017-22.
