- TWO SCOOPS
  The Daytona Tortugas will play their third official doubleheader of the 2021 season on Thursday evening against the Clearwater Threshers:

  In their first official twinbill of the campaign on May 7 at Palm Beach, Daytona split the two affairs.

  The Cardinals took game one at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, 3-1, thanks to a two-run bottom of the fifth.

  Daytona took the nightcap, 5-2... Tugas scored four runs in the top of the seventh to rally and emerge victorious.

  In their second, they split a pair of contests at Clover Park in St. Lucie on May 29.

  In 2019, the Tortugas appeared in eight official doubleheader games, accumulating an impressive 6-2 record.

  Daytona swept double-dips at Florida on April 20 and vs. Lakeland on July 13.

  This is the first official doubleheader between the Tortugas and Threshers since they split one at Jackie Robinson Ballpark on May 20, 2019.

  Daytona took game one, 4-3, while Clearwater reeled in the nightcap by the same final, 4-3.

- A SLICE OF SEMINATI
  Tortugas IF/OF Leo Seminati has caught fire at the plate during the season's second month:

   Since snapping an O-for-13 skid at the dish on June 3, the 22-year-old has hit .303 (10-33) with a .303/.410/.545 slashline in addition to a .956 OPS.

   Over his last 10 games, Seminati has scored 7 runs, and picked up 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 9 RBI, and 6 walks.

   The Bergamo, Lombardy, Italy native leads the team in OPS (.956) in that span...He is also second in batting average (.303), slugging percentage (.545), tied for second in RBI (9) and home runs (2), third in on-base percentage (.410), and tied for third in extra-base hits (4).

- HOP ABOARD THE GUS BUS

  INF Gus Steiger had a season-high 9-game on-base streak snapped in game two on last Wednesday, but has reached in 12-of-13 contests:

   Dating back to June 3, the 22-year-old has tallied a .326 batting average (14-43) with a .326/, 453/,349 slashline in addition to providing a .802 OPS.

- GREEN WOLF
  Daytona C/DH Garrett Wolforth has been a catalyst at the middle of the Tortugas lineup over the last several contests

   Wolforth enters Thursday on team season-high 11-game hitting streak...During the stretch that began on June 8, the switch-hitter has registered a .326 clip (14-43) with a .326, .333/.605 slashline, adding a .938 OPS.

   During the streak, Wolforth has garnered 9 runs scored, 4 doubles, 2 triples, a home run, 9 RBI, and a walk.

   In 17 games for the "Tugas in June, the 23-year-old has a team-best 14 RBI...Wolforth has collected a .284 average (19-67) with a team-high 13 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, and 3 home runs.

  Since Wolforth's batting average dipped to a season-low, 121 (4-33) on May 25, the switch-hitter has slashed 2.82/, 319/, 567 over 19 games with 14 runs scored, 12 extra-base hits, 3 home runs, and 15 RBI...He has raised his batting average 109 points (.121 to .231) in the last 29 days.

- MARRERO'S MONSTER MASH
  Like Triana, OF Wendell Marrero had a sluggish beginning to the 2021 campaign and has since caught fire over the last several games:

   Since Daytona's 1-0 no-hitter of Jupiter on May 22, the 20-year-old enters Thursday with a .315/.451/.493 slashline over his previous 24 contests,
- In that span, Marrero has scored 19 runs, posted 7 extra-base hits, 2 home runs, driven in 9 tallies, drawn 15 walks, and been hit by a pitch thrice.
   Dating back to May 22, the Dorado, P.R. native is tied for the lead among all Low-A Southeast hitters in triples (2)...Additionally, Marrero is fourth in on-base percentage (.451), fifth in batting average (.315), seventh in OPS (.944), and 10th in slugging percentage (.493).
   In his first 10 contests this season, Marrero was 2-for-36 at the plate (.056) with 3 runs, 2 doubles, and an RBI.

## CLASS WITH PROFESSOR PROCTOR

- Minor League Baseball announced on June 2 that Tortugas RHP James Proctor has been named the Low-A Southeast Pitcher of the Month for May.

   Proctor ignited Daytona's combined no-hitter of the Jupiter Hammerheads on Saturday, May 22, at Jackie Robinson Ballpark.
   Threw 5.0 innings of no-hit ball, allowing only two baserunners in the fourth on a walk and hit-by-pitch.
   RHP Vin Timpanelli, RHP Ricky Karcher, RHP Nick Hanson, and RHP Carson Spiers united over the final 4.0 frames to complete the bid.
   It was the Tortugas' second no-no and their first since RHP Tyler Mahle threw a 9.0-inning no-hitter at Jupiter on June 13, 2016.
   His 11 K's that night are the second-most from a Tortugas pitcher since the franchise rebranded prior to the start of the 2015 season.

CONTRASTING STYLES
Through the first month-plus of the season, the Daytona Tortugas have played 24 home and 19 road games. However, the results at Jackie Robinson Ballpark have had a stark contrast in comparison to what the team has done in visiting ballparks.
