RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (30-15) **Modesto Nuts (28-17)**





RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (0-1, 5.02 ERA) vs. LHP Harold Melenge (1-2, 5.22 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their longest road trip of the year, as they take on the Modesto Nuts (SEA), the two-time defending Cal League Champions, in the first game of a six-game set and game seven of a 12-game, 13day road trip. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 3rd to face the San Jose Giants. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE NUTS: Today's game is the first of 12 against the Nuts and the first of six at John Thurman Field. In 2024, the Quakes went just 2-10 against the Nuts, 1-5 here in Modesto. In 2023, they went 3-6, just 1-5 here in Modesto. The last time the Quakes won a series here in Modesto was in 2021, when they went 4-2.

LAST GAME: The Quakes got knocked around on Sunday, dropping a 10-3 decision to the Stockton Ports at Banner Island Ballpark. Jared Sprague-Lott (4) smacked a three-run homer as part of a six-run fourth to blow the game open, as the Ports took the series by winning four of six. Rancho starter Sterling Patick (0-2) suffered the loss, allowing three runs (two earned) on four hits over 2.1 innings. Stockton starter Donny Troconis (4-0) allowed one unearned run on three hits over five innings to notch the win. Eduardo Quintero had two hits and two runs scored to lead the offense.

ROSTER MOVES: Earlier, today, the Quakes activated C Gio Cueto from the Injured List. He takes the roster spot of C Angel Diaz, who was sent back to the Arizona Complex League. Also joining the Quakes is RHP Domingo Geronimo from Great Lakes. RHP Michael Vilchez (DEV LIST) and LHP Octavio Becerra (IL) also leave the roster. **SO LONG, MODESTO:** 2025 marks the final season of professional baseball in Modesto, CA. In 2026, the franchise rights will be moved to Ontario, CA. The city of Modesto has had professional baseball and has been a member of the California League since 1946. Modesto has won 11 Cal League titles, including the last two (2023-2024). They have

SERIES STUFF: The Quakes lost four of six in Stockton, giving them just their second series-loss of the year, both coming in Stockton. The series-loss snapped a streak of five straight series-wins. Rancho's series record is now 6-2-0. **DON'T WALK:** Rancho pitching struggled overall in the Stockton series, allowing 30 runs on 30 hits with 42 walks over the first 33 innings pitched (four games). On Sunday, the Quakes walked a series-low three batters, leaving them with 50 walks issued over 50 innings against the Ports. The Quakes now have an ERA of 3.78, second behind San Jose's 3.39. Rancho pitching now has 241 walks, third most in the league.

OH, WHAT A NIGHT!?! Jaron Elkins had a night to remember on Saturday, tying multiple career-marks. The first-year player had four hits for the second time in his career, five RBIs for the second time in his career and four runs scored for the second time. In addition, he enjoyed his first two-homer game and his first career grand slam. He also walked and stole two bases for good measure. He's now hitting .320 in the month of May, with 4 homers and 21 RBIs. HYUN-SEOK JANG: 21-year-old right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang makes his tenth start of the year, his first against Modesto. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run on one hit, but with three walks, while recording just two outs over 29 pitches (14 strikes) in the first inning of a no-decision at Stockton on May 21st. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 17th best prospect.

HAROLD MELENGE: 23-year-old left Harold Melenge makes his eighth start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run on five hits over four innings in a no-decision at Inland Empire on May 20th. Melenge signed with Seattle in December of 2018 out of Cali, Colombia.
