

LAST TIME OUT: Trailing and down to their final out, Brooklyn rallied to stun Wilmington, 3-1, on Friday night...With the bases empty and 2 out in the top of the 9th, 2B Chase Estep singled, 1B Mateo Gil walked, and SS Junior Tilien clobbered a go-ahead 3-run home run...RHP Dylan Tebrake entered with 2 on and nobody out in the bottom of the 9th...He received a caught stealing of third and tallied back-to-back strikeouts to earn the first save of his career...RHP Robert Colina tossed 3.0+ innings of scoreless relief for his first win...RHP Brendan Hardy, Colina, and Tebrake combined to throw 6.2 innings of 4-hit, 9-strikeout shutout relief in Brooklyn's win.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Brooklyn set a new mark for their longest winning streak of the season — tallying 5-straight wins — with a 3-1 victory at Wilmington on Friday...Prior to Friday, the Cyclones had 4-consecutive ballgames on 2 separate occassions...Most recently, Brooklyn captured 4-straight games from June 22-25 vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat in 2023 by taking 4 in-ar-ow at Hudson Valley from May 17 until Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...The 5-game streak is the longest for the 'Clones since they won 6-straight from September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn earned their 11th, 12th, and 13th come-from-behind victories of the 2023 season with 6-4, 9-3, and 3-1 wins over Wilmington on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday...Friday's win was Brooklyn's first in 2023 when trailing after 8 innings...It marked the 'Clones first victory when trailing after 8 frames since August 14, 2022, at Wilmington...Brooklyn erased a 5-4 deficit entering the 9th that night on a 2-run pinch-hit home run by C **Matt O'Neill**...The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on Tuesday, matching their largest deficit erased on the campaign...The 'Clones erased a 4-0 margin entering the 5th and a 4-1 deficit going into the 7th...Brooklyn also erased a 4-run ledger on Opening Day – April 7 – vs. Jersey Shore... The Cyclones trailed 4-0 after the 1st inning that day, ultimately topping the BlueClaws, 9-8, in 11 innings.

SUPER STAFF: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has posted an MiLB-low 2.71 ERA (123 ER in 409.0 IP) over their last 47 games, holding a 27-20 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (2.86) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 5 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.2% and a walk rate of 11.3%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching has permitted the fewest home runs (13) and hold the lowest opposing OPS (601), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.71) in that time period...RHPs **Blade Tidwell** (1.55) and **Tyler Stuart** (1.62) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 45.0 IP).

RED HOT RELIEF: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.11) in the entire South Atlantic League, and 3rd lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East leads (3.04) in MILB, while Hudson Valley (3.47) is 2nd in the circuit...RHP **Paul Gervase** (1.07) is 1st in ERA among SAL relievers (min. 30.0 IP).

JUNIOR MINT: INF Junior Tilien clubbed a go-ahead 3-run home run with 2 out in the 9th on Friday at Wilmington as part of a multi-hit night...The 20-year-old enters Saturday on a 7-game hitting streak dating back to June 28 vs. Jersey Shore...Tilien is 10-for-his-last-27 (.370) with 5 runs scored, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, and 2 walks...Tilien is slashing .370/.414/.704 with a 1.117 OPS and 197 wRC+ during the streak.

BEND, BUT NO TE-BRAKE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** earned his first career save on Friday at Wilmington and has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 13 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 1.23 ERA (3 ER in 22.0 IP) on 10 hits and 10 walks, registering 34 strikeouts (13.91 K/9)...That equates to 39.5 K% (34/86) and 11.6 BB% (10/86)...Since moving to a relief role, Tebrake is 2nd among SAL relievers (min. 20.0 IP) in opposing OPS (.381) and ERA (1.17), 3rd in strikeouts (36) and WHIP (0.87), and 4th in hits-per-9 innings (3.91), and strikeouts-per-9 innings (14.09).

CAPTAIN KEVIN: C Kevin Parada tied a career-high with 3 hits on Wednesday and has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .333/.398/.591 with a .989 OPS and 165 wRC+ in 24 games...Parada has accrued 14 runs scored, 3 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 17 RBI, 8 walks, and 2 hit-by-pitches...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Saturday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (17), 6th in hits (73), and 7th in extra-base hits (29) and total bases (122)...Since June 6, Parada is tied for 1st in triples (3), 3rd in slugging (.591), tied for 3rd in total bases (55), tied for 4th in batting average (.333) and OPS (.989), tied for 6th in hits (31) and extra-base hits (11), and 10th in on-base percentage (.338).

LOVE THE DRAKEI: C Drake Osborn has been unconscious at the plate through his first 3 games of Brooklyn's series in Wilmington...The 24-year-old matched a career-high in hits (3) in consecutive contests to open the set..Osborn is 7-for-13 (.538) so far against the Blue Rocks with 3 runs scored, 2 RBI, and a walk...Drake is on a 4-game hitting streak dating back to Monday and is 8-for-his-last-17 (.471).

AL-WAYS ON: OF Alex Ramírez is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in walks (21), 5th in pitchesper-plate appearance (4.155) and tied for 6th in runs scored (22), since the beginning of June (min. 120 PA)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Saturday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (69) and is 22 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark and suprassed IF/OF Jaylen Palmer (68) for 3rd on Wednesday...He is also 3rd in doubles (29), tied for 3rd in hits (125) with C José Mena, 5th in total bases (186), and 7th in runs scored (62).

total bases (186), and 7th in runs scored (62). **CUTTING 'EM DOWN:** RHP **Blade Tidwell** is amid his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old has tossed 4-straight quality starts dating back to June 17 at Aberdeen...Tidwell has earned the win in 3-of-4 outings with Brooklyn winning all 4 games...He has permitted just 4 runs on 16 hits over 26.0 innings...He has walked only 5 (5.2 BB%) and struck out 37 (38.5 K%) in those contests...Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on Thursday at Wilmington and last Friday vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after tied a thencareer-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 9 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 5-0 with a 1.55 ERA (8 ER in 46.1 IP) with just 26 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 25 and struck out 70 (37.6 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .161 batting average (26-161) against him... Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League and Minor League Baseball in batting average against (161) and is 2nd in strikeouts (70) and ERA (1.55) since that date (min. 40.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL, the Loretto, Tenn. native is 2nd in strikeouts (97) and batting average against (192), tied for 5th in wins (5), and 6th in ERA (3.48). vs. WILMINGTON: After a 2-week homestand, the Cyclones open up a 6-game road trip against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 7 of Washington's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: SS Brady House (3), LHP Jake Bennett (8), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (10), OF T.J. White (12), and RHP Andry Lara (15)...C Israel Pineda (19) and 2B Darren Baker (28) are on rehab assignments...Brooklyn and Wilmington are meeting at Frawley Stadium since May 9-14...Wilmington captured 5-of-7 games...In 2023, the Cyclones are 8-8 against the Blue Rocks through 2+ series...Dating back to 2021, the 'Clones are 34-32 (.515) all-time against the 'Rocks.

STU-PENDOUS: RHP Tyler Stuart earned his third victory in as many starts after a 6-inning, 2-run performance on Wednesday at Wilmington...He set career-highs in innings pitched (7.2) and strikeouts (11), in his start on June 22 vs. Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old was the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts in a single game since RHP Carson Seymour accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensbor...Stuart was also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP Conner Grey tossed 8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum was the first Cyclone to work 7.0+ innings and record 10+ strikeouts in a single game since LHP Kevin Canelon whiffed 10 over 8.0 frames at Hudson Valley on August 25, 2015...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.42)...Double-A Penacola's LHP Patrick Monteverde (1.93) is 2nd in the minors...The Kankakee, III. native leads the league in LOB% (87.4%), is 2nd in WHIP (1.04), 3rd in FIP (3.08), xFIP (3.49), and innings pitched (75.2), 5th in batting average against (.206), 7th in strikeouts (84), walk rate (76.8%), and strikeout rate (27.8%).

EXTRA! Brooklyn earned their 5th win in extra frames in 2023 with a 10-inning triumph at Wilmington on Thursday...The win snapped the Cyclones' 6-game losing streak in extra-inning affairs...This came after Brooklyn started the season 4-1 in extra-inning games...Brooklyn's previous victory in added frames also came at Frawley Stadium...The Cyclones defeated the Blue Rocks, 5-4, in 11 innings on May 9...Overall, the 'Clones are 5-7 in 12 extra-inning contests this season.

LOST IN THE 'CORN': RHP Joshua Cornielly has hit his stride over the last 2-plus months for the Cyclones' bullpen...Since allowing 5 runs in 0.1 innings on April 15 at Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has been as consistent as any relief arm on the staff...Dating back to April 21 vs. Wilmington, Cornielly holds a 2-1 record with a 1.88 ERA (6 ER in 28.2 IP) in 15 appearances (1 start)...The Caraças, Venezuela native has permitted 24 hits, walked 10 (8.4 BB%), and struck out 35 (29.4 K%)...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with one or fewer starts since that date, Cornielly ranks 3rd in the league in ERA (1.88) trailing only Bowling Green's RHP **Nate Dahle** (1.08) and teammate RHP **Paul Gervase** (1.32)...He is also 6th in walk-to-strikeout rate (.286) and walks-per-9 innings (3.14) in that span.

HIT 'EM UP: Brooklyn tallied a season-best 16 hits in Wednesday's 9-3 victory over Wilmington...8-of-9 Cyclone starters tallied at least 1 hit, while 6-of-9 registered multi-hit games...The team's previous season-high was 13 on 2 occasions, most recently on June 14 at Aberdeen...The 16 knocks were the most for the Cyclones since collected 16 hits in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022.

GARCÍA LATER: RHP Benito García has been as reliable as any Cyclones reliever over the last month...Dating back to June 9 vs. Greenville, the 23-year-old has tallied 6-consecutive scoreless relief appearances...In 71 innings, García has earned a save and permitted just 6 hits and 1 walk, while striking out 7...The right-hander holds a 25.9% strikeout rate (7/27) and 3.7% walk rate (1/27) during that span...In 10 relief outings with Brooklyn in 2023, García holds a 1.26 ERA (2 ER in 14.1 IP).

LUGO LAND: INF William Lugo has been on a tear for Brooklyn offensively over the last 2-plus weeks...Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .316/.400/.658 with a 1.058 OPS and 176 wRC+ over his last 11 games...Lugo is 12-for-38 at the plate (.316) with 2 doubles, a triple, 3 home runs, 10 RBI, 5 walks, and a hit-by-pitch in that span...The Dominican native has raised his season batting average by 26 points (.181 to .207) during that time.

OH MY, OMAR: OF Omar De Los Santos has 30 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 100 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in Mil.B...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valeder (106), Marlins farmhand INF Masim Núñez (103), Diacks prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (103), and Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (102) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 59 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 41...Omar is already 2 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

POWER OF PAUL: RHP Paul Gervase garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and has tossed 7-straight scoreless outings since that date (12.0 IP)...Gervase averages 13.90 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.9% strikeout rate for the season...Since June 9, the numbers have ballooned to 16.50 K/9 and a 44.9% strikeout rate.


MARATHON MEN: Brooklyn is in the midst of their longest stretch without an off day for the 2023 season...The Cyclones will play 12 games in 12 days from Wednesday, June 28, until Sunday, July 9... Brooklyn completes their 2-week homestand with a 6-game series at Maimonides Park vs. Jersey Shore until Monday, July 3...The 'Clones then travel south to Wilmington for a 6-game set at Frawley Stadium against the Blue Rocks starting on Tuesday, July 4...So far, Brooklyn is 7-3 during the stretch...Following the 12 games in 12 days, Brooklyn will have a 4-day break for the Major League All-Star Game before returning to Coney Island on Friday, July 14, to open up a brief 3-game home series vs. Greensboro.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on June 14...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), and RHP Tyler Stuart (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...ln all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision on Sunday afternoon vs. Jersey Shore...Allowed 4 runs on 5 hits over 1.2 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 3...Tossed 2 wild pitches... Threw 41 pitches and 25 strikes (60.98%)...Relieved by RHP Joshua Cornielly with a man at 2nd, 2 out, and Brooklyn trailing, 4-1...Cyclones rallied to take the lead in the bottom of the 8th...Game was delayed for an hour and 7 minutes in the top of the 9th...BlueClaws came back to defeat the Cyclones, 11-6.

YO-JOANDER: Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old set a new-career-high with 6+ innings of work in a June 20 defeat and added another scoreless inning in relief, earning the win on June 25...Suárez allowed just 1 run on 2 hits, walking 3 and striking out a season-high-matching 8 on June 20...Over a 3 appearance (2 start) stretch from June 14-25, Suárez posted a 1-1 record and a 3.00 ERA (4 ER in 12.0 IP)...The Cumaná, Venezuela native punched out 16 and walked 6, allowing just 6 hits...Suárez held a rate of 12.0 strikeouts-per-9-innings and a strikeout rate of 33.3% (16/48) in that span.

PROSPECT RADAR: While not currently ranked, Suárez was deemed the Mets' No. 30 prospect entering the 2022 season by Baseball America...Considered the No. 25 farmhand entering 2021.

2022: Placed on Single-A St. Lucie's 60-day injured list to start the season...Sent on a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Mets on August 12...Tallied a 1-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER in 11.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in 6 games (3 starts)...Returned to St. Lucie on August 23...Registered an 0-2 mark with a 7.20 ERA (8 ER in 10.0 IP) and 13 K's in 4 appearances (2 starts).

COMEBACK TRAIL: Suárez is participating in his first full season since the 2019 campaign...The 23-year-old made 6 starts with Single-A St. Lucie in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in June...Made his return to play in game one of a doubleheader with the FCL Mets vs. the FCL Cardinals on July 14, 2022.
