TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for the last game of a six-game set, as your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes take on the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres). Earlier today, the Quakes hosted the second U.S. Bank Youth Clinic of the season, as with the purchase of a ticket to the game, local little leaguers received free baseball instruction from Quakes' players and coaches. After today's game, kids will "Run the Bases", thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: This is the ninth of 30 match-ups and the sixth of 15 here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 5-3 against the Storm in 2024, 4-1 here at home. Last season, the Quakes won the season-series (17-13), and were 11-7 at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: Rancho pitching struck out 17 hitters en route to a 7-4 win over the Lake Elsinore Storm on Saturday night at LoanMart Field. Edgardo Henriquez and Jose Rodriguez (3-0) each struck out six batters, while closer Reynaldo Yean fanned three in the ninth for his second save of the year. Offensively, Carlos Rojas had two hits and a run scored, while Logan Wagner ripped a two-run triple and scored a run. The victory for the Quakes is their fourth in five games of this series, giving Rancho the series win, regardless of today's outcome. Storm reliever Isaiah Lowe (0-1) took the loss in relief, allowing three runs over three-plus innings.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a roster move on Thursday, adding utility player Jefferson Valladares from the Arizona Complex League. On Tuesday, Rancho moved OF Cameron Decker to the Arizona Complex League and added former 2023 sixth-round pick Logan Wagner to the 30-man roster.

BANGED UP: For all the winning the Quakes have done recently, it's certainly come at a price. Jose De Paula, Joe Vetrano and Jesus Galiz have all left games in this series and are nursing injuries. While none of the three have been officially placed on the Injured List, they aren't available to play either. Next week should provide clarity to all their respective injury situations.

FIRE UP THE HEAT AFTER A COLD NIGHT: Friday night's loss stopped a season-best seven straight wins, but Rancho rebounded last night with another win, making them 12-2 in their last 14 games. The seven-game winning streak was also the longest in the league this year. Last night's win matches their largest division lead this year at four.

PEREZ PLAYER OF THE WEEK: For the second time in as many weeks to start the year, the Quakes have had an offensive player recognized as Cal League Player of the Week. Jeral Perez was named this week's winner, after hitting .360 (9-for-25) with three home runs and eight RBIs last week against Inland Empire. Jake Gelof was recognized as the league's Player of the Week after the first full week of the season.

CAM DAY: Cam Day will make his second start and fourth appearance of the year, his second outing and first start against Lake Elsinore. In his last outing and only appearance against Lake Elsinore, he allowed just one hit and three walks over 4.1 innings of scoreless baseball, earning his first professional win this past Tuesday at LoanMart Field. Day signed as an undrafted free agent with the Dodgers, after playing collegiately at the University of Utah.

SAM WHITING: Righty Sam Whiting will make his first appearance with the Storm this year, after opening up the year with three games (one start) with High-A Fort Wayne of the Midwest League. He went 0-0 with a 1.35 ERA in those three games, allowing just one run over 6.2 innings. Whiting made seven relief appearances (1-0, 2.35 ERA) for the Storm last year, after being drafted by San Diego in the 16th round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Santa Barbara.
