TODAY marks game #14 of the 2024 season, the 5th game of a six-game roadtrip, and the 5th game a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 24 times during the 2023 regular season, with the Loons winning the season series 13-11. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 31st season in professional baseball, while the Loons are in their 18th year of professional baseball affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers.

UP NEXT: The 'Caps return home for a rematch of Opening Weekend, but this time on their home turf to begin a six-game series at LMCU Ballpark against the Lake County Captains at LMCU Ballpark from April 23-28 before concluding the month with a six-game road set at Day Air Ballpark against the Dayton Dragons from April 30-May 5.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

WHITECAPS FALL TO LOONS, 5-4: The West Michigan Whitecaps carried a lead into the seventh inning but couldn't hold it as part of a 5-4 loss to the Great Lakes Loons Friday night at Dow Diamond. The 'Caps finished the seventh inning stretch with a 4-2 lead, but a three-run Great Lakes surge marked the third late-inning Loons comeback in the first four games of this series, helping the Loons climb back above .500. The Whitecaps gave Great Lakes the lead in the first inning when Alex Freeland connected for a solo home run to begin the contest with a 1-0 Loons lead. In the second, infielder Peyton Graham, making his first career appearance as a center fielder, delivered the lead with a two-run double and a 2-1 'Caps edge. In the third, Kyle Nevin knotted the contest at two with a run-scoring two-out triple, but the next inning saw the 'Caps regain the lead. Back-to-back doubles from Andrew Jenkins and Luke Gold highlighted a two-run fourth and a 4-2 'Caps advantage. In the seventh, the Loons rallied for three runs, highlighted by a run-scoring double from Freeland, to take a 5-4 lead. The rally marks the third time in the four games of this series that Great Lakes has erased a 'Caps lead against the West Michigan bullpen, and the first time it led to a Loons win. Great Lakes reliever Brandon Neeck (1-0) tossed 1.1 scoreless frames in earning his first win of the 2024 season, while 'Caps pitcher Max Alba (0-1) gave up the three Loons runs in taking his first loss of the season. Kelvin Ramirez tossed a scoreless ninth to record his first save of the season. West Michigan drops to 6-7 while the Loons jump to 7-6. West Michigan outfielders Seth Stephenson and Cole Turney missed the contest with unspecified injuries and are considered day-to-day.

GETTING BLANKED: The Whitecaps pitching staff collected a Midwest League-best 15 shutouts of their opponents this season, with the last one occurring on August 20 in a 5-0 win over the South Bend Cubs at LMCU Ballpark. The 'Caps also hold the Midwest League record for shutouts in a season with 27 back in 2017. They also began the 2024 season with a 2-0 blanking of the Lake County Captains at Classic Park in the first game of a doubleheader on April 7.

SWING FOR THE FENCES: The Whitecaps totaled 109 home runs last season - breaking the franchise record of 101 set in 2022.

In his senior campaign with Valparaiso, Fields was named All-MVC second-team - ranking second in the country in strikeouts per nine innings (14.08) and top-15 in the NCAA in overall strikeouts (110).

LAST APPEARENCE: Fields posted just two innings of scoreless baseball while striking out two as part of a 5-2 loss to the Quad Cities River Bandits on April 14 at LMCU Ballpark.

2023: After pitching just three scoreless innings with the Rookie League Tigers to begin the season, Fields found his groove in low-A Lakeland - going 5-0 with a 3.38 ERA while tallying 51 strikeouts through 45.1 innings pitched and missing a ton of barrels - with opposing hitters batting just .194 on the season.

2022 (Senior): In his senior season at Valparaiso, Fields began to separate himself as one of the best strikeout pitchers in college baseball, punching out 110 batters through 73.2 innings pitched - earning All-MVC Second Team honors before signing with Detroit on July 26, 2022.

2021 (Junior): Fields made his first big impression when he became just the eighth pitcher in program history to complete a no hitter and the first in 29 years - striking out ten batters vs Middle Tennessee State on March 13th. The performance was enough to earn him the Valparaiso University Male Performance of the Year Award as part of the athletic departments annual awards.

More: Helped Libertyville High School to two regional championships while becoming a two-time all-conference and all-area selection. Honor roll all four years of high school. His father Timm was a 1990 Valpo graduate who also played baseball for the Crusaders. His favorite movie is Straight Outta Compton and his favorite TV Show is The Office.

Scouting Report: Fields brings a low-90s fastball that has "cutter" movement to it, as well as a high spin curveball. The cutter-curveball combination was something that was very difficult for batters at the low-A level to catch up on.
