Happy Birthday! Today is the 22nd birthday for both the Lugnuts' leadoff hitter and center fielder, **Rodney Green, Jr.**, and yesterday's starting pitcher, **Gage Jump**.

Down the Ladder: While the Athletics' and Dodgers' High-A Midwest League affiliates battle this weekend in Lansing, their Single-A California League affiliates are also meeting up. The Stockton Ports, the A's Single-A squad, had beaten the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes in three straight games before allowing three runs in the ninth yesterday in a 5-4 loss. Remember the name **Wei-En Lin** as a future Lugnut; the 19-year-old Ports starter struck out eight batters and walked none while allowing one run in five innings.

Up the Ladder: Former Lugnut **Jacob Wilson** (2023 in Lansing) extended his hitting streak to an MLB-high 14 games with an RBI single in the A's 7-6 loss last night to the Mets. Wilson's 20 hits are tied for most in the Majors, and his .377 batting average ranks second in the American League.

Patience at the Plate: OF Jared Dickey drew two more walks last night, giving him six walks this week and eight walks this season, tied for 3rd in the Midwest League. The Nuts drew seven walks as a team while striking out only three times and now lead the MWL with 43 walks (averaging six per game) while only striking out 55 times (tied for 2nd fewest in the league).

In Command: In contrast, Lansing's pitching staff is 3rd in the Midwest League in fewest walks allowed (28) and is tied for 1st in the Midwest League in fewest home runs allowed (2).

It's All in the Timing: Credit the Lugnuts for their consistency. After playing games lasting 2:29 and 2:31 to open the season in Fort Wayne, the Nuts and Loons have played 2:32 and 2:31 the last two nights. Who's up for a two-and-a-half-hour-long game today?

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 14 and Green is No. 20. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 30.

Welcome Back: The Lugnuts' roster features 17 returning players, from position players Jonny Butler, Cole Conn, Jared Dickey, Clark Elliott, Joshua Kuroda-Grauer, Nate Nankil, CJ Rodriguez, T.J. Schofield-Sam and Casey Yamauchi to pitchers Mark Adamiak, Hunter Breault, Jake Garland, Garrett Irvin, Grant Judkins, Blaze Pontes and Yehizon Sanchez.

Atop the Minors: 2024 Athletics first-rounder **Nick Kurtz** jumped over Lansing on his way up A's system and is currently excelling with Triple-A Las Vegas. Kurtz leads Minor League Baseball with 6 home runs, 12 extra-base hits, 44 total bases and 20 RBIs. Additionally, former Lugnut **Grant Holman** is tied for the MiLB lead with three saves.

APRIL 11TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: A day after allowing eight runs in the seventh inning at Fort Wayne, the Lugnuts exploded for 11 runs in the seventh to blow out the TinCaps, 13-4. The first 12 Nuts all reached base in the inning, six against reliever Henry Henry and six against reliever Spencer Kulman, including seven walks and two Henry balks. The Nuts drew 13 walks in total. It was the third time in franchise history that the Lugnuts had scored 11 runs in an inning.

2022: Pinch-hitter Jonny Butler's RBI single in the ninth had forced extra innings at West Michigan, and then Butler struck again with a tie-breaking single in the 11th to spark a four-run rally, seemingly pushing the Nuts to a thrilling victory at their archrival. But the Whitecaps tallied five runs in the bottom of the 11th against Daniel Martinez, winning the game on a Wenceel Pérez two-run double, 11-10.

2024: The Lugnuts drew ten walks, six from Great Lakes prospect Jackson Ferris in 3 2/3 innings (including three consecutive walks in the first inning to force in a run), and stomped the Loons 9-3 on a night that featured winds gusting at 23 mph.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball - the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

19-year-old Steven Echavarria is part of an exclusive club: players who suited up for the Lugnuts as teenagers. Future Major Leaguers include 19-year-old Max Muncy, who joined the Nuts for the final 42 games of 2022; 19-year-old Gabriel Moreno, who homered in his first Lugnuts at-bat in 2019; and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. and Bo Bichette, who were 18 and 19 respectively when they dominated the 2017 Midwest League and appeared in the Futures Game.

Path to Lansing: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... vs. right-handers: .306/.386/.387, 1 HR, 5 GiDP... vs. left-handers: .316/.431/.474, 3 HR, 1 GiDP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
