CROOKS, BUCHBERGER LEAD CARDS TO 8-2 DEFEAT OF TRAVS: Jimmy Crooks went 3-for-4 falling a triple short of the cycle, Jacob Buchberger had two hits including a home run and Quinn Mathews allowed just 1 H over 5.1 innings in his Double-A debut as the Cardinals snapped a three-game skid with an 8-2 win over the Arkansas Travelers on Sunday evening at Hammons Field. Dakota Harris also had two hits for Springfield, and Crooks and Buchberger hit back-to-back home runs in the 6th inning. The Cardinals scored 4 runs in the bottom of the 8th inning to break open a two-run game.



OPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander **Tyson Guerrero** makes his 12th start (14th appearance) of the season in the series opener for the Naturals...Last pitched on Wednesday, June 26 at Wichita and took the loss allowing 5 ER on 7 H with 4 K over 5.0 IP...Best start of the season came against the Cardinals on June 14 at Hammons Field, firing 6.0 scoreless frames allowing just 4 H with 3 K...In 2 starts against Springfield is 1-1 with a 1.64 ERA with 10 K and 1 BB while allowing 9 H in 11.0 IP...Made 3 starts with the Naturals at the end of the 2023 sesaon and went 1-2 with a 6.55 ERA...Began 2023 at High-A Quad Cities going 2-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 18 appearances (17 starts), racking up 106 K to just 29 BB in 84.1 IP...Limited to just 6 starts with Quad Cities in 2022 because of shoulder injuries...Made 9 appearances between the ACL and Low-A Columbia in 2021...Selected by the Royals in the 12th round of the 2021 draft out of Washington...Went 3-3 with a 2.96 ERA in his redshirt sophomore season with the Huskies...Pitched at Lower Columbia CC in 2020...Was a two-way player at Washington State as a freshman in 2019, going 1-2 with a 3.63 ERA in 19 appearances while hitting .277 with 2 HR and 5 2B in 94 AB...25 years old

CARDINALS LOOK TO FLIP SCRIPT ON NATURLAS: The Cardinals head to Springdale to start a split six-game series against the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (Double-A, Kansas City Royals). The Naturals have had the Cardinals' number in 2024, winning 10 of the 12 matchups between the two this season including each of the last eight.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

NDDDDDDDDT: For the 2nd time during the 2024 season, Cardinals OF **Lars Nootbaar** is rehabbing with Springfield. He has been on the IL with St. Louis since May 31 with an oblique strain. **Nootbaar** appeared in one game for Springfield on April 9 rehabbing from fractured ribs, going 1-for-4 with an RBI and 2 runs scored before being activated by St. Louis on April 11. In 5 games with Triple-A Memphis at the start of the season, he went 3-for-17 with a 2B. **Nootbaar** is batting .234 with 5 HR and 19 RBI to go along with 7 2B and a .741 OPS in 39 big league games this season.

Two games into his current rehab stint with Springfield, **Nootbaar** is 2-for-6 with a home run.

RDAD WARRIDRS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have been the best team in the Texas League away from home. Springfield has a league-best 24-14 record on the road this season and have the 2nd-best road ERA at 3.62, just 0.05 behind Frisco and tops in the North Division. Remarkably, the 10 teams of the Texas League have combined to put together a winning road record at 188-186.

Home games for the Cards, however, have been a different story. Depite an 8-2 win over Arkansas in the series finale on Sunday, the Cardinals have dropped 11 of their last 13 and 22 of their last 29 games at Hammons Field. The Cards began the season winning their first 8 home games. Springfield's last consecutive wins at home came May 24-25 against the Tulsa Drillers. Overall the Cardinals have the 2nd-worst home record in the league at 15-22 and the highest home ERA at 5.90.

ONE-SIDED SERIES: During their six-game series against the Naturals this week, the Cardinals will be looking to turn things around against their North Division rival. The Birds are just 2-10 against NW Arkansas this season, including the only sweep Springfield has endured this season. The Naturals have doubled up the Cardinals so far this season, outscoring Springfield 82-41.

GRINDIN': Simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 526 whiffs in 75 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (504 K in 75 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.01 K's per game. The Cardinals this week are up against the top strikeout staff in the Texas League; the Naturals average 10.1 K's per game.

WALK THIS WAY: In the month of June, the Cardinals drew 116 walks, tied with San Antonio most in the Texas League during the month. Springfield's OBP for June was a league-high .345, and also tops in the league for the season at .349. **Jacob Buchberger** led the Texas League with 21 BB in June (21 games), and is riding a 15 game on-base streak.

BIG INNINGS COSTLY: Big innings have happened more frequently than the Cardinals' pitching staff would like so far this season. The Cards have surrendered 52 innings of 3+ runs in 2024. All together, "big innings" have accounted 207 of the 389 runs (53.2%) Springfield has allowed this season. Cardinal opponents have batted around (9+ in an inning) 20 times this season, 9 of which have happened in June. The Cardinals are 30-6 when they don't allow a "big inning" and 9-30 when their opponent scores 3+ runs in an inning.

RUNNING WILD: The Cardinals are 22-for their last-26 in stolen base attempts over their last 12 games. **Jeremy Rivas, RJ Yeager** and **Mike Antico** lead the Cards with 4 SB during that time, while **Matt Lloyd** and **Bryan Torres** each have swiped 3 bags. The Cardinals are 4th in the Texas League with 100 SB as a team, while **Rivas** and **Bryan Torres** are tied for the team lead with 19 SB. In the month of June, **Antico** is 4th in the Texas League in steals, going a perfect 10-for-10. As a team, the Cardinals finished 3rd in the circuit with 37 bags, trailing only NW Arkansas (43 SB) and the Travelers (40 SB).

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career

RBIs with 218.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 39 straight games without a home run.
