Harrisburg Senators (24-33, 55-70) vs. Altoona Curve (24-31, 58-65)

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, opens a six-game series with Harrisburg.

LAST TIME OUT: Tsung-Che Cheng recorded his first career multi-homer game in a 13-5 loss in the series finale at Erie.

GET SHORTY: Righty Aaron Shortridge has turned in his best work of the season in the month of August, Shortridge earned a win in all 5 of his starts and recorded a 1.91 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) with just 7 walks and 24 strikeouts. 9 times this season, Shortridge has turned in a quality start. In the month of August, the 26-year-old ranked: 4th in ERA (1.91), 1st in W (5), 1st in IP (33.0), and T-8th in WHIP (1.09). Overall on the season he ranks 1st in the Eastern League with 25 starts, T-1st with 10 wins, and 2nd with 130.0 IP.

A HISTORIC NIGHT IN CURVE, PA: With right-hander Paul Skenes making his Double-A debut on Saturday, August 26, the Curve welcomed the largest crowd in franchise history with 10,164 fans at Peoples Natural Gas Field. The attendance total surpassed the Pirates-Curve Exhibition game on March 30, 2013 (10,116) and is the largest crowd in the Eastern League since July 27, 2013 when the Portland Sea Dogs hosted the Harrisburg Senators in front of 16,674 fans at Fenway Park. It was the fourth time since 2005 that an Eastern League club has announced over 10,000 fans in a game at an Eastern League Park. Altoona won a wild back-and-forth affair with the 'Ducks after Skenes didn't make it out of the first inning. Matt Gorski picked up three hits, including a game-tying double in the ninth inning, Joe Perez reached in all five of his plate appearances (including hitting his 6th home run in 13 games with Altoona) and Carter Bins sent the record crowd home happy with a walk-off infield single that ricocheted off the pitcher with the bases loaded and two out in the ninth inning.

HE'S HERE: Right-hander Paul Skenes, the No. 1 Overall selection in the 2023 draft joined the Curve for his Double-A debut on Saturday, August 26. Skenes is the 5th player No. 1 overall selection to suit up for the Curve following RHP Kris Benson (1996 / 2002 rehab), RHP Bryan Bullington (2002, 2004 with Curve), RHP Gerrit Cole (2011 / 2012 with Curve) and C Henry Davis (2021 / 2022-23 with Curve).

FLAVA-FRAZ: Outfielder Matt Fraizer matched his career-high with four hits and reached base in all five of his plate appearances in Altoona's 8-1 win over Akron on Wednesday, August 23. Frazier has reached base safely in 17 straight games in which he's batting: .333/.370/.464 with 2 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR and 7 RBI. He owns the league's longest active hit streak at 16 straight games. Fraizer's 105 hits rank 5th in the Eastern League and his 59 runs scored rank T-11th in the Eastern League.

NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOE: Signed as a minor league free agent on August 10 after six seasons in the Astros system, utility man Joe Perez has reached base safely in each of his 19 games played with Altoona, batting .328/.458/.642/1.100 with 3 2B, 6 HR, 14 RBI, and 22 K's. Twice in a Curve uniform he's homered in back-to-back games.

OUR OWN HOWLER: Left-hander Jackson Wolf, acquired from the Padres in the Rich Hill and Ji Man Choi deal, has remained one of Double-As best strikeout artists this season. He's struck out 20 in 21.0 innings since joining the Curve, giving him 125 this season between San Antonio and Altoona, the 10th-most strikeouts by a pitcher at the level, also ranks 13th in ERA (3.95), 8th in BAA (.226) and 5th in WHIP (1.12)

THE BIG LEFTY: Lefty Anthony Solometo is the youngest pitcher to reach the Eastern League this season, doing so at 20 years, 6 months and 15 days when he made his debut on June 17 at Somerset. Solometo is the 13th player in franchise history to suit up for the Curve under the age of 21 and slots in as the 5th-youngest player in the team's history between C Ryan Doumit, who was 20 years, 4 months, 0 days old when he debuted on August 3, 2001, and LHP Sean Burnett, who was 20 years, 6 months, 18 days old when he debuted on April 4, 2003. Solometo is one of 8 players to play in the EL at age 20 or younger, Harrisburg has two of them: Brady House and James Wood. Jackson Holliday (BOW), Jasson Dominguez (SOM), Yanquel Fernandez (HFD), Blaze Jordan (POR) and Marcelo Mayer (POR) are the others in the league that are not permitted to drink alcohol.

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out, Entering play on Sunday, September 3, Altoona has struck out 1,021 times, the 2nd-fewest among Double-A teams and 5th-fewest in minor league baseball. Altoona's was the last Double-A team to reach 1000 strikeouts this season.

THE MEN FROM THE UPPER CHAMBER: Managed by Delino Deshields, Harrisburg features the next wave of Nationals stars highlighted by outfielders Robert Hassell III, James Wood and Dylan Crews. Crews and Paul Skenes were the first collegiate teammates ever to be selected No. 1 and No. 2 in the draft when they went to start the 2023 draft.

THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: Dustin Saenz takes the ball in the series opener for the Senators. Washington's 4th round pick in 2021 out of Texas A&M, Saenz attended King HS in Corpus Christi, Texas and he was collegiate teammates with Seattle's Bryce Miller who recently made his major league debut. Saenz has pitched twice against Altoona this season going 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA (8 ER / 10.2 IP) with 16 hits allowed and 7 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

2023: Opened the season with Double-A San Antonio... Matched career-long outing on 5/14 with 7.0 tossed... Struck out a career-high 11 batters on 7/7 at Corpus Christi 7.0 innings...Made his Major League debut with the Padres on 7/22 at Detroit, just about 200 miles from his hometown of Gahanna, Ohio... Earned first Major League win, allowing three runs on six hits, retiring 9 of last 11 batters faced... Returned to San Antonio, where he allowed a career-high eight runs on a career-high 10 hits in 3.1 innings on 7/29... Traded to the Pirates on 8/1... At the time of his trade, led all Padres Minor Leagurs with 105 strikeouts, good for fourth among pitchers in the Texas League...Rankings in Texas League at time of promotion: 2nd in Wins (8) and WHIP (1.09), fourth in batting average against (.228) and fifth in ERA (4.08)... Made his Altoona debut on 8/6 vs. Richmond with 4.2 innings of 2-run ball (1 earned)... His 125 strikeouts rank T-10th among all Double-A pitchers, also ranks 13th in ERA (3.95), 8th in BAA (.226) and 5th in WHIP (1.12)...

2022: Opened season with Fort Wayne (A+) and went 7-8 with a 4.01 ERA and 134 strikeouts over 119.0 IP in 23 appearances, 22 starts... His lone relief outing came behind a rehabs start from LHP Blake Snell and said later that it a beneficial experience to observe how Blake went about his start-day routine... Also made two starts at Double-A San Antonio at the end of the season...

2021: Split his first pro season between the Arizona Complex League Padres (Rk.) and the Lake Elsinore Storm (A)...

COLLEGE: Played at West Virginia University, where he pitched in 50 games with 33 starts, going 12-11 with 205 strikeouts in 208.2 innings... Named to All-Big 12 Second Team in 2021 after going 6-5 with a 3.03 ERA and 104 strikeouts in his Senior season... Became the 28th player in WVU history to play in the major leagues... Dreamed of going to nearby Ohio State, but was never offered... Went to West Virginia, which was the first school to offer him... As a freshman, was primarily a reliever, though did make a start at PNC Park in Pittsburgh against Penn State (said at the time that was a dream come true)... Starter as a sophomore... First 2 seasons was teammates with Alek Manoah (John Means is another WVU MLB alum)... Following sophomore season, had an impressive summer in the Cape Cod Baseball League... Went undrafted after abbreviated junior year (2020, 5-round draft)... Back then, Amir Garrett tweeted, "Guys who were left out, remember this feeling. It's time to work even harder now. They always come back around. Remember that." Jackson replied, "I will forever remember this feeling. This will be the best thing to ever happen to me and I can't wait to show everyone what they missed..."

Traded to the Pittsburgh Pirates along with 1B Alfonso Rivas and OF Estuar Suero on August 1, 2023 in exchange for INF Ji-Man Choi and LHP Rich Hill

CURVE CUTS: Jackson David Wolf... Ranked No. 5 among left-handers and No. 20 overall in the state of Ohio by Perfect Game in High School... Played at Lincoln High in Gahanna, OH... Was also on golf team and played some basketball, but as a post player, was behind two future pros in Nick Ward (Michigan State) and Matthew Moyer (Syracuse, Vanderbilt, George Washington) so he didn't stick with it... Alumni include Evan White (2020 Gold Glove at 1B with Mariners), plus Broncos linebacker Jonathon Cooper (Ohio State) and Commanders long snapper Camaron Cheeseman (Michigan)... Was collegiate teammates with Pirates 2023 fourth-round pick (104th overall) Carlson Reed during the 2021 season at WVU... Father Joe played baseball at Columbus State... Known to have a high "perceived velocity" much in part to his frame, large stride to home plate, and funky delivery... Averages around 7.5 feet of extension on his release to home plate... Became a "Southern California guy" after freshman year of college, pitching for Santa Barbara in the California Collegiate Summer League and falling in love with the region... Has spent off-seasons living in Huntington Beach and San Clemente... Grew up attending Columbus Clippers (Triple-A, Guardians)... Rooted for the Cincinnati Reds as a kid when Ken Griffey Jr. suited up for them... Admired Aroldis Chapman and Randy Johnson as a kid... Avid golfer and also likes to fish.
