- Beloit finished its home schedule with a loss as Wisconsin completed a 6-game sweep of the Sky Carp with a 6-3 win on Sunday at ABC Supply Stadium.
- Javier Sanoja put Beloit in front early with an RBI double in the third inning that made it 1-0.
- Wisconsin responded in the middle innings, as Joe Gray Jr. tied the game with an RBI single in the fourth, and Brock Wilken belted a 2-run homer that put the T-Rats in front for good in the fifth.
- Wisconsin tacked on another run with a Matt Wood RBI single in the seventh to push the lead to 4-1.
- Beloit got a run back on an Ynmanol Marinez infield single that forced two errors, which cut the lead to 4-2.
- In the eighth inning, Beloit ran into bad luck. With two outs and a runner on third, Luis Lara dribbled a ball to first that appeared to be routine, but the ball bounced off the base and got through Torin Montgomery for an RBI single. Lara would score on a Hendry Mendez RBI knock that pushed the score to 6-2.
- Beloit threatened to rally in the bottom half of the eighth and got a run on a bases loaded walk, but left the bases juiced.


## THESE EIGHT HAVEN'T BEEN GREAT

Beloit's eight-game losing streak is their longest since losing 11 straight from May 23 through June 3, when the Carp were swept by Quad Cities in six games and lost five of six to Great Lakes. Across the eight game slide, Beloit has been outscored $42-11$. The team has lost 12 of its last 13 games. The rough stretch has dropped Beloit to a season-worst 23 games below . 500 .

## OFFENSIVE OUTAGE

The Sky Carp offense has sputtered down the stretch, averaging 3.3 runs and 7.1 hits per game in their last 27 contests. The team has been shutout five times in that span. In the first 36 games of the second half, Beloit averaged 5.3 runs per game and 9.3 hits and suffered one shutout loss.

## SNAKE BIT

The Sky Carp were swept in six games by Wisconsin last week, marking the second time this season Beloit has been swept in six games.

## EARLY BIRDS

The Sky Carp have scored first in each of their last three games. The stretch comes after Beloit scored first in just one of their prior nine games.

## FIRST IMPRESSIONS

In his High-A debut, Marlins 2023 draft pick Ryan Ignoffo went 2-4 with two doubles. Ignoffo was Miami's 20th round selection - their final pick. The Eastern Illinois product is a native of Cary, Illinois - located roughly an hour southeast of Beloit. Ignoffo assumes Jake Thompson's roster spot, as the slugger was promoted to AA-Pensacola.

## LACK OF THE LONGBALL

The Sky Carp haven't homered in their last 15 games - their longest stretch without a longball this season. Beloit's last homer came off the bat of Jake Thompson on August 18 at Quad Cities. Prior to the stretch, Beloit had hit 8

## homers in six games.

## IT'S NOT MEANT TO BE WHEN THE CARP SCORE THREE (OR FEWER)

Beloit is $4-55$ when scoring three runs or fewer this season. The Sky Carp haven't scored more than three runs in a game in their last nine contests.

## SEARCHING FOR SERIES SUCCESS

Beloit has gone nine consecutive sets without a series win (5 losses, 4 splits). Beloit's last series win came when it took five of six from South Bend June 28 through July 3.

## OPPORTUNITY KNOCKS

Across Beloit's eight game losing streak, the team is 6-61 [.098) with runners in scoring position, including a 1-4 performance Sunday.

## LANGUISHING WITH THE BASES LOADED
