Today: It's the fifth game of a six-game series between the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the A's, and the host West Michigan Whitecaps, the High-A affiliate of the Tigers. This is the 460th all-time matchup, coming in the Nuts' 3802nd all-time game; 12% of all of the regular season games the Lugnuts have ever played have come against West Michigan. The Nuts are 5-5 vs. West Michigan this season with 14 more meetings remaining to be played.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 8, Whitecaps 5. Trailing 3-0 after three innings, the Lugnuts rallied with solo tallies in the fourth, sixth and seventh innings before breaking things open with a five-run eighth inning, built on a Danny Bautista Jr. two-run single and Will Simpson two-run homer.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Whitecaps through tomorrow, enjoy an off day on July 29, and then welcome in the Dayton Dragons for a six-game series running from July 30 - August 4. Only three more homestands remain in the Nuts' 28th season.

Transactions: Yesterday, the Lugnuts reinstated infielder **Joshwan Wright** from the Injured List and gave him his release. Today, the Nuts moved pitcher **Luis Carrasco** from the 7-day Injured List to the Full-Season Injured List.

The Fateful Eighth: Lansing scored five runs in the eighth inning to blow open a 3-3 game last night en route to the 8-5 win. Two days prior, the Lugnuts scored four runs in the eighth inning to overcome a 6-2 deficit on their way to a 7-6 victory. This season, the Nuts have scored 59 runs in the eighth overall, outscoring the opposition by 14 runs. The only innings with more runs: 65 in the 3rd inning (outscoring the opposition by 15) and 69 runs in the 6th inning (outscoring the opposition by a whopping 23 runs).

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense is 1st in the Midwest League in at-bats (3123), total bases (1204) and triples (32) and ranks 2nd in runs (476) and hits (784), tied for 2nd in batting average (.251), slugging percentage (.386) and doubles (155), and 3rd in on-base percentage (.341) and OPS (.727).

All-Star Alumni: The Lugnuts were represented in the MLB All-Star Game by 2017 Nuts alum **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went hitless, and 2022 Lansing standout **Mason Miller**, who tossed a perfect frame for the A.L., striking out **Shohei Ohtani** and **Trea Turner** and hitting 103.6 mph, the fastest pitch in All-Star Game history.

Prospecting: The Nuts have five Top 30 A's prospects on their roster: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 14), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 23), pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 26) and third baseman **Luke Mann** (No. 30) as ranked by MLB Pipeline.

The Future is Here: 21-year-old Luis Morales, the youngest player on the Lugnuts, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Perez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the Prospect Showcase, and the fifth all-time Lugnut to participate in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: In 15 innings on a Sunday matinee, the Lugnuts defeated Burlington, 3-2, on a Dawel Lugo RBI single. The game lasted four hours and 38 minutes, meaning that the Lugnuts and Bees played 29 innings, lasting eight hours, 41 minutes, in the first two games of their three-game series at Community Field.

2022: Max Muncy homered on the first pitch of the game and the Lugnuts knocked out Kendall Williams with a three-run first, but the Great Lakes Loons answered with an Eddys Leonard leadoff homer igniting a four-run first against Christian Fernandez en route to a 8-6 win.

In a Nutshell: Excelled in his Lugnuts debut on May 2 vs. South Bend, becoming the club's 11th different starting pitcher this year and the 939th all-time player to put on the Lansing uniform... replaced the demoted Eduardo Rivera and tossed five scoreless two-hit innings, striking out six Cubs... followed up with eight strikeouts in three hitless innings with his mother in attendance at Great Lakes, May 8... grew up idolizing Max Scherzer... enjoys the great outdoors... notable splits:

Prospecting: Rated the A's No. 27 prospect and No. 12 pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline... grades: fastball 50, slider 45, change-up 55, control 50, overall 40... they write, "With low expectations, Johnston began his first full season of pro ball at age 23 with Single-A Stockton, but he threw so well out of the gate he earned a quick promotion up to High-A Lansing at the end of April... Johnston has shown a better feel for his three-pitch arsenal than some expected given his college numbers. He adds and subtracts from his fastball, throwing it typically in the 89-94 mph range, though he's shown in the past the ability to reach back for a 95 or 96-mph heater on occasion. The pitch has played up a bit because he can pitch north and south with it. His best pitch is now his split-changeup, which flashes plus and can be a true out pitch at times. His low-80s breaking ball can be on the slurvy side, but it can be effective."

Stockton Sensation: Opened 2024 with the Class A Ports... made two relief appearances and two starts, facing 46 batters and whiffing 26 of them ... debuted with 4 2/3 hitless innings with eight strikeouts on April 6... followed up with three perfect innings with 7 K on 4/12.

Gig 'Em: Majored in finance at Texas A&M... pitched primarily out of Aggies' bullpen; career stats: 6-4, 5.77 ERA, 66 G, 8 GS, 8 SV, 98 1/3 IP, 57 BB, 132 K... finest year at College Station was in 2022: 3.25 ERA, 23 G, 2 GS, 4 SV, 36 IP, 2 HR, 18 BB, 49 K... struggled in 2023 to 5.89 ERA due to 9 HR and 31 BB in 47 1/3 IP, though he struck out 70 batters... drafted following his fourth season at A&M... joined fellow Aggies Micah Dallas (8th round, 2022) and Nathan Dettmer (5th round, 2023) as Aggies drafted by the A's, and one of seven Aggies drafted overall in 2023... signed for \$150,000... notable Aggies in the pros include Chuck Knoblauch, Davey Johnson, Wally Moon, Michael Wacha, Ross Stripling and A.J. Minter.

Back Home: Batted .413 with seven homers during senior year at Keller High School; ascended from closer as a sophomore (posting 11-0 record with 11 saves) to ace as senior; compiled three-year record of 21-2... Keller High School also produced Shea Langeliers and Max Muncy 1.0.

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts... opened the 2024 season in a piggyback tandem with Wander Guante, who was promoted to Double-A Midland on May 14... on May 29, needed only 39 pitches to fire five scoreless innings against Peoria... promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas for an emergency relief appearances on June 23 at Tacoma, earning the win in a 20-10 victory; allowed first five batters to reach before recovering to record the next nine outs scorelessly...
