CARDINALS QUIETED BY SURGE IN 6-1 LOSS: The Cardinals matched a season low with 3 hits, including just one knock after the first inning, as Springfield dropped a 6-1 decision to the Wichita Wind Surge on Friday night at Riverfront Stadium. Matt Lloyd drove in the only run foir the Cardinals with a an RBI single in the 1st inning to give Springfield a 1-0 lead. Michael Siani went 0-for-1 with 3 walks in his third rehab start with the Cards. Springfield went 1-for-8 with runners in scoring position and is batting .164 with RISP over their last 5 games.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Cory Lewis** makes his 12th start (13th appearance) for Wichita... Last pitched on Sunday, August 25 at Midland and took the loss allowing 2 ER on 4 H while walking 4 and striking out 6 over 3.1 IP...Has lost his last 2 starts despite allowing just 3 ER over his last 9.1 IP...Has pitched well in the month of August despite an 0-2 record, compiling a 1.46 ERA with 34 K in 24.2 IP...Has pitched once against the Cardinals this season and suffered his worst start of the campaign surrendering 7 ER on 9 H (including HR hit by Bryan Torres and Chandler Redmond) in just 3.1 IP...The Cards won the game 10-2...Was slated to come out of Spring Training with Wichta but was placed on the IL on April 6 with a right shoulder impingement...Made his season debut in the FCL on May 24...Split the 2023 season between Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids going a combined 9-4 with a 2.49 ERA...Named the Jim Rantz Minor League Pitcher of the Year by the Twins last season...Pitched against the Peoria Chiefs in the first round of the postseason in the Midwest League last season and allowed just 1 R over 4.0 IP with 4 K...The Chiefs lost the game 9-1...Throws a knuckleball along with a fastball, curve, slider and changeup... Selected by the Twins in the 9th round of the 2022 draft out of UC Santa Barbara...23 years old

CARDS WRAP UP SEASON SERIES WITH WIND SURGE IN SIX-GAME SERIES: With just 3 weeks left in the regular season, the Springfield Cardinals head to the Sunflower State for a six-game series against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins) at Riverfront Stadium. The Cardinals won 5 of 6 in Wichita in their first series in Kansas from May 28-June 2.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

ON PACE...: With 16 games remaining in the 2024 regular season, the Cardinals are on pace for several team and individual franchise records:

- Springfield is on pace to win 80 games this season, which would eclipse the franchise record of 77 (2012 & 2017).
- The Cardinals have tied the franchise record for road wins in a season with their 38th on Thursday night, matching the record set in 2008.
- The current strikeout pace for the Cardinals pitching staff is 1,273, which would surpass the 2019 franchise record of 1,263.
- With an average of .333, Bryan Torres is 12 points ahead of the Springfield record held by Tyler Minges who hit .324 in 2005
- With 24 saves, Matt Svanson is within 3 of the franchise record of 27 (Mark Worrell, 2006 & Chris Perez, 2007)

ONE-SIDED SERIES: The season series between Springfield and Wichita has been controlled by the Cardinals in 2024. Springfield has outscored the Wind Surge 130-85 and despite being outhomered 25-16 in the series has a batting average 69 points higher (.290 to .229). The Cards have a 3.68 ERA against the Wind Surge, their best mark against any other North Division team. The Birds have a team ERA of 3.00 against San Antonio.

LONG, HOT SUMMER: The Cardinals are 33-16 since July 1, the best record in the Texas League during that time and 2nd-best in Double-A behind the Tennessee Smokies (CHC) who are 35-14. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 5-1-2 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .273. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.82, which is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a 4.75 ERA.

ROAD WARRIORS: For the duration of the 2024 season to this point, the Cardinals have been the best road team in Double-A. Springfield is 38-22 (.633) away from Hammons Field this season, a half-game better than the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) who are 37-22. The Cards have the best road mark in the Texas League by a wide margin; Frisco is 2nd-best with a record of 35-27 (.565) away from Riders Field.

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 16 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in half of those contests, Springfield is 12-4 during that time. The Cards have outscored their opponents 33-10 in the 8th inning or later.

STAFF AGING LIKE FINE WINE: The later into the 2024 season, the better numbers the Cardinal pitching staff has put up. August has been the best month for Springfield hurlers to date, as the Cards are 3rd in the Texas League with a 3.41 ERA.

FOR STARTERS: Springfield's starters since August 1 have the 2nd-best ERA in the Texas League at 2.62, trailing only Midland (2.38). Over their last 10 games since the series opener against the Drillers last Tuesday at Hammons Field the Cardinals' rotation leads the circuit with a 2.21 ERA.

SIANI REHABBING: St. Louis Cardinals rookie OF Michael Siani continues his rehab stint with Springfield this weekend. In 101 games with St. Louis this season Siani is batting .256 with 2 HR and 18 RBIs while ranking top-10 among CF in MLB with 9 Defensive Runs Saved. He was placed on the 10-day injured list on August 4 with a right oblique strain.

TORRES ON ANOTHER PLANET: Among qualified hitters in the Texas League, nobody has been swinging a hotter bat in the month of August than Cardinals INF/OF Bryan Torres. Despite an taking an 0-for-4 on Thursday night, Torres is batting .432 through 22 games in the month with 8 2B, a home run and 12 RBI while compiling a .500 OBP and 1.157 OPS. He has recorded multiple hits in 11 of his last 15 games and is a scorching-hot .492 (32-for-65) since August 10. The Texas League Player of the Week for August 12-18, Torres leads the league in hitting (.333), OBP (.419), hits (135) and runs (73).

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer Matt Svanson has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 24-for-24 and his 46 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 24.2 IP (0.36 ERA) and is 14-for-14 in save opportunities. Svanson has allowed just one unearned run over his last 19 appearances, allowing just 14 H with 19 K over 23.2 IP. The Cardinals are 51-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
