Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies beat the Richmond Flying Squirrels 7-2 on Friday night, backed by dominant pitching from Luis Moreno, Justin Courtney, and Hunter Parsons. The Ponies also had timely hits with Jose Peroza's two-run triple in the first and Luke Ritter's three-run homer in the third. Courtney and Parsons combined to throw three perfect innings in relief of Moreno, who had a Double-A career-high seven strikeouts over six innings.

Dominant Dom: RHP Dom Hamel threw three perfect innings with four strikeouts in his last start on Sunday at New Hampshire. Hamel will make his eighth start and ninth overall appearance of the season and of his Double-A career tonight.

Bullies in the Pen: The Rumble Ponies' bullpen has found success in this series. Eight different pitchers have been used in relief and they have combined to throw 14.1 innings, while allowing just one earned run. The bullpen has combined for 14 strikeouts and just three walks this series. **Hunter Parsons** has appeared twice, earning the win with two scoreless innings in the series opener and he tossed two perfect frames on Friday night. **Alex Valverde**, **Sammy Tavaréz**, and **Marcel Rentería** have all thrown two innings of relief without allowing an earned run in the series. **Nolan Clenney** (1.1 IP), **Jimmy Yacabonis** (1.0 IP), and **Justin Courtney** (1.0 IP) have also not allowed a run against Richmond.

BMac Delivers: Outfielder **Brandon McIlwain** extended his hitting streak to 10 games on Friday night, with a double and RBI single. McIlwain had a three-run double and a single with three runs batted in the series opener and hit a single on Wednesday. He went 2-for-4 with an RBI and run scored on Friday. He has 13 hits and 11 runs batted in across his 10-game hitting streak.

Military Appreciation Weekend: It is Military Appreciation Weekend at Mirabito Stadium starting tonight and throughout Memorial Day Weekend. All active and retired military personnel receive a complimentary Reserved Grandstand ticket when they show their ID badge at the box office this weekend. The Miller Auto Team Fireworks Series will take place on Sunday night. The first 1,000 fans in attendance will receive a cooling towel giveaway on Friday and a cooler bag giveaway on Saturday. Sunday's game is at 6:35 PM.

Last Start: Hamel pitched three perfect innings in the series finale on Sunday at New Hampshire. He struck out four batters over three perfect frames in his second start of the series. Hamel left with the Ponies leading 4-0.

World Baseball Classic: Hamel represented Team Puerto Rico in the 2023 World Baseball Classic. He honored his late mother, who passed away 11 days before the Mets selected him in the 2021 MLB Draft. He was WBC teammates with current New York Mets, Francisco Lindor and Edwin Díaz.

2022: Was named the 2022 New York Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. He led all Mets minor leaguers with 10 wins and 145 strikeouts. Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and pitched to a 5-2 record with a 3.84 ERA in 14 appearances and 13 starts. He tossed 63.1 innings and struck out 71 batters, before he was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on July 4. He went 5-1 on the mound with a 2.59 ERA in 11 starts for the Cyclones. He struck out 74 hitters over 55.2 innings and opponents hit just .180 against him.

BACKGROUND: Ranks as the Mets' No. 2 pitching prospect and No. 7 overall Mets' prospect by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted out of Dallas Baptist University in the 3rd round (81st overall) by the Mets in 2021. Hamel went 13-2 on the mound and racked up 136 strikeouts in his final year at DBU in 2021. He spent his first two years at Yavapai College in Arizona.
