✖ **PRIMERA IN AUGUST:** Since the calendar flipped to August, **Franklin Primera** has been posting video game numbers. The catcher is leading the Carolina League with a .455 batting average (15-for-33) across 10 games in August with a league leading 1.288 OPS and hits in 16 of his last 19 games dating back to July 17. Over that same stretch since July 17, Primera leads the RidgeYaks in average (.431), hits (28), total bases (43), and OPS (1.211)

✖ **MUSETT RETURNS:** **Andrew Musett** is back in Southwest Virginia for year number three with Salem. In his Single-A career, the Barquisimeto, Venezuela native has appeared in 131 career Single-A games while recording 123 hits and 66 RBI. In 39 games this season with the Yaks, Musett has hit safely in 27 of them and reached base safely in 34 of 39 games this year

✖ **NEW FACES:** Salem welcomes back RHP **Barrett Morgan** from an injury he suffered back during his June 23 start vs Myrtle Beach. Salem also sees the return of RHP **Nicholas Judice** for his third season of Single-A after being sidelined with an injury since last May. On the position player front, FCL standout OF **Josue Brito** sees the promotion while 2026 draftees IF **Wills Maginnis** (11th round) and IF **Colton Coates** (16th round) start their pro careers this week

✖ **ANDUJAR BREAKS THROUGH:** After recording just one RBI, and batting .095 through his first 20 games in Single-A, **Louis Andujar** has flipped it into gear as of late. Over his last 28 games since June 27, Andujar is leading the Carolina League with a .346 average (37-for-107) with 24 RBI, six homers, and a 1.049 OPS. Andujar has recorded a hit in 22 of his last 28 games after collecting hits in just five of his first 20 games

✖ **34 GAME SUCCESS:** Salem has won 20 of its last 34 games dating back to July 2. Over that span, the RidgeYaks are second in Single-A with a .277 batting average. The Yaks also lead the Carolina League with 219 runs and rank fourth in Single-A with 316 hits over their last 34 games

✖ **SECOND-HALF SURGES:** Since the start of the second half on June 19, The Yaks have three of the top six hitters in the Carolina League. Over his 29 games in the second half, **Franklin Primera** is fourth in the league with a .333 batting average. **Kleyver Salazar** places fifth with his .331 average over his 34 second-half games and finally **Louis Andujar** is batting .322 (sixth) over his 32 games

✖ **DIVISIONAL BATTLES:** Salem will see only Northern Division opponents the rest of the way, with a six-game series at home against Wilson (August 18-23), seven games at Fayetteville (August 25-30), and a final home series against Hill City (September 1-7) to round out the year

✖ **ROSTER TURNOVER:** Salem makes their penultimate road trip of the season this week. Salem has 14 players that remain on the roster who made the first road trip to Hickory and are still on the active roster. Pitchers Harry Blum, Nicolas De La Cruz, Leighton Finley, Christian Foutch, Barrett Morgan, Williams Rodriguez and Ethan Walker. As well as hitters in Kleyver Salazar, Starlyn Nunez, D'Angelo Ortiz, Avinson Pinto, Anderson Fermin, Skylar King and Andrews Opat

✖ **LIGHTS OUT WILLIAMS:** RHP **Williams Rodriguez** has been a staple out of the Yaks bullpen. Over his last five outings since July 18, Rodriguez has thrown 8.2 innings allowing just five hits and two earned runs pitching to a .161 batting average against and impressive 2.08 ERA over his last five

✖ **DELZINE DEALS:** After earning his promotion to Single-A on July 21, RHP **Sadbiel Delzine** is slowly becoming a household name in Salem. Delzine made his Single-A debut on July 24 and allowed a leadoff home run to Augusta's Luis Guanipa just two pitches into his debut outing. It was the first home run Delzine had allowed in his career, but since that pitch, Sadbiel has surrendered just one earned run over his last 12 innings (179 pitches), while striking out 16 and allowing just six hits. Those numbers translate to a 0.75 ERA and 0.92 WHIP since the Guanipa home run

✖ **FERMIN FINDING IT:** Outfielder **Anderson Fermin** had a series to remember last week; Friday he tied his career high with three RBI in a 2-for-4 effort. In the three games he played last week, Fermin went 4-for-11 (.364) with five RBI and three walks. Over his last five games since August 1, Fermin is hitting .359 with five RBI and a .500 OBP

- ✦ **DELZINE AND MONTERO ARRIVE:** After leading the FCL Red Sox in wins (4), innings pitched (39.2), strikeouts (43), ERA (2.72) and WHIP (1.07), **Sadbiel Delzine** earned a promotion to Single-A Salem last week. Salem also sees the addition of RHP **Williams Montero**. Delzine is the fifth youngest active player in the Carolina League and second youngest pitcher in the league:

- ✦ **ABOUT SUNDAY:** The RidgeYaks and Woodpeckers had their series finale postponed on Sunday afternoon. The Yaks and Peckers will now play a doubleheader on Wednesday, August 26, at Segra Stadium in Fayetteville. Game One, in which Salem will be the home team, is scheduled for 4:35 p.m. Both games will be seven innings

- ✦ **BOSTON'S FULL ORGANIZATION TURNAROUND:** Since July 2, the Boston Red Sox have been the hottest team in Major League Baseball, going 28-9 over their last 37 games. The Red Sox farm system has matched that success, posting a combined 80-58 record (.580) since July 2, which is the second-best combined record among MLB organizations. Worcester is 23-11, Portland is 18-17, Greenville is 19-16 and Salem is 20-14 during that span

- ✦ **THE STRIKEOUT STAFF:** After 110 games this season, Salem pitchers have combined to strike out 1082 batters, good for the second most in the Carolina League. The only team with more is Hill City who have 1100 punchouts. In total, Salem is averaging 9.83 strikeouts per game

WHAT IS A RIDGEYAK

The name "**RidgeYaks**" is a creative and symbolic reflection of the Southwest Virginia community and carries a double meaning:

Ridge: A tribute to the scenic Blue Ridge Mountains that tower beyond the outfield wall at Salem Memorial Ballpark, a nod to the beautiful, rugged landscape that defines the region.

Yak: The name carries two layers of local-flavor meaning. First, "yak" plays off the slang for kayak, a subtle salute to the region's love for kayaking and other outdoor recreation on the area's waterways.

A Yak is also a real animal. The Yak is a long-haired, heavily built bovine native to high-altitude mountains. The Yak comes to symbolize strength, resilience, stability, and a hardworking spirit, qualities that resonate with both the team and the broader Salem community.

The new mascot, named **Mac the Yak**, takes inspiration from McAfee Knob, one of the region's most iconic natural landmarks, linking the team's identity not only to athletic grit, but to local heritage, outdoor adventure, and mountain pride.

- At the time of his promotion to Single-A Salem on July 20, led the FCL Red Sox in wins (4), innings pitched (39.2), strikeouts (43), ERA (2.72), and WHIP (1.70)
- The 2.72 ERA was the sixth lowest among all Red Sox minor leaguers (Min 20 IP)
- Enters his third season of professional baseball after signing as an international free agent in January 2025 out of Venezuela, receiving a \$500,000 signing bonus, the highest bonus given to any pitcher in Boston's 2025 international class
- The \$500,000 bonus was the fifth-highest given to any pitcher in the 2025 international class and the most Boston had spent on an international arm since 2019 with Chih-Jung Liu (\$750,001)
- Of his 11 appearances with the FCL Red Sox, went at least three innings in eight
- Was named the Florida Complex League Pitcher of the Week on June 14 after going a career long 6.1 innings at the FCL-Braves while striking out a career best eight hitters in the winning effort
- Has added at least 20 pounds to his 6-foot-5 frame since signing last January, and his fastball has gone from sitting in the low 90s to now being in the mid-90s and touching 98 mph at the peak
- Is the fifth youngest player in the Carolina League. Born on January 9, 2008, is one of five active players in the league born in 2008. Joining the exclusive list of Eric Booth (Delmarva), Juan Cabada (Myrtle Beach), Williams Montero (Salem), Kevin Alvarez (Fayetteville), and himself
- Allowed a leadoff home run to Luis Guanipa two pitches in (his first career home run allowed) in his Single-A debut on July 24, but settled in for 61 more pitches and didn't allow another earned run after the leadoff bomb
- Varies his motion, will pause in the windup occasionally
- Has struck out 16 over his 12.0 innings in Single-A
