### GAME 2: LHP REID DETMERS (1-2, 6.00) VS. RHP NOAH DAVIS (1-2, 6.00)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes and Bees will play a doubleheader after Saturday's night contest was suspended in the bottom of the second inning ... Game 1 will continue in the second frame and be a nine inning contest while game 2 will be seven innings with approximately 30 minutes between games.

SERIES RECAP: Albuquerque holds a 3-1 series lead over Salt Lake after an 11 inning 12-11 walk-off victory Friday night ... Since 2022, the Isotopes are 19-6 against the Bees in Albuquerque ... Noah Davis is slated to toe the rubber for the Isotopes in game two while Reid Detmers is scheduled to start for Salt Lake.

**WALK-OFF**: Friday night's walk-off triumph is the Isotopes' fourth of the season (last: June 1 vs. Oklahoma City, 10-9). The Isotopes have scored double-digit runs in three of their four walkoff victories. The four walk-off wins matches last season's total.

VS. SALT LAKE: It's also the eighth all-time walk-off against the Bees, first since June 18, 2022, in game one of a doubleheader, a 6-5 victory on a Jonathan Morales RBI single in the 7th inning.

COMEBACK: The Isotopes trailed 5-0 after two innings, making Friday's win the largest comeback victory of the season (previous: four, June 1 vs. Oklahoma City, 10-9).

**EXTRAS**: The win improves Albuquerque to 1-2 in extra innings on the year and 1-0 at home. It's the first extra-inning game at Isotopes Park since Sept. 11, 2022 (7-6 victory over El Paso).

ONE-RUN GAMES: The Isotopes move to 7-14 in one-run games and 5-6 at home. The club has won two of its last three one-run contests. It's the first one-run victory at home since June 1 (last: vs. Oklahoma City, 10-9).

**DOUBLE-DIGITS**: Friday was the 83rd time in Isotopes Park history both clubs scored in double-digits, fifth in 2024 (last: May 17 vs. Sugar Land, 14-12 loss). The club is 1-4 in such contests.

ATTENDANCE: Over 43 openings, Albuquerque has tallied the third-highest total attendance in all of Minor League Baseball (282,177) and highest in the Pacific Coast League.

1ST INNING RUNS: Isotopes allowed four runs in the first frame Friday, tied the second-most tallies (twice) allowed in the first (most: five, twice: April 7 at OKC and May 3 vs. RR). In 2024, the club has yielded 63 runs in the first inning, 4th-most in Triple-A.

TWO HOMER GAME: Salt Lake's Keston Hiura connected on two home runs last night, the 14th multi-homer performance by an opposing batter in 2024 (last: Hiura, June 27). MR. JONES: Greg Jones matched a season-high with three hits Friday (also: April 20 at El Paso), including a solo home run, for his eight multi-hit game of the year ... Has homered in twostraight games for the second time since June 17 ... Over last six games since being sent to Albuquerque, slashing .444/.500/.852 with five multi-hit games, a triple, three homers and five RBI.

ON BASE STREAK: Jones has reached in 19-straight starts for Albuquerque, compiling a .317/.398/.573 slash line with four doubles, a triple, five homers and nine RBI ... Has seven-game hit streak.

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall extended his season-high hit streak to and season-high hit streak to 11 games with a single. During stretch, is slashing .400/.462/.622 with seven multi-hit games, four doubles, two homers, 10 RBI and six walks ... Is the longest active hitting streak in the PCL ... It's his longest hit streak since a 12-gamer with Double-A Hartford (Aug. 23-Sept. 7, 2022).

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo collected three singles for his 19th multi-hit game of the year, eighth three-hit contest and second in his last five games. Has a hit in five of his last six games (9x25, .360, with a double, two homers and six RBI).

VANDY: Connor Kaiser tallied his eighth multi-hit game of the year and second-straight, his first back-to-back multi-hit games of the year. Has recorded doubles in two-straight contests for the third time in 2024. His three RBI established a season-high. ... Drove in multiple runs for fourth time in 2024, all in June.

TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron extended his hitting streak to seven games with a single Friday. During the stretch, he is slashing .290/.313/.419 with a double, homer and five RBI with two multi-hit contests.

**T-BONE**: Trevor Boone registered three hits Friday, a single, double and homer, for his fifth multi-hit game of the year and second three-hit game (also: June 15 vs. El Paso).

JC: Julio Carreras swiped his 20th bag of the season June 19, establishing a new career high.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 5th in average (.307) ... Julio Carreras is 6th in SB (20) ... Greg Jones in T-7th in stolen bases (19).

**TEAM STATS**: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 1st in triples (37), slugging (.478) and total bases (1,331), 2nd in hits (775), average (.278) and OPS (.836) and 6th in runs (471).

### **NUCLEI NOTES**

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**HOMETOWN KID:** Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
