PAPILLION, NEB. – The Storm Chasers returned home Tuesday and won their third straight game, a 10-3 over the Stripers to open a six-game series at Werner Park.

Omaha jumped out of the gates early and sent 10 hitters to the plate in the bottom of the 2nd inning and scored six runs on seven hits to knock Gwinnett starter Huascar Ynoa out of the game ... after Tyler Gentry doubled and CJ Alexander singled, Cam Devaney singled Gentry home to put the Chasers on the board ... with one out, John Rave singled Alexander home, then MLB rehabber Michael Massey doubled in Devaney and Rave to plate two more runs ... three pitches after Massey doubled, catcher Logan Porter blasted a two-run homer to center field to cap the scoring in the six-run frame and put Omaha up 6-0.

The Storm Chasers added more in the bottom of the 3rd inning, as Alexander and Devin Mann singled, then Drew Waters tripled the two in and Massey singled in Waters for what was at the time a 9-1 lead ... Alexander added Omaha's final run of the day in the bottom of the 4th inning, as he connected on his team-leading third home run of the season, a solo shot for a 10-1 Chasers advantage.

Aided with strong run support, Omaha starting pitcher Jonathan Bowlan compiled his best outing in a Storm Chasers uniform with the club's first quality start of the season ... the right-hander limited the Stripers to two runs over 6.0 innings and finish off the Stripers and secure Omaha's third straight win. Bowlan did not walk a batter and set a season-high with 10 strikeouts, just the third double-digit strikeout game of his professional career.

Behind Bowlan, Anthony Veneziano threw 2.0 innings and held Gwinnett to one run in his first relief outing of the year, a solo home run in the seventh inning ... John McMillon worked around a walk in the ninth to strike out the final two batters and finish off the Stripers and secure Omaha's third straight win.

All nine Storm Chasers in the starting lineup recorded at least one hit, while eight of nine scored a run and six of nine drove in a run ... Alexander led the way with his third straight multi-hit game, while Waters, Massey and Porter each collected two hits and drove in multiple runs.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

ALOHA, KANEOKA!

Gwinnett Stripers manager Kanekoa Teixeira returns to Werner Park this week, where he played in 2011 as a member of the Omaha Storm Chasers under current Chasers manager Mike Jirschele.

Teixeira pitched 8 games for Omaha in 2011, between April 24 and May 17, including 3 outings at Werner Park ... he went 0-1 in those 8 outings with one save and a 5.23 ERA (6 ER in 10.1 IP).

The right-hander opened the 2011 season with Kansas City in the big leagues and appeared in 6 games with the Royals in what was his second (and final) Major League season.

A Rule 5 Draft pick by Seattle ahead of the 2010 season, he was designated for assignment in May 2010 by the Mariners and claimed off waiver by the Royals, finishing the 2010 season in the big leagues.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

Infielder CJ Alexander has been Omaha's top hitter through the first 10 games of the season, leading the team in nearly every offensive category.

Alexander leads the Storm Chasers in hits (13), doubles (4), home runs (3), runs batted in (9), extra-base hits (7), total bases (26) and runs scored (7) ... among qualified Chasers hitters, he also leads the team in batting average (.342), slugging percentage (.684) and OPS (1.026).

The left-handed hitter is 7th in the International League in total bases and tied 8th in hits.

CJ also leads the team with 5 multi-hit games this season, including his last 3 games in a row ... there were a pair of occasions last year where he had back-to-back multi-hit games, but this is the first time since August 2022 he's had three straight games of 2+ hits.

DAZZLING DEFENSE

While still early in the season, the Omaha Storm Chasers have established themselves at one of the best defensive teams in Minor League Baseball, with just 2 errors made in 352 total chances (.994 fielding percentage) across the first 10 games of the season.

The Chasers haven't made a throwing error, just a caught stealing error (interference) on March 30 vs. Iowa and a fielding error yesterday.

Omaha did not make an error in 7 games, between March 31 and April 7 ... since 2011, the Storm Chasers have just 6 stretches of 7+ games without making an error and last year's 10-game streak is tied for the longest (with the 2018 Omaha Storm Chasers, July 22 to August 2).

RELEASABLE RELIEVERS

The Storm Chasers bullpen is still of the best in the International League as Omaha's relievers have combined for a 3.77 ERA through the team's first 10 games.

A 3.77 ERA (19 ER in 45.1 IP) ranks 7th among the 30 Triple-A teams, while a .182 opponents' batting average (29-for-159) ranks 2nd at the Triple-A level.
