SAGGESE HITS GRAND SLAM TO PUSH RIDERS TO VICTORY:

Thomas Saggese's third grand slam of 2023 made the difference on Saturday in the Frisco RoughRiders' 8-6 win over the San Antonio Missions at Riders Field. Frisco (10-10, 41-47) led 4-3 in the sixth inning before a two-out rally. **David Garcia** was hit by a pitch, tonio Missions at Riders Field. Frisco (10-10, 41-47) led 4-3 in the sixth inning before a two-out rally. **David Garcia** was hit by a pitch, **Luisangel Acuña** walked, **Evan Carter** got ahead 3-0 and was intentionally walked to load the bases. Saggese rode a 3-1 pitch out to left field for the Riders' eighth grand slam of the year, twice as many as any other team in the Texas League. San Antonio (8-12, 45-44) threatened late by putting the tying run at the plate in the ninth inning but **Matt Bush** recorded the final two outs for the save. Daniel Camarena (1-5) allowed just one hit in his first three innings while starting for the Missions. The Riders finally did some damage against him in the fourth inning, starting with **Jax Biggers**' single and **Kellen Strahm**'s double to score the first run. **Josh Hatcher** walked and **Liam Hicks** added a double of his own to score Strahm. **Chris Seise** singled with two strikes for an RBI. With two outs, Acuña and Carter added infield singles to put Frisco ahead 4-2. **Noah Bremer** lasted three innings in his start for Frisco, allowing two earned runs. He finished his day on a 1-2-3 inning in the third. Nick Starr (4-3) picked up where Bremer left off, tossing a three-up, three-down fourth inning and coming back for a scoreless fifth as well to earn the win. He allowed one base runner on a single and wiped him out on a caught stealing, with Garcia gunning down Jackson Merrill at second base. A day after going 0-for-6 with runners in scoring position and stranding 11 runners on base, Frisco went 5-for-10 with runners in scoring position on Saturday, stranding seven. Frisco turned two double plays during the game and now lead the league with 77 on the season. seven. Frisco turned two double plays during the game and now lead the league with 77 on the season.

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.23 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and last in the Texas League. They have used 16 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and just under the 19 they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 33 games since June 11th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.81 (101ER/116.1IP) while the bullpen has a 4.55 ERA (86ER/170.0IP). Over the 33 games, the Riders have the third-best offense in the league by OPS (.769) and have hit 33 home runs (6th in the Texas League).

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 18 games, he has driven in 20 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .302/.353/.512/.865 with three homers and 16 RBIs in 12 games.

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 25 games since his return, he has nine multi-hit games, batting .337 (32-for-95)/.439/.600/1.039 with three doubles, two triples, six home runs, 19 RBIs and 20 runs scored.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 37 games, he is hitting .352/.429/.634/1.063 with 10 home runs and 35 RBIs. The California native is currently fourth in the league in batting average (.310), tied for second in RBIs (70), first in hits (107), fourth in doubles (20) and first in total bases (175).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .567 average (17-for-30) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.494 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .450 (27-for-60) on the initial offering while his 27 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are fourth in the minors.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 37 and is on pace for a career-best 56 swipes. Acuña is on pace to set a single-season record for the Riders, as Elvis Andrus has the record with 54 swipes in 2008. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 112 bases in 134 attempts (83 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE, AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's eighth grand slam of the season. They are one of three teams with at least eight grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect has reached safely in a Riders' season-high 21 games in a row, batting .333/.402/.425/.827. He is seventh in the Texas League in batting average (.304), third in hits (104), third in doubles (22), second in runs (62) and first in steals (37).

At the Schrines College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.
