YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 6-5. Bowie scored twice in the third to open a 2-0 lead. **Brandon Martorano** gave the Flying Squirrels a 3-2 lead with a three-run triple in the fifth inning. In the sixth, **Connor Norby** tied the game with a sac fly. Bowie took a 6-3 lead with a pair of homers in the seventh by **Hudson Haskin** and **Andrew Daschbach**. **Jacob Heyward** hit a two-run homer in the eighth to pull the Flying Squirrels within a run, his second straight game with a homer. **Landen Roupp** issued a career-high five walks and struck out five batters over 5.1 innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels opened the season with two wins in three games at Bowie from April 8-10. From April 26-May 1 at The Diamond, Richmond won five-of-six against Bowie. In the first series of the second half, Richmond dropped five-of-six at Prince George's Stadium from June 28-July 3. The Baysox won two-of-three at The Diamond coming out of the mid-season break from July 22-24.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 21-38 in the second half. They are 15-30 in the last 45 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost 10 and split five this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,394 strikeouts, the most in the history of the Eastern League, and rank tied for third with 155 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 28-38 on the road this year. Richmond is 26-25 in games decided by two-or-less runs.

THE BAYSOX are tied for first place in the Western Division in the second half with nine games remaining. Last week, the Baysox split a six-game series on the road against the SeaWolves. It was the only set between the two teams in the second half. If the Baysox and the SeaWolves finish the regular season tied, the SeaWolves hold the tiebreaker and will advance to the playoffs. Bowie's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including RHP Grayson Rodriguez (No. 2, No. 4 overall - on MLB rehab assignment), 3B Coby Mayo (No. 7), 2B Connor Norby (No. 12), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 14), LHP Cade Povich (No. 15), SS Darell Hernaiz (No. 18), INF Cesar Prieto (No. 21), OF John Rhodes (No. 23 - on IL) and OF Hudson Haskin (No. 24).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Kyle Harrison** makes his 17th Double-A start and his third against the Baysox. He last pitched on Saturday against the Senators and allowed four runs over two innings with six strikeouts. He faced the Baysox on July 2 and struck out seven while allowing one run in five innings in a win at Prince George's Stadium. He pitched against Bowie again on July 23 at The Diamond, his first outing following the Futures Game, and threw three hitless innings. After walking the first batter he faced, Harrison struck out the next nine straight batters. Overall this year, Harrison is ranked first in the minors in strikeout percentage (39.9), first in K/9 (14.47) and first in K-BB% (29.0). Since the start of the 2021 season and his professional debut, he has recorded 330 strikeouts, the second-most in the minors, trailing only 351 by Diamondbacks minor leaguer **Brandon Pfaadt**. Harrison was selected to represent the Giants in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on July 16. With his Flying Squirrels debut on May 27, he became the youngest pitcher in team history. He also picked up the second-most strikeouts in a debut in franchise history with nine. Harrison began the season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, where he went 0-1 with a 1.55 ERA in seven starts. At the time of his promotion to Richmond, Harrison ranked third in the Northwest League in ERA (1.55), second in strikeouts (69), third in BAA (.179) and tied for fifth in WHIP (1.00). Harrison was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft by the Giants out of De La Salle High School in Concord, Calif. He is currently rated by MLB.com as the Giants' No. 2 prospect, No. 22-overall prospect and the No. 1 LHP prospect. *Baseball America* ranks Harrison as the Giants' No. 2 prospect, the No. 21-overall prospect and the No. 1 LHP prospect. **For more on Harrison, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander **Chayce McDermott** makes his fifth Double-A start. On Saturday, he worked five innings and allowed one run with six strikeouts for his first Double-A win at Erie. After going 0-1 with a 15.75 ERA (14 ER/8.0 IP) in his first two Double-A starts, McDermott has gone 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA (2 ER/10.0) with 10 strikeouts in his last two starts since August 28. McDermott was selected in the fourth round (132nd overall) by the Houston Astros in 2021 out of Ball State. In August, he was traded to the Orioles as part of the deal that sent **Trey Mancini** to the Astros.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,140) and rank second in total attendance (368,407). Richmond is 15th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 155 home runs this season, which is tied for third in the Eastern League. On August 7 in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 167 home runs. **Sean Roby** is tied for third in the league with 25 homers on the season, with 21 coming at The Diamond.

RELYING ON THE LONGBALL: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have scored 266-of-their-599 runs on homers. At 44.41 percent, they have the second-highest total of their runs scored on the year on homers in the Eastern League, trailing Somerset (48.37 percent, 311-of-643 runs). **Will Wilson** has picked up 81.0 percent (17-of-21) of his Double-A RBIs on home runs this year. **Sean Roby** has driven in 65.5 percent (36-of-55) and **Tyler Fitzgerald** has 56.9 percent (33-of-58) of their RBIs on home runs.

CASEY AT THE BAT: Infielder **Casey Schmitt** was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 9. After going 0-for-3 in his Double-A debut on August 10, Schmitt has hit .365 (31-for-85) with three homers, nine doubles, a triple and 15 RBIs in his last 21 games since August 11. Last Thursday, he homered twice and drove in four runs. On Friday, he collected three hits, including two doubles, and drove in three runs. In last week's series against the Senators, Schmitt hit .444 (8-for-18) with two homers, three doubles, two walks and seven RBIs.

SMITH STREAKING: **Armani Smith** is currently riding a 27-game on-base streak since July 29, which is the second-longest active streak in the Eastern League. It is also now the longest on-base streak for a Richmond player this year, ahead of a 24-game streak by **Shane Matheny** in May and June. During the streak, Smith is batting .242 (23-for-95) with three doubles, a homer, seven RBIs and 22 walks. Smith's current on-base streak is tied for the third-longest in the Eastern League in 2022. Smith has the Flying Squirrels' longest on-base streak since 2013 and is tied for the third-longest in franchise history.

FITZ ON FIRE: **Tyler Fitzgerald** has 21 homers this season, which ranks as the second-most in a season in franchise history, one homer ahead of **David Villar**'s previous franchise record of 20 set last year and trailing 25 by **Sean Roby** this year. Over his last 34 games since July 28, Fitzgerald is batting .326 (44-for-135) with six homers, nine doubles, one triple and 23 RBIs, which has raised his season batting average from .194 to .236. He is batting .379 (11-for-29) with three doubles in his last seven games since last Thursday.

BRAND NEW MAN: **Will Wilson** returned to action late last month after missing nearly three months with a broken hamate. After a rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League, Wilson was assigned to Richmond on August 24. He hit .160 (4-for-25) in his first seven games back with Richmond. Over his last seven games, Wilson is batting .346 (9-for-26) with a double, six walks and three RBIs.

SHANE TRAIN: On Tuesday night, **Shane Matheny** hit a two-run homer against the Baysox. It was his 12th Double-A homer of the season and his fifth against the Baysox. He hit two homers in a win over Bowie on May 1 at The Diamond. He added homers in back-to-back games played on June 28 and June 30 at Prince George's Stadium. After going 20 games without a homer from August 6-September 2, Matheny has homered twice in his last five games since Saturday.

SAY HEY: **Jacob Heyward** has clubbed two-run homers in each of his last two games. He now has six homers in his last 19 games played, giving him 32 for his Richmond career, which is the second-most in franchise history, trailing on 37 by **Ricky Oropesa** (2013-16). He has also extended his career franchise walks record to 154.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is tied for third in homers (25) and ranks eighth in SLG (.481). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for eighth in stolen bases (24). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is 10th in homers (21) and tied for second in runs scored (71). **Shane Matheny** is third in OBP (.376) and ninth in walks (54). **Ryan Walker** is tied for sixth in games pitched (43).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: In the Eastern League, Hudson Haskin is sixth in OBP (.363). **Joey Ortiz** is 10th in batting average (.269), tied for eighth in RBIs (71), tied for fifth in hits (117), tied for third in doubles (28), seventh in extra-base hits (47), seventh in total bases (198) and sixth in runs scored (69). **Garrett Stallings** is ninth in innings pitched (107.2).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Casey Schmitt** (2), **Vaun Brown** (10), **Ryan Murphy** (15 - on IL), **Will Wilson** (22) and **Ricardo Genoves** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Schmitt is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes **Harrison** (2), **Schmitt** (6), **Murphy** (15), **Tristan Peters** (21), **Will Wilson** (26) and **Landen Roupp** (28). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 22 overall prospect.
