SERIES RECAP:

The Reading Fightin Phils battled hard against the Hartford Yard Goats, but fell 7-3 on the road. Reading used the long ball to tie things up in the middle of the contest, but #1 Rockies prospect Zac Veen's solo shot ended up being the winning run for Hartford. Aldrem Corredor had a two-run shot, while Jhailyn Ortiz launched his team-leading 16th homer of the season.

SUCCESSFUL SCHULTZ

Out of the bullpen, Andrew Schultz has dropped his ERA down to just 1.04 in 8.2 innings of work in Double-A. The righty has only allowed one earned run since his call up on August 5. Schultz was a 6th round pick back in 2019 out of the University of Tennessee. He began the season in High-A Jersey Shore throwing 30.0 innings for a 4.80 ERA. There he struck out 48 batters and held hitters to a .204 average. He has been typically a middle inning reliever, but does have one save on the season.

BAKER BROUGHT UP:

Andrew Baker, a right-handed reliever, got the call up on Monday and made his Double-A debut on Tuesday. He needed just four pitches to get one out in the eighth, stranding two inherited runners on base. The 22-year old pitched in 40 games for High-A Jersey Shore in just his second professional season. He compiled three wins for a 4.74 ERA over 43.2 innings of work. Baker was drafted in the 11th round of the 2021 draft. He has struck out 61 batters and held opponents to a .237 average. Baker has been known to hit triple digits with his fastball velocity.

DE LA CRUSHED:

Carlos De La Cruz has had a fantastic last ten games for the Fightin Phils. Over the past week and a half, he is batting .333 with thirteen hits, including three doubles and three homers. The righty has driven in four runs and scored six times. De La Cruz even recorded his first Double-A stolen base. He has split time in righty and left field and has covered a lot of ground to make some impressive snags.

PROSPECT CENTRAL:

The Fightins roster boasts many top prospects in the Phillies farm system. Andrew Painter (#1), Mick Abel (#2), Griff McGarry (#4), Johan Rojas (#5), Ethan Wilson (#8), Luis Garcia (#14) Jhailyn Ortiz (#18) and McKinley Moore (#25) rank high.

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies took back-to-back losses at the Arizona Diamondbacks with a 12-3 defeat. The team made two errors in the field. The Phillies got just four hits on the night as Brandon Marsh launched his first home run with the organization. Aaron Nola got jammed up early allowing eight runs on ten hits in four innings of work. Philadelphia had Nick Maton pitched the eighth inning. The position player let up three runs on four hits.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

August 30, 2012: At Reading, in the final home game of the regular season, Darin Ruf homers for the 38th time, setting the franchise record for home runs in a single season. Ruf's dinger is a 3-run shot in a 6-run 2nd inning and comes off Kutztown University product Darin Gorski. It is also his 20th HR in August, tying him with Sammy Sosa for the professional record for homers in a month. Justin Friend enters the game with the bases loaded in the 9th and induces a 1-2-3 double play to nail down the 7-2 victory. It is Friend's 24th save in 24 chances, tying the franchise record in that department.
