YESTERDAY: The Captains edged the South Bend Cubs, 4-3. Lake County held four separate one-run leads (1-0; 2-1; 3-2; 4-3). After South Bend tied the game at 3-3 in the eighth on a single by Bryce Ball, Jonathan Rodríguez single-handedly propelled the Captains ahead in the top of the ninth. Rodriguez led off with a single to right, stole second and moved to third when the throw went into center field. He then scored what proved to be the winning run

LAST SERIES: The Captains lost four of six against the Great Lakes Loons to fall out of first place in the High-A Central League East Division. Lake County lost two games by one run.

PRESSURE PACKED: Before this series, the Captains' prior 12 games were against opponents in the top two spots in the High-A Central East Division standings. Every game in the last two series pitted the Captains against a team within 1.0 game of Lake County in the standings.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 2.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, the Dayton Dragons and the Great Lakes Loons are all separated by just 3.5 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 11.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

#### WHO'S HOT?

José Tena: In August, Tena has posted season-best numbers in batting average (.293), on-base percentage (.350), slugging percentage (.587), OPS (.937) and home runs (7). He was third in the league in homers and fourth in slugging percentage during the month.

Christian Cairo: 5-for-16 (.313) since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 24.

Jhonkensy Noel: Slashing .326/.383/.465 (.848) in his first 11 games since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg. Joe Naranjo: Has posted a 13.3 BB% in August, compared to a 10.2 BB% for the full season. His on-base percentage in August is .347, compared to .319 for the full season.

Raynel Delgado: Has posted a 12.5 BB% in August, compared to a 8.2 BB% for the full season. His on-base percentage in August is .318, compared to .288 for the full season.

Tim Herrin: Has not allowed an earned run since July 17 (11 consecutive appearances). Herrin's streak has spanned 17 innings. He has lowered his ERA from 3.72 to 2.31 during this stretch.

Xzavion Curry: Has a 1.88 ERA across his last four starts (4 ER, 19.1 IP) with 22 K against 2 BB

Hunter Gaddis: Has a 2.70 ERA since July 3 (25 ER, 50 IP). Gaddis has pitched 5+ innings in each of his eight starts during the stretch and has four consecutive quality starts. In his lone relief outing, (August 27, piggybacking behind Aaron Civale on an MLB Rehab Assignment), Gaddis pitched four shutout innings with eight strikeouts.

NO TRAFFIC: In the month of August, the Captains' pitching staff owns the league's second-lowest WHIP (1.18), the second-fewest hits (179) and has the second-lowest batting average against (.216). Their hit total and batting average against are the second-lowest in all of High-A, while their WHIP is fourth-lowest.

NEW BLOOD: 3B Jhonkensy Noel joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF Christian Cairo and OF Jonathan Rodríguez joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats (minimum 200 PA). Rodríguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

LAST TIME OUT: In his fourth start back from the Injured List, Burns pitched four innings (69 pitches) against Great Lakes and allowed two runs on five hits last Wednesday at Classic Park. After holding the Loons scoreless in the first two innings, Burns surrendered both of his runs in the third on an RBI double by Eddys Leonard and an RBI single by Andy Pages. Burns stranded three men in scoring position over his four innings of work. The right-hander took the loss in a 4-3 defeat.

INJURY LIST: Missed two starts between July 17 and August 4 with right elbow soreness.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: After a solid freshman campaign, Burns broke through in 2019 and was named a third team All-American by Perfect Game. Prior to the 2020 season Burns was Named Preseason All-SEC. Preseason All-America by Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball, D1 Baseball and Perfect Game. In just four games in 2020 Burns was off to a hot start striking out 12.9 per nine innings and had a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA.

TEAM USA: In 2018, Burns was selected to the USA Collegiate National Team. Burns appeared in four games allowing five runs over 7.2 innings. He allowed nine hits, struck out six and walked one. Also on the team were back to back first overall draft picks Adley Rutschman (2019) and Spencer Torkelson (2020).

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Burns in the CBA round (36th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Burns was Cleveland's second selection in the draft, following SS Carson Tucker (1st Round – 23rd overall).

PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED: Originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 37th round of the 2017 draft out of Decatur High School (Decatur, AL).

MR. ALABAMA: Burns was named Mr. Alabama his senior season of high school. Along with being one of the top pitchers in the state he hit .467 with 16 homers, 10 doubles, four triples and 46 RBI as a senior in High School.

RECRUITING BATTLE: A highly sought after recruit in Alabama, Burns originally committed to the University of Alabama but decided to weigh other options when Crimson Tide Head Coach Mitch Gaspard resigned in 2016, eventually committing to Auburn. Burns grew up an Alabama fan and only committed to the Tide's arch-rival Auburn due to Head Coach Butch Thompson's experience developing pitchers. He says he took a lot of heat for committing to Auburn from friends he grew up with.

STAR MENTORS: While at Auburn, Burns had a variety of people with great track records to learn from. Auburn Head Coach Butch Thompson has had 16 of his former pitchers make the big leagues including 10 since 2014. He previously worked as the Associate Head Coach and Pitching Coach at Mississippi State. Among the stars coached by Thompson is 2018 number one overall pick Casey Mize. Burns worked closely with Mize at Auburn, and was throwing partners with Mize during his freshman year of 2018. He took over the premier role in the rotation from Mize, operating as the teams Friday night starter in 2019 and 2020. Tim Hudson joined Thompson's staff in 2020 as a volunteer assistant and pitching coach, also getting the chance to mold Burns' game. The former Auburn great and 17 year MLB veteran worked with Burns for a short time in 2020 before the season was shortened but Burns says the two will have a relationship for the rest of his life.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT: Kevin Goldstein of FanGraphs says Burns brings "big stuff out of a small package" with good secondary pitches to go with solid velocity (sits 93-94) on his fastball. Eric Longenhagen, also of FanGraphs, describes Burns as "an org based bet." Longenhagen sees Burns as someone who's future value mostly revolves around Cleveland's recent ability to develop pitchers. "I've always been a little lower on him due to his middling velocity and projectionless frame, but he executes his secondary stuff very consistently" Longenhagen said. Baseball America sites Burns offspeed pitches as potential plus pitches, especially his curveball and slider. Burns earns praise for his dedication, makeup and desire to learn.
