NOTES AND NUGGETS

JAC ATTACK

Last week, Royals top prospect **Jac Caglianone** was promoted from Double-A Northwest Arkansas to Triple-A Omaha ... last week in Omaha's series at Salt Lake, "Cags" went 9-for-26 with 5 homers and 10 RBI over his first 6 Triple-A games.

✦ Caglianone was selected by the Royals with the 6th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft, announced as a two-way player, though he has yet to pitch professionally.

✦ Caglianone leads Minor League Baseball with 56 RBI, is tied 2nd in MiLB with 15 homers, 5th with 117 total bases and tied 6th with 63 hits.

✦ Cags is responsible for 5 of Omaha's 7 hardest-hit balls this season, including the hardest-hit ball of the year by a Chasers hitter, a home run last Wednesday at 113.6MPH ... his average exit velo leads Omaha and is 3rd in Triple-A at 95.6MPH.

✦ Going 0-for-5 this Tuesday, Cags snapped a 19-game hitting streak, a stretch where he hit .350 (28-for-75) with a 1.141 OPS from May 3 to 25, tied for the 3rd-longest hitting streak in the Minors this year ... he had reached base in 26 games, from April 25 to May 25, with a .356 average (37-for-104) and 1.097 OPS.

✦ Caglianone hit two home runs in last Sunday's win over the Bees, his second two-homer game of the season ... he hit home runs in the last 4 games of the series against Salt Lake ... his first home run Sunday flew 459 feet, Omaha's longest of the season and the team's 2nd-longest of the Statcast Era (since 2023).

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

✦ Omaha has successfully stolen 88 bases this year, and only been caught 12 times ... 88 steals rank 4th in the International League and among Triple-A teams.

✦ 88-for-100 in steal attempts is a 88.0% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 90.5%, 38-for-42).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 533 strikeouts this season ... that is 3rd in the league and 4th at the Triple-A level.

✦ Over 472.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.15 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

✦ With 533 strikeouts through 54 games, an average of 9.87 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,470 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

ROLLER COASTER RIDE

Omaha has held leads in its last 12 games ... but the Storm Chasers are just 3-9 in this stretch

✦ In this 12-game stretch, since Sunday, May 18, the Chasers have played 109 innings (against Columbus, Salt Lake and St. Paul) ... Omaha has led for 38 of 109innings, but only won 3 games: yesterday, and back-to-back wins May 25 at SL and May 27 vs. STP.

✦ The Storm Chasers have had a lead for multiple innings in 7 of 12 games, including 7 innings Friday night (1st inning through the 7th) ... Omaha has lost its lead in the 7th inning or later in 4 of the 12 games.

FROM OMAHA TO THE SHOW

7 Omaha alumni have debuted in the Major Leagues this season, with the two most recent Royals debuts being members of the Storm Chasers' 2024 International League Championship team.

✦ Outfielder **John Rave** (2022-25) made his MLB debut with the Kansas City Royals yesterday afternoon, starting in right field and hitting 6th in the Royals' lineup ... he went 0-for-2 at the plate, but laid down a sacrifice bunt and drew a walk in the game against the Reds ... Rave is the 341st Triple-A Omaha player to reach the big leagues and currently leads the Minors in runs scored (46).

✦ Pitcher **Andrew Hoffmann** (2023-25) had his contract selected by the Royals Wednesday and made his MLB debut Friday night ... Hoffmann allowed 2 runs in 2.0 innings, but struck out 4, pitching the 8th and 9th innings against the Tigers.

OVER THE HILL

Today, 45-year-old **Rich Hill** starts for the Storm Chasers, the oldest player to suit up for Omaha in the modern era (since 2005).

✦ Hill has over 14 years of MLB service time and has appeared in at least 4 MLB games every year, from 2005 (his debut season) to 2024 (he pitched 4 games with the Red Sox) ... he has appeared in MLB games for 13 different teams.

✦ One member of the Storm Chasers - **Jac Caglianone** - was not alive when Rich was drafted by the Cubs in the 4th round of the 2002 Draft ... Jac was born on February 9, 2003, 249 days after Rich was drafted, on June 5, 2002.

- ✓ Hill is making his **1st start with Omaha** this season, his 3rd overall start in the Royal organization ... signed a Minor League contract with Kansas City on May 14, 2025 and made 2 starts with the Arizona Complex League Royals before being assigned to Omaha this week, on May 28.
- ✓ Playing his 24th professional season this year ... Royals are Hill's 16th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Cubs, Orioles, Cardinals, Red Sox, Indians, Angels, Yankees, Nationals, Athletics, Dodgers, Twins, Rays, Mets, Padres and Pirates ... he has pitched in the Major Leagues for 13 of the 15 organizations (has not appeared in an MLB game for St. Louis or Washington).
- ✓ Hill has appeared in 386 MLB games (248 starts) across the last 20 seasons ... since making his MLB Debut with the Cubs in June 2005, he has pitched at least 4 MLB games each of the last 20 years, every season from 2005 to 2024.
- ✓ If Hill appears in a Major League game with Kansas City this season, he will tie Edwin Jackson's MLB record by playing for his 14th big league club.

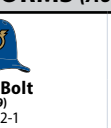
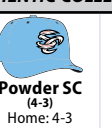

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
