**PAPILLION, NEB.** – The Storm Chasers took 5 of 6 games in the series over the Jumbo Shrimp at Werner Park, concluding with a 6-5 walk-off win Sunday afternoon.  
 Like the previous two nights, the Storm Chasers jumped out early and took a 3-0 lead in the bottom of the 2nd inning as **Tyler Gentry** ripped a double that drove in **Nick Pratto** and **Devin Mann** to open the scoring, then **Cam Devanney** followed two at-bats later with a single to drive in Gentry and extend the lead to three runs.  
 With three runs of support, Omaha starting pitcher **Zach Davies** cruised through 5.0 scoreless innings to open the game and worked two outs into the 6th inning before a two-out double ended his day.  
**Anthony Veneziano** followed Davies and allowed the runner he inherited to score on a double from **Troy Johnston** to cut Omaha's lead down to 3-1, giving Davies just the one run allowed over 5.2 innings with three hits and three strikeouts.  
 Omaha extended its lead to 4-1 in the seventh as Pratto singled in **Nate Eaton** ... Eaton went 3-for-4 on the day with three doubles, the first Storm Chaser hitter to collect three doubles in a game since **Dairon Blanco** in September 2022 ... the game was also Eaton's fifth game of 3+ hits this season, a team-best.  
 Jacksonville slowly cut into Omaha's lead, as Veneziano and Major League Rehabber **Carlos Hernández** combined for a scoreless 7th inning, but **Griffin Conine** connected for a two-run homer off Hernández in the 8th to cut Omaha's lead to 4-3.  
**Evan Sisk** got the final out of the 8th inning behind Hernández, then **Will Klein** took the mound in the 9th inning to try and lock down his seventh save of the year ... Klein loaded the bases on three walks and surrendered the game-tying run on a sacrifice fly, but stranded the other two runners on.  
 Omaha couldn't score in the bottom of the 9th inning and send the game to extras, the second game past 9 innings in the series with Jacksonville ... **Steven Cruz** got two quick outs in the 10th but the placed runner on second base came around to score on a 2-out single from **Cristhian Rodriguez** for a 5-4 Jumbo Shrimp lead.  
 Jacksonville did not lead for long, as **Ryan Fitzgerald** blasted a 2-run home run to right field with one out in the bottom of the 10th to win the game 6-5, his second homer of the year and Omaha's fourth walk-off win of the season.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has won 10 of its last 11 games ... 9 of those 11 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 8 of the 10 wins in that 11-game stretch.  
 After Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, 7 of the last 9 wins have had a save awarded ... **Will Klein** has earned three saves in the last 7 wins, while **Walter Pennington** has two and **Carlos Hernández** and **Sam Long** each have one.  
 In total, 25 of Omaha's 36 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (69%), including 10 of the Chasers' 12 losses this season ... in 5 of the 10 games that Omaha has lost by 3 or fewer runs, the Chasers have at the tying run either at the plate or on base ... the Storm Chasers have only lost one game by more than 4 runs: a 9-1 loss on April 18 at Nashville.  
 The Storm Chasers have not allowed more than 9 runs in a game this season ... of the 20-team International League, only Swanton/Wilkes-Barre and Omaha have yet to allow a double-digit run total, but SWB has 5 games of 9+ runs allowed ... 16 of 20 IL teams have allowed 10 or more runs at least 3 times.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 211 to 162 this season, a +49 run differential.  
 A +49 run differential ranks as the best in the International League, is 3rd in Triple-A and ranks 5th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams ... Oklahoma City leads the Triple-A lead at a +68 run differential, while Modesto leads MiLB at +111.

#### GETTING OFFENSIVE

Omaha has been one of the top hitting teams in the International League in the month of May, with a 10-2 record so far this month.  
 Omaha leads the league in doubles this month (32) and ranks 2nd in hits (105), tied 2nd in runs scored (71), tied 3rd in stolen bases (15) and in total bases (177).  
 Overall in 2024, Omaha's 211 runs scored rank 5th in the International League and 12th in Triple-A, with 7 of the 10 Pacific Coast League teams ahead of the Chasers.

#### JUST THE 2 OF US...

The Storm Chasers are one of the best 2-out hitting teams at the Triple-A level.  
 In 2-out situations this season, Omaha is slashing .268/.345/.501 (107-for-399) ... among all 30 Triple-A teams, the Chasers are tied 6th in average (.268) and 2nd in slugging (.501) and OPS (.846) ... 200 total bases with 2 outs also rank 2nd-best at the Triple-A level.

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.  
 The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .208 average (122-for-595), which is tied for the best mark among Triple-A teams, while the .671 opposing OPS ranks 3rd-best and a 3.80 ERA against the Omaha bullpen is 5th-best in Triple-A.  
 Saturday's combined shutout marked the 7th time Omaha's relievers combined in a single game to not allow any runs ... 5.0 scoreless innings from the bullpen is the second-most in a game this year, after 6.0 scoreless frames on March 29 vs. Iowa.

### TODAY'S START

- Lynch is making his **9th overall appearance**, **8th overall start** and **7th Omaha start** this season ... after 6 starts in Triple-A, he was called up to Kansas City on May 5 and appeared in 2 games (1 start) before being optioned back to Omaha May 10.
- Has improved his walk rate in each of his first three seasons in the Majors since debuting in 2021, lowering his BB% from 10.0% in 2021 to 8.7% in 2022 and 7.2% in 2023 ... walk rate in Triple-A this year is 7.1% (9 walks in 127 batters faced).
- Added the 'IV' to his surname before his July 18, 2023 start vs. Detroit to honor his father, Daniel Lynch III, and grandfather, Daniel Lynch II.
