LAST GAME

Powered by a strong pitching performance, the Bowie Baysox won their third-consecutive contest on Tuesday night with a 3-0 win over the Harrisburg Senators. Right-hander Connor Gillispie paved the way with his six, one-hit, shutout innings on the mound for Bowie, en route to his fourth victory of the season. The Baysox grabbed a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the first on Jud Fabian's solo home run - his fifth at the Double-A level. Bowie extended the lead in the fifth on a pair of sacrifice flies from Shayne Fontana and Greg Cullen. Out of the bullpen, right-hander Nolan Hoffman contributed a pair of shutout frames before right-hander Nick Richmond notched his first Double-A save to complete the seventh shutout win of the season for the Baysox.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Harrisburg Senators enter this week with an overall record of 38-46. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg is 7-9 in the second half and 3.5 games back of first-place Erie in the second half Southwest division standings. The Senators have the third-lowest team average (.229) and fewest home runs (61) in the Eastern League, but have committed the fewest errors (51) defensively. The Senators' roster is highlighted by eight of the Nationals' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - OF James Wood (No. 1 WSH/ No. 4 overall), IF Brady House (No. 2 WSH / No. 70 overall) OF Robert Hassell III (No. 5 WSH / No. 93 overall), RHP Cole Henry (No. 12 WSH), RHP Zach Brzykcy (No. 17 WSH), IF Trey Lipscomb (No. 18 WSH), LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 22 WSH), RHP Gerardo Carrillo (No. 26 WSH).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Dustin Saenz is tonight's projected starter for Harrisburg. Saenz will be making his sixth Double-A start tonight, but has struggled at the new level thus far. Opponents are hitting .376 against Saenz, who has allowed 32 hits across 20 innings, walking 11 compared to just 12 strikeouts. Saenz recorded just two outs in his most recent outing on 7/9, allowing two runs on a pair of hits and three walks against Akron. The left-hander threw 30 pitches in the outing and just 12 for strikes. Saenz showed similar struggles after moving to High-A last season, but pitched to a 1.97 ERA across 50.1 innings for Wilmington this season prior to his promotion to Harrisburg in early June. A fourth-round pick of the Nationals in 2021 out of Texas A&M, Saenz features a fastball, curveball, slider, and changeup.

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Jackson Holliday has already made a splash in Double-A, going 8-for-16 with a pair of doubles in his first four contests, recording multiple hits on three occasions and reaching base twice in all four games. Baseball's top prospect ranks top five in the Orioles' system with a .341 average (2nd), .471 on-base percentage (1st), .529 slugging percentage (5th), 1.000 OPS (2nd), six triples (1st), and 66 walks (1st). Holliday on-base percentage also leads all of Minor League Baseball, while he sits with the third-most walks. He is the second No. 1 overall prospect to don a Baysox uniform in quick succession, as Adley Rutschman (2021-22) also topped the prospect rankings during his time in Bowie. Holliday is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday. He is the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

ALL RHODES LEAD TO HOME

John Rhodes had a sensational weekend at the plate for Bowie. The No. 19 Orioles' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, went 5-for-14 with five RBI. Rhodes' weekend included a three home-run contest on Friday - the first multi-home run game of his career and just the seventh three home run game in Baysox franchise history, along with a game-tying and walk-off RBI single on Sunday. Rhodes currently ranks second among active Baysox in RBI (38), first in on-base percentage (.342), second in slugging (.442), and second in OPS (.784) among qualifiers.

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has enjoyed a breakout at the Double-A level in the summer months. Cook has hit .323 since the calendar flipped to June - third-highest average in the Eastern League among players with at least 100 at-bats. Cook's 17 extra-base hits in that stretch (nine doubles, six home runs) are also fifth-most in the league, while his 13 stolen bases in as many attempts are second-most. Last night, Cook extended his active hitting streak to six games, with multiple hits in three of the six games. Cook currently leads active Baysox hitters in home runs (11), RBI (46), and stolen bases (18).

STARTING STRONG

Despite sitting in the bottom half of the Eastern League with a 4.24 staff ERA, the Baysox have gotten a lot of help from their starting staff. Bowie starters hold a collective 3.75 ERA this season - the best mark in the Eastern League and second-best in Double-A. Last night's six shutout frames from Connor Gillispie was the sixteenth start of at least five shutout innings from a Baysox arm this season. Tuesday's effort was also the seventh shutout of the season for Bowie. Only Erie (8) has more in the Eastern League this season.

CAREER NOTES

- 2022: Had a stellar month of May, where he pitched to a 0.49 ERA and held opponents to a .098 average - was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.
- Struggled in the two months afterward, moving on-and-off the 7-day injured list while posting a 6.57 ERA through June and July, before being placed on the injured list for the remainder of the season on August 4. Control issues also resurfaced in June in July with twice as many walks in each month as he had in April or May.
- College: Transferred to UT-Arlington from Weatherford College in 2020, after pitching at Weatherford for two seasons.

NOTES BY OUTING*

- 4/12 Pitched in relief of Chayce McDermott, allowed a solo home run in his third inning of work after striking out two batters to start the frame.
- 4/19 First start. Struck out the first four batters faced, and retired the first nine. Did not allow a hit until the fifth inning, where he allowed two runs.
- 4/26 Pitched in relief of Connor Gillispie. Retired the first two batters faced, but still allowed a run in the same inning. Third inning of work struggled, allowing a walk and two doubles with one out.
- 5/3 Second start, allowed a leadoff home run in the second inning, and five runs in the fourth on four-straight baserunners and another homer.
- 5/9 Relieved Houston Roth. Single and two walks to open his second inning of work eventually led to two runs.
- 5/14 Third start. Gave up two extra-base hits and had no strikeouts.
- 5/21 Relieved Justin Armbruster. Walked two batters in first inning of work, and allowed an unearned run on a passed ball, but still struck out three in the frame.
- 5/26 Fourth start. Earned first win behind five no-hit innings. Was the second-night that the Bowie starter had thrown five hitless innings to begin the game (McDermott) First reliever gave up a base hit to the first batter faced.
- 6/1 Relieved Houston Roth. Allowed go-ahead two-run home run in the sixth, and another solo later in the frame, and one more in the seventh. Career high three home runs.
- 6/7 Struck out two batters in the first inning, but allowed four straight batters to reach with two outs in the second, including a two-run home run. Bowie lead 7-0, but only won 8-7.
- 6/13 Second pitch thrown was hit for a home run, allowed two more runs to score on two walks and two hits in the first.
- 6/18 After starting ahead 0-2 on the first batter, opened with back-to-back walks, and allowed a three-run home run. Walked two more batters after the home run.
- 6/24 Struck out the first four batters faced, but only one more in the fourth inning. Only allowed baserunners in two innings, while stranding a runner at third in both frames.
- 7/1 Walked three batters in the first inning, but reset to retire seven straight before allowing a leadoff home run and two runs in the fourth inning.
- 7/6 Only run scored following a single, balk, wild pitch, and groundout.
