ABOUT LAST TIME... A sacrifice fly from Luis De Los Santos brought home the game-winning run in the bottom of the ninth for the Vancouver Canadians on Sunday afternoon as the C's took down the Everett AquaSox 2-1 to split the six-game set three games apiece.

Tied 1-1 entering the final frame, Spencer Horwitz laced the first pitch from Isaiah Campbell (L, 2-1) into left-centerfield for a lead-off double. Ryan Gold advanced him to third base by grounding out to the right side before De Los Santos lifted a fly ball to center that was deep enough to plate Horwitz and give Vancouver the victory.

The teams traded zeroes for the first six innings before both sides broke through in the seventh. Everett got on the board with a one-out double, a wild pitch and a sacrifice fly to lead 1-0, but the C's answered in the home half. Back-to-back walks to Horwitz and Gold put two runners on before De Los Santos beat out a potential inning-ending double play to put runners on the corners with two outs. Up stepped Sebastian Espino, who flicked a broken bat single into centerfield to score Horwitz and make it 1-1.

Right-hander Paxton Schultz was tremendous for the Canadians. The Orem, UT native went six shutout innings, scattered three hits, walked two and struck out a season-high eight, though he did not factor into the decision after AquaSox starter Juan Then matched Schultz's effort with six scoreless stanzas of his own.

Hagen Danner (W, 2-1) earned the win in relief with a season-best three innings of work in which he allowed a run on one hit, walked one and struck out three.

Horwitz and Espino paced the offense with two hits apiece. The former scored twice and worked a walk while the latter collected an RBI.

FEELING GREEN: The Eugene Emeralds, Advanced-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, come to town this week for their first taste of the Canadians this season. This is the first of just two series between these two clubs in 2021; Vancouver will visit PK Park June 22-27 for the remaining six games of the 12-game season set. The C's went 3-4 against the Ems in 2019 when both clubs were their parent organization's Short-Season A affiliate.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

SEEING RED: The Canadians are a perfect 5-0 in their red jersey tops this year.

MAY DAYS: Vancouver finished the first month of the season with a 15-9 record, a .224 team batting average and a 3.36 team ERA (the sixth lowest among all 30 Advanced-A clubs).

WALK HARD: Spencer Horwitz leads the High-A West with 27 walks in 22 games played. His 27 free passes are tied for the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball; Anthony Serviedo of the Delmarva Shorebirds (Low-A, Orioles) leads the minors with 28, though is batting just .237 as opposed to Horwitz's .318 average (the fourth highest in the circuit).

ON THE HILL: Right-hander Sean Wymer takes the hill today for Vancouver looking to build on his recent successes. In his last turn on May 25 against Everett, the Flower Mound, TX native earned his first quality start of 2021 with a season-high six innings pitched in which he allowed just one run on three hits, walked two and struck out a season-best five. Wymer has dropped his opponent's batting average against by over 200 points in his last three starts. Drafted by the Blue Jays in the fourth round of the 2018 draft out of TCU, Wymer had a sterling collegiate career for the Horned Frogs. Over three seasons, the 24-year-old posted a 3.33 ERA and a 15-7 record across 61 games (12 starts) while amassing 162.1 innings pitched and limiting Big 12 hitters to a .233 average. He served as a reliever for his freshman and sophomore campaigns before converting to a starter his junior year. Prior to heading to Fort Worth, Wymer was a four-year letter winner at Flower Mound High School.

Aaron Phillips gets the nod for Eugene. The righty took the loss in his season debut on May 26 against Spokane; that day, Phillips gave up four runs (three earned) on six hits in 3.2 innings pitched. He walked one and struck out three. Phillips, 24, was the Giants' ninth round selection in 2017 out of St. Bonaventure, where he went 13-6 with a 3.17 ERA in three seasons.
