In the losing cause, Danny Bautista, Jr. went 3-for-3 with three doubles and a walk.

### LUG•NOTES

**Roster Flux:** Entering today's game, the Lugnuts added pitcher **Micah Dallas** and outfielder **Nate Nankil** from Single-A Stockton, promoted pitcher **Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang** and infielder **Euribiel Angeles** to Double-A Midland, and gave infielder **Jose Escorche** and outfielder **Cameron Masterman** their release. In addition, two players who were acquired today by the A's via trade – pitcher **Kade Morris** from the Mets (for Paul Blackburn) and outfielder **Jared Dickey** from the Royals (in a three-player package for Lucas Erceg) were assigned to the Nuts' roster.

**Splitsville:** Before the Lugnuts split with the Whitecaps over the weekend, Lansing had only two series splits all season... coincidentally, both came against the Dayton Dragons..

**Team Effort:** The Nuts' offense is 1st in the Midwest League in at-bats (3186), base hits (797), total bases (1225) and triples (34), tied for 1st in batting average (.250), and ranks 2nd in runs (477), slugging percentage (.384) and doubles (159), and 3rd in on-base percentage (.339) and OPS (.723).

**All-Star Alumni:** The Lugnuts were represented in the MLB All-Star Game by 2017 Nuts alum **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went hitless, and 2022 Lansing standout **Mason Miller**, who tossed a perfect frame for the A.L., striking out **Shohei Ohtani** and **Trea Turner** and hitting 103.6 mph, the fastest pitch in All-Star Game history.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts have five Top 30 A's prospects on their roster: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 14), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 23), pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 26) and third baseman **Luke Mann** (No. 30) as ranked by MLB Pipeline.

**The Future is Here:** 21-year-old **Luis Morales**, the youngest player on the Lugnuts, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Perez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the Prospect Showcase, and the fifth all-time Lugnut to participate in the game.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2017:** The Lugnuts built a 7-0 lead, watched the Great Lakes Loons hit three straight solo homers (Saige Jenco, Jeren Kendall and Gavin Lux) in the fifth inning and then add a fourth solo home run (Nick Yarnall) in the eighth, before escaping with a 7-5 win at Cooley Law School Stadium on a wacky game-ending double play. With the tying runs at the corners in the ninth, Jared Carkuff struck out Cristian Santana on a pitch in the dirt – the second out immediately, since first base was occupied. But Santana took off for first base anyway, inadvertently kicking the ball away from catcher Javier Hernandez. Umpires Matt Cowan and Raul Moreno conferred and determined that Santana had committed interference, calling runner Cody Thomas out and giving Carkuff his third save of the year.

**Off to Arlington:** Luis represented the Oakland Athletics in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game on July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, becoming the fifth active Lugnut in team history to participate in the Futures Game, joining Denzel Clarke (2022), Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (2017) and Ángel Perdomo (2016). He was one of seven current Midwest Leaguers to be part of the Futures Game roster, along with Ethan Salas (Fort Wayne), Ben Kudrna (Quad Cities), Noble Meyer and Thomas White (Beloit), Thayron Liranzo (Great Lakes) and Cam Collier (Dayton). He faced four batters, striking out two, hitting Dylan Crews with a pitch and walking Liranzo.

**Prospecting:** Morales is ranked the Oakland Athletics' no. 2 prospect behind SS Jacob Wilson and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50. They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodriguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings."

**Path to Lansing:** Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder.
