SIX-RUN THIRD LEADS JUMBO SHRIMP TO WIN

A six-run third inning on Sunday spurred Jacksonville to a 9-5 victory over Nashville. After Peyton Burdick's RBI single in the first, the Sounds scored two in the bottom of the first inning. Jacob Amaya laced a two-run double for the Jumbo Shrimp to regain the lead in the second. Xavier Edwards' RBI triple then capped a six-run third inning to make it 9-2. Former Jumbo Shrimp Brian Navarreto hit an RBI double in the fourth and another former Jacksonville player, Alex Jackson, notched a two-run two-bagger in the fifth to get the score to 5-3. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen worked 4.2 scoreless innings.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 39 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 61-for-165 at the plate, slashing .370/.411/.473/.884 with six doubles, one triple. three home runs, 25 RBIs and 36 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in the International League in batting average (.350) and ninth in OBP (.419). Among the 287 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances. Edwards ranks second in swingingstrike rate (3.8 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 48 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 51-for-171 (.298/.378/.678/1.056) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.2 percent of the time in 2023.

NFFD FOR SPFFD

Xavier Edwards stole a base successfully on Saturday, pushing his personal streak to 24 attempts in a row without getting caught. The Jumbo Shrimp as a whole have been one of the best teams in baseball in stealing bases; Jacksonville's 84.5 percent stolen base success rate is third in Triple-A and fifth out of the 120 full season MiLB teams. Only two Jumbo Shrimp have been caught stealing since July 9, with the club swiping 16 bags in that span.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Though the Jumbo Shrimp won 9-5 on Sunday, 15 of Jacksonville's last 24 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 95 games played thus far in 2023, 52 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 24-28 (.462) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer

ODDS & FNDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. In the other 15 games of the second half of the season. Jacksonville is just 6-9, with all but one of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those nine defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 44 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -20 against their other second-half opponents (Durham, Worcester & Nashville).

THE PENDULUM SWINGS

Jacksonville started their series at Nashville with strong performances from their bullpen. In the set's first two games, Jumbo Shrimp relievers surrendered only one run on seven hits in 11.0 innings of work, combining for 12 strikeouts against seven walks. However, things devolved quickly from there; over the next three contests, Jacksonville's relief corps combined to allow 21 runs, all earned, on 24 hits in 17.0 innings with 23 strikeouts against 12 walks. In Sunday's series finale, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen regained its footing, firing 4.2 shutout innings, scattering three hits and a walk and picking up six strikeouts.

Jacksonville pitching has walked at least six batters in eight of their last nine games... In his 15 games played since July 4, Jake Mangum has recorded 11 multi-hit contests. He is 28-for-73 (.384/.408/.521/.929) during that span with seven doubles, one homer, eight RBIs, and 13 runs.

ABOUT RONALD

- -Before coming to the United States, Bolaños played for Mayabeque of the Cuban National Series. He signed with the San Diego Padres as an International free agent on August 11, 2016.
- -The Padres selected Bolaños' contract and promoted him to the major leagues for the first time on September 2, 2019. He made his major leagues debut on Spetember 3rd vs. the Arizona Diamondbacks, allowing two runs over six innings pitched.
- -On July 16, 2020, Bolaños and outfielder Franchy Cordero were traded to the Kansas City Royals in exchange for LHP Tim Hill.
- -On April 16, 2023, Bolaños signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.
- -Entering the 2023 season, Bolaños has pitched in 18 major league games, including five starts with Kansas City and San Diego. In those games, he is 0-4 with a 5.25 ERA. Over 48.0 innings, he has yielded 49 hits and struck out 43 against 29 walks.
- -When he was signed by San Diego, the then-19-year-old was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 20 international prospect in the 2016 class and ranked by Baseball America as the fourth-best Cuban pitcher avaliable.
- -In 2014, he played in the COPABE 18U Pan American Championship in Mexico.
- -The Cuban native came up as an outfielder before converting to a pitcher.

2022 SEASON

-With Triple-A Omaha, went 0-1 with a 3.52 ERA in four starts. Over 15.1 innings, yielding 17 hits and struck out 16 against four walks. However, over 24 relief apperences with the Storm Chasers, he posted an 0-3 record with a 7.63 ERA. In those relief apperences, he allowed 42 hits in 26.2 innings and struck out 18 against 14 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Bolaños began the year with Triple-A Omaha and made four starts before joining the Royals on June 4th. He closed the season with the Storm Chasers.

2020 SEASON

- Made a pair of starts, July 26 at Cleveland and Aug. 1 vs. the White Sox... Took the loss in his first start, allowing two unearned runs on three hits and a walk over 2.0 innings.
- -Became the third Cuban-born pitcher to start a game for the Royals, joining Onelki García (2017) and Zip Sánchez (1988).
