CAREER NOTES

- Is only the eighth player in Presbyterian College's history to be drafted...Eagen's teammate at Presbyterian Joel Drago was drafted in the 7th round by the Phillies that same year, becoming the first players drafted out of Presbyterian since 2013 when the Diamondbacks selected Bud Jeter, a right-handed pitcher, in the 25th round.
- Over 35 games (27 starts) in his collegiate career, went 7-7 with a 5.02 ERA over 131.0 innings from 2022-24.
- Made 14 starts in 2024 as the Friday starter for the Blue Hose, setting a program record for strikeouts (122) to the tune of a 2.67 ERA...struck out a program record 14 batters on April 5, 2024 against Radford.
- Earned Big South Pitcher of the Year honors in 2024 as well as First Team All-Big South...Named Big South Pitcher of the Week six times in 2024.
- In high school, ranked as the 17th-best RHP in North Carolina (per Prep Baseball Report)...his 2020 high school team (Fuquay-Verona HS) ranked 10th in the nation.
