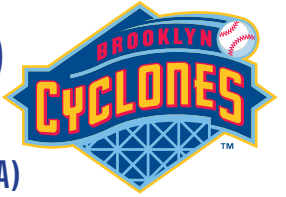

**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn matched its longest winning streak of the season with a rain-shortened 2-1 triumph at Wilmington in 6 innings on Sunday...After an hour and 18-minute delay before the start of the 7th, the game was called due to rain and the threat of further inclement weather...The Cyclones fell behind 1-0 before tying the game on a DH **D'Andre Smith** double in the 5th and taking the lead on a RF **Jeffrey De Los Santos** ground out in the 6th...Smith finished with a multi-hit game...RHP **Austin Troesser** tossed 3.2 innings in his Cyclones and High-A debut, allowing 1 run on 1 hit...RHP **Jawilme Ramirez** posted 2.0 scoreless innings of relief to earn the win.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY:** On August 20, 2007, Brooklyn scored the game's only run on a 1st inning RBI single by 2B **J.R. Voyles** in a 1-0 win vs. Staten Island...RHPs **Dylan Owen** (6.0 IP), **Stephen Clyne** (2.0), and **Eddie Kunz** (1.0) united on a 6-hitter in the win...In 2009, RHP **Colin McHugh** tossed 7.0 innings of 4-hit, shutout ball to win in a 4-3 triumph at State College...In 2013, 1B **Matt Oberste** broke a scoreless tie with a 2-run single in the 7th in a 2-0 win vs. Staten Island...LHPs **Dario Alvarez** (5.0 IP), **Juan Urbina** (2.0), **Paul Paez** (1.0), and RHP **Johnny Magliozzi** (1.0) combined on a 5-hit shutout...In 2015, Brooklyn tied the game with 2 run-scoring ground outs in the 9th before scoring 2 in the 11th on a 1B **Zach Mathieu** double and a walk-off hit-by-pitch of LF **Pedro Perez** to win 4-3 vs. Lowell.

**WINNING IN WILMINGTON:** Brooklyn matched their longest winning streak of the season at 4 in a 2-1, rain-shortened triumph at Wilmington on Sunday...The Cyclones have now won 7-of-their-last-8 games since Sunday, August 11...The 7-1 mark is the best record at the High-A level since that date...Brooklyn won 4-straight games 3 times earlier this season: April 20-24 at Jersey Shore and vs. Wilmington, May 3-7 vs. Aberdeen and at Rome, and May 18-22 at Bowling Green and vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones had not won 5-of-6 games in a series since July 4-9, 2023, at Wilmington...Brooklyn has not won 5-consecutive games since July 3-7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and at Wilmington...The road series win was the Cyclones' first since taking 4-of-6 at Asheville from August 22-26, 2023.

**WENN IN BROOKLYN:** RHP **Jack Wenninger** suffered the defeat in his first start at the High-A level, but has quickly figured things out at the classification since...After tossing 5.0-plus innings of shutout ball for his first High-A win last Tuesday, the 22-year-old is a 1-0 with a 1.31 ERA (3 ER in 20.2 IP) and 1 hold in his last 5 appearances (4 starts) since July 14 at Wilmington...Wenninger has surrendered 15 hits and 9 walks while striking out 27 in that span...The Barrington, Ill. native is 5th in the South Atlantic League (min. 20.0 IP) in ERA (1.31), 10th in batting average against (.192), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (27) in that time.

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 25-year-old clubbed a go-ahead three-run home run in the 6th inning last Thursday in Wilmington and powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the 9th vs. Rome on July 28...6 of his 7 home runs since returning from Double-A Binghamton tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the All-Star break, Omar is tied for 2nd in the league in triples (2), home runs (6), and runs scored (17). 3rd in slugging (.550), tied for 4th in total bases (44) and RBI (16), 6th in OPS (.883), and tied for 6th in extra-base hits (10)...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still 7th in the South Atlantic League for the year with 36 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's then-single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (73) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is 2nd in the South Atlantic League (73) and is tied for 5th across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (145).

**LOUIS LOUIS:** LHP **Gregori Louis** joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...Over 20 appearances in the Florida State League, the 21-year-old tallied a 4-0 record with a 1.49 ERA (7 ER in 42.1 IP), 2 saves, 24 walks, and 44 strikeouts...Since June 2 at Dunedin, Louis has allowed only 3 earned runs over 35.0 innings...The left-hander holds a 3-0 mark with a 0.77 ERA, 19 hits, 16 walks, and 38 K's in those 16 relief outings.

**COMEBACK 'CLONES:** Brooklyn erased another multi-run 9th-inning deficit last Saturday en route to a 5-4 win at Wilmington...Since the All-Star break, the Cyclones have won 3 games when trailing after 8 innings after falling to do so before that...Brooklyn also came back from 5-0 down in the 9th to win 6-5 vs. Jersey Shore in 10 innings on July 19 and erased a 6-4 deficit in the 9th in a 7-6 win vs. Rome...The Cyclones have won 8 games in their final at-bat since returning from the break...Since the break, Brooklyn is 16-11, tied for the most wins in the South Atlantic League with Bowling Green, Greenville, and Hudson Valley.

**MORABITO BITE:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The McLean, Va. native is tied for 9th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (50)...Morabito is 1-of-4 players in MiLB with 50 or more runs scored, walks, and stolen bases...High-A Eugene OF **Jonah Cox**, Double-A Biloxi OF **Dylan O'Rae**, and High-A Tri-City INF **Caleb Ketchup** are the others...Morabito is the only one of the 4 to hold a batting average over .300 (.304)...With 2 swipes (39) last Thursday, he broke OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (89), is 2nd in stolen bases (39), tied for 3rd in games played (79), 6th in batting average (.282), and tied for 6th in runs scored (50)...The former 2nd-round selection is 4th in the SAL in stolen bases (39) 7th in batting average (.282), and 8th in hits (89) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.305), stolen bases (50), on-base percentage (.395)...He is also tied for 1st in hits (120), tied for 2nd in runs scored (64), 3rd in total bases (150), and tied for 3rd in triples (4).

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the

**vs. JERSEY SHORE:** The Cyclones return home to open their penultimate homestand of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws have 4 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF **Aidan Miller** (1), INF **Bryan Rincon** (10), RHP **Wen-Hui Pan** (20), and OF **Emaarion Boyd** (23)...Rincon is currently on the injured list...The Cyclones are 9-12 against the BlueClaws this season and only 3-6 at Maimonides Park...Since moving to the full-season level in 2021, Brooklyn leads the all-time series against Jersey Shore, 55-49 (.529).

last few weeks...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit and all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (98)...The 98 strikeouts are also 8th in the circuit overall...Tong also leads the SAL in batting average against (.218), is 2nd in ERA (3.70), 3rd in WHIP (1.30), and tied for 9th in innings pitched (75.1) since that date...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 90.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is 1st in FIP (2.19), 3rd in strikeout rate (34.4%), 7th in strikeouts (134), and 8th in strikeout-to-walk rate (23.8%)...Since 2021, Tong's 134 strikeouts are the 8th-most in a season by a New York Mets farmhand...RHP **Dominic Hamel** was the most with 160 K's at Double-A Binghamton in 2023.

**TO SMITH-EREENS:** UT **D'Andre Smith** has been blasting the ball across the diamond since returning from the 7-day injured list on July 22...The 23-year-old has 4 multi-hit games during a 9-contest on-base streak dating back to the opening game of August 7's doubleheader vs. Hudson Valley...In that span, Smith is hitting .375/.394/.469 with a .863 OPS, 3 doubles, 3 RBI, and 2 stolen bases...The 23-year-old is hitting .281/.303/.375 in 19 games since being reinstated but has hit another gear since the calendar flipped to August...In 12 games this month, Smith is batting .366/.395/.512 with a .907 OPS, 3 runs scored, 3 doubles, a home run, 5 RBI, and 2 steals...The former 5th-round pick is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.366) and 7th in OPS (.907) during August (min. 40 PA).

**NONE SHALL PASS:** The Cyclones' bullpen had a 17.2-inning streak without allowing an earned run snapped with DH **T.J. White's** solo home run in the 3rd inning last Thursday...The stretch began in the 4th inning on August 10 vs. Hudson Valley...The 'Clones bullpen did not allow a hit in 11.0 consecutive innings with 19 strikeouts from SS **George Lombard Jr.'s** 2-out single in the 8th inning on August 10 until 1B **Roismar Quintana's** single in the 6th inning last Wednesday...RHP **Eduardo Herrera**, LHP **Ryan Ammons**, RHP **Jordany Ventura**, and RHP **Alan Perdomo** also combined to retire 22 hitters in a row from one out in the 9th inning on August 10 until 1 out in the 8th inning last Tuesday.

**A DOZEN DONUTS:** Brooklyn's 2-0 win at Wilmington last Tuesday night marked the team's 12th shutout of the year, setting a new single-season franchise record...The Cyclones tied the 2023 squad's franchise record with its 11th shutout in July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones had blanked Wilmington in consecutive matchups and had thrown 21.1 consecutive scoreless frames against them dating back from the fifth inning on July 13 until the first inning on Wednesday...The 12 shutouts are two behind Rome and Hudson Valley (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League.

**EXTRA! EXTRA!** The Cyclones' offense picked up 7 extra-base hits in last Thursday's 8-5 win at Wilmington...The 7 extra-base knocks (6 doubles and a home run) were the most for Brooklyn in a single game since tallying 8 (6 doubles and 2 home runs) in an 8-5 win at Jersey Shore on August 25, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' record for extra-base hits in a game is 10, accomplished on June 24 and July 10, 2010 vs. Hudson Valley and State College, respectively...The 6 doubles in Thursday's game were a season-high for the club and the most since that 6-double performance on August 25, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The franchise mark since 2005 is 7, accomplished three times, most recently on August 3, 2015, at Lowell.

**IT'S A WALK-OFF:** For the 4th time in 10 home games, Brooklyn earned a walk-off victory thanks to 3B **Jacob Reimer's** 2-run single in the bottom of the 7th in Game 1 of August 7's double-dip with Hudson Valley...In the Cyclones' previous home game, on July 28 vs. Rome, 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying 2-run home run in the 9th before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS **William Lugo** and OF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the 6th inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off home run of the season...3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins in those 10 home affairs on July 19, via C **Chris Suero's** game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.63% of all defeats, including 26.09% of all road losses, while earning 12 walk-off wins...30 of Brooklyn's 245 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.24%).

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (27), and RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (10), Báez (14), OF **Nick Morabito** (19), Reimer (20), and Wenninger (30).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his first High-A victory last Tuesday night at Wilmington...Did not allow a run on 2 hits over 5.0 innings...Struck out 8 without issuing a walk...Plunked a batter... Threw 79 pitches and 48 strikes (60.76%)...Relieved by LHP **Ryan Ammons** with a runner at 1st and nobody out in the bottom of the 6th and Brooklyn leading 2-0...Bequeathed runner did not score...Wenninger, Ammons (2.2 IP), and RHP **Eduardo Herrera** (1.1) combined on a 2-hit shutout in the Cyclones' 2-0 win over the Blue Rocks...The shutout was Brooklyn's franchise-record setting 12th of the season.

**PROSPECT RANKINGS:** Wenninger is ranked as the New York Mets' No. 27 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 30 by MLB Pipeline.

Wenninger has surrendered 15 hits and 9 walks while striking out 27 in that span...The Barrington, Ill. native is 5th in the South Atlantic League (min. 20.0 IP) in ERA (1.31), 10th in batting average against (.192), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (27) in that time.

**FLORIDA STATE FIRE:** Wenninger was among the best pitchers in the Florida State League prior to joining the Cyclones on July 8...At the time of his promotion, the 22-year-old ranked second in the FSL in strikeouts (89)...Wenninger was also tied for fifth in innings pitched (71.2), seventh in WHIP (1.26), eighth in batting average against (.238), and ninth in ERA (5.02)...He was also first in xFIP (3.06), third in strikeout rate (28.7%) and strikeout-to-walk rate (21.3%), sixth in walk rate (7.4%).

**2023:** Wenninger signed with the Mets for \$225,000 on July 14...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 22...Tossed a scoreless inning of relief, striking out one, that day at the FCL Cardinals...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 5...Started vs. Daytona that day...Took a no-decision after allowing two runs on one hit, walking two, and striking out three, in 1.1 innings.

**ILLI-NOISE:** Wenninger had an outstanding final campaign at the University of Illinois, transferring in after spending his freshman season at Murray (Ky.) State University in 2021...During the 2023 season, the Barrington, Ill. native posted a 6-4 record with a 4.59 ERA (41 ER in 80.1 IP), 28 walks (8.30 BB%), and 76 strikeouts (22.55 K%) in 15 appearances (14 starts) for the Fighting Illini...Wenninger was All-Big Ten Second Team in 2023.

**MLB DRAFT LEAGUE:** Prior to being drafted by the New York Mets, Wenninger made three starts for the Williamsport (Pa.) Crosscutters in the MLB Draft League in 2023...The Crosscutters were a former foe of the Cyclones in the New York-Penn League...The 22-year-old accrued an 0-1 mark with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP), seven walks, and 19 strikeouts.

**FAMILY TREE:** Wenninger is far from the only member of his family to play collegiate baseball...Jack's grandfather, **Robert Eckl Sr.**, and his uncle, **Robert Eckl Jr.**, both played baseball at the University of Wisconsin...The Badgers' baseball program, however, was discontinued following the 1990-91 school year.
