



PINSTRIPE PRIDE: JACE AVINA ADJUSTING WELL TO THE YANKEES WAY

The Renegades welcomed a new face to the squad on April 17th, and he has proved to be quite the addition. Back in November, Jace Avina was acquired by the Yankees in a trade with the Milwaukee Brewers. The Yankees sent infielder Jake Bauers to Milwaukee in exchange for Avina. It was a tough pill to swallow.

"It was a surprise to me at first," Avina said. "I got a phone call from our farm director with the Brewers, and I didn't know how to take it at first."

It was difficult for the outfielder to grapple with departing the franchise that had believed in his skillset as a teenager. Milwaukee had drafted Avina out of high school in 2021 in the 14th round. After an outstanding career at Spanish Springs High School in the Reno, Nevada

area, Avina faced a difficult decision in 2021 – go to college or turn pro.

He had a full-ride scholarship on the table to stay home and play at the University of Nevada. Avina's mom favored the college route.

"She wanted me to get my education at first," Avina said. "My dad was super into the idea that you get this opportunity to be a professional baseball player, you might as well just take it. The big deciding factor was that the Brewers actually offered me school money. That was the big thing, knowing I could go back whenever and let's just get my career started."

Milwaukee signed Avina for over \$250,000, money typically given to sixth-round draft picks.

At 19 years old, he began his professional career in rookie ball with the ACL Brewers in 2022. His first season was a resounding success, hitting .294 with



10 home runs, 29 RBIs, and 27 runs scored in 36 games. This performance earned him Arizona Complex League MVP. His 10 home runs, .630 slugging percentage, and 1.066 OPS led the league, and following the season, he was named an Organization All-Star by MiLB.com.

Adjusting to life away from home for the first time, Avina was grateful to be close to home during his first season.

"It was very nice," Avina said. "It was easy for my parents to fly down, only an hour and a half flight there. My dad, my brother, and my mom would come down about once a month to spend the whole week there, and it was awesome to have their company and to have their support. It's a true blessing that I have them as my family."


In his second pro season in 2023, Avina made the transition to the Single-A Carolina Mudcats, where he moved across the country for the first time.

"Having to deal with not having my family close by, that was the big thing," Avina said. "Dealing with the humidity there was very different as well. In Reno and Arizona, it's very dry weather. So having to get used to that humidity was a challenge."

Avina struggled early in the year, but picked up speed as the season went on, hitting 22 doubles and 14 home runs, driving in 50 runs, and walking 56 times in 99 games. Just over two months after the season concluded, the 20-year-old was traded to the Yankees. He got his first opportunity to appear with his new club on April 17, when he was activated from the 7-day Injured List, where he began the season after an injury suffered in spring training. In Hudson Valley, Avina is off to an excellent start. Through 10 games with the team, he is 10-for-33 (.303) with a .439 OBP and a .863 OPS. Avina is currently ranked as the Yankees No. 29 prospect by MLB Pipeline. It hasn't taken long for Avina to feel comfortable.

Renegades hitting coach Rick Guarno notes that beyond his contributions at the plate, he has made a huge difference in the locker room, too: "Jace just brings such an energy to the dugout, to the lineup. What he brings emotionally is such a big lift for the guys. Additionally, obviously, he's been hitting, which is kind of what we expected ... we [the Yankees] wanted him for a reason. There's a lot of ability there, a lot of talent."

"The coaching staff here at Hudson Valley is amazing," Avina said. "My teammates are awesome as well. Just having a great group of guys here really makes me feel like I fit in. The Yankees organization is really good with their hitting department. They're honestly really good all around. I just love being a Yankee. It's awesome."

ZAK WASSERMAN BACK WITH YANKEES IN NEW ROLE AS EX-PLAYER CONTINUES COACHING CAREER

Zak Wasserman has coached at all levels of baseball. From JUCO to Division-1, he's seen the national pastime from a vast array of perspectives. This season, Wasserman is getting to coach in the minors for the first time, working as a defensive coach for the Renegades. He's cherishing the opportunity.

"When I was in junior college, I was also an admissions rep at the same time. I had to double dip to make ends meet. The best part of this job is to come out and be a part of baseball every single day."

Prior to his coaching career, Wasserman was a successful player who reached the minor leagues. In 2013, Wasserman graduated from the University of Louisville following a successful career as a two-way player. He was signed

by the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2014, and pitched for them in rookie ball that season.

While playing for the AZL Diamondbacks, Wasserman met current Renegades pitching coach Spencer Medick, marking the beginning of a long friendship.

"Spencer and I have been friends for about a decade now," Medick said. "We have lived together for multiple offseasons, trained together, played together. He's one of my best friends to this day. So getting the chance to not only be in the same organization as him, but also being at the same affiliate, it's been awesome."

After a season in the Diamondbacks organization, Wasserman played for three years with the Windy City Thunderbolts of the Frontier League, before being signed by the Yankees in 2016. While with Rookie-level Pulaski that year, Renegades manager Nick Ortiz coached Wasserman, signifying another connection to this Hudson Valley staff.

In 2018, Wasserman began his coaching career with Lake Michigan College, where he coached until 2022. This time was a tremendous learning experience for him.

"That's where I really learned how to work," Wasserman said. "As a junior college coach, you don't have a ton of resources and a ton of money to be able to pay assistants. You kind of have to learn how to do everything. I fell in love with this side of the game, and it taught me how to handle the curveballs that the game throws at you. One of the things that it's taught me, not just in baseball but in life, is to learn how to roll with the punches."

In 2022, Wasserman joined Xavier University as an assistant coach in his hometown of Cincinnati. It proved to be a very successful tenure with the Musketeers, as the program went to the Nashville Regional Finals in the 2023 NCAA Tournament and won the BIG EAST Championship.

Following the 2023 season, it was time for Wasserman to take the step up to professional baseball. In his position with Hudson Valley, Wasserman is primarily assigned to improving run prevention.

"My job specifically is catered to the outfield," Wasserman said. "So I go back through the night before and create a catalog of plays to help increase our ability to go out and grab more balls. I also want to make sure guys are getting good reads in batting practice, and they're prepared with the groundball chart and spray chart of the opposition."

After a long journey back to minor league baseball, Wasserman feels grateful to not only be coaching for an affiliate, but to be coaching for the Yankees.

"I'm very blessed that now I get to do it in pinstripes," Wasserman said.



YES-SERNA! FROM UNDERDOG TO TOP DOG, JARED SERNA KEEPS PERFORMING

Jared Serna signed with the Yankees out of Mexico in July of 2019, when he was just 17 years old. At a prospect showcase while enrolled in an academy that summer, Serna caught the attention of the Yankees organization, and signed with New York.

The excitement of this moment faded away quickly, however. Less than eight months later, as Serna prepared for his first professional season, COVID-19 changed the world. The Minor League Baseball season was canceled, and Serna left to wait anxiously to get his first crack in baseball in the US.

As the 2020 minor league season nonexistent, Serna dealt with a brutal situation. Living at home in Mexico, the Yankees signee had to find a place to train in order to maintain baseball shape. The question was, where was that

actually possible during a pandemic?

"It was very difficult because a lot of baseball fields were closed and if they found you there, the police would kick you out," Serna said. "I would go to these batting cages, to these establishments, where I would speak to the owner personally and just ask, 'Can you give me this chance to work out? I'm trying to prepare for the pros."

Serna credits his father with keeping him fresh as well during the height of the pandemic. He would take his son through batting practice, hit him groundballs, and walk him through fitness drills.

Fortunately for Serna, the Renegades infielder made the most of his situation and is off to a roaring start professionally, after finally debuting in 2021. Serna had a promising debut in 2022, and had a tremendous breakout campaign in 2023. Across 122 games between Tampa and Hudson Valley, Serna hit 19 home runs had 79 RBIs. His 144 hits, 90 runs scored, and 235 total bases were the best marks among all Yankees farmhands in 2023, and his 28 doubles ranked second in the Yankees system.

"The fact that the Yankees trusted me and were able to sign me, it's been so great," Serna said. "I'm very thankful to the organization for giving me this opportunity."

Serna began playing baseball when he was three years old, as he was introduced to the sport by his father and grandfather. When the 21-year-old was a teenager, Serna dropped out of school to fully pursue pro baseball. He enrolled in a baseball academy in Monterrey, located in the state of Nuevo León in Mexico.

In the summer of 2019, the academy hosted a showcase for their prospects, attended by scouts from all over MLB. Following an impressive performance there, the Yankees were impressed with Serna, and signed him that July.

The experience of playing baseball in Mexico still holds a strong impression on Serna. During the minor league offseason, he has made it a routine to return home to play in the Mexican Pacific Winter League. The atmosphere at a baseball game is one that isn't easy to forget.

"Simply said, it's very different," Serna said. "Over here, it feels like the fans are kind of reserved as opposed to Mexico. Back home, it's a party. Let's get the beer. Let's make a live atmosphere. Let's cause a ruckus."

Baseball in Mexico is also meaningful for Serna because of a strong familial connection. His cousin Luis, about two years younger, is currently playing in the Yankees system. During the pandemic, Luis and Jared worked out together back home, continuing to grow a strong relationship.

Luis Serna was signed in May 2021 by New York, and has developed as a promising prospect in his own right. The 19-year-old is currently playing with the Tampa Tarpons.

"It's been great being close to my cousin," Serna said. "His pitches are nasty. He's a good guy, and I'm very proud of him. I'm super enthusiastic to be going through this process with him, and I can't wait for him to move up."

After a tremendous breakout performance in Tampa in 2023, Serna was called up to Hudson Valley on August 8th. Beginning this season in High-A, this is the second time around with the Renegades for the season. He feels very at home here.

"I feel great vibes from the dugout to the great fans out in the Hudson Valley," Serna said. "The energy that they bring, they're always ready to go. There's just great energy in the dugout as well as the clubhouse."

A BASEBALL LIFE: WOODLEY THRIVING IN YEAR TWO WITH YANKEES

Defiance College was Derek Woodley's home for 15 years. Located in Northwest Ohio, the D-III school was where Woodley was the head baseball coach, compiling over 300 wins during his tenure and two conference coach of the year honors.

After coaching in small college baseball for three decades, Woodley got his opportunity to take the next step in 2023, joining the Yankees organization as a defensive coach. He is grateful every day to have this position.

"It's just a great organization," Woodley said about the Yankees. "It's the best professional organization in all of sports. For me, it's about the coaching. Being able to interact with these players on a daily basis, hopefully having an impact on them daily, whether it's on the field or off the field, it's special."

Woodley began his coaching career at his alma mater Bethany Lutheran College in Mankato, MN. While coaching there in the early 2000s, Woodley began an intriguing new endeavor that would help lead him down his current path. A friend of the family, Bob Gebhard, was the assistant GM for the St. Louis Cardinals. He asked Woodley if he was interested in trying scouting.

"I said sure I'll try it, so it was a part time scout deal," Woodley said. "Basically if i saw anybody in my area, I'd recommend them. Because at the time I wondered if I wanted to be a full time scout. I just ended up being in college the rest of my career until now, but it was a good intro to professional baseball for sure."

During the summer from 2000-2003, Woodley had the chance to further build his experience, coaching for Mankato's team in the Northwoods League, a collegiate wood-bat summer league. Top collegiate prospects would travel there to compete during the offseason, giving Woodley a chance to coach promising players while also scouting.

"It was a really neat experience," Woodley said. "One, it gave me some confidence because guys responded to me pretty well from a coaching standpoint, and two, obviously to see that talent level was different from where I was coaching. I was able to get an idea of separating players. No offense, but I was coaching small college baseball. I wasn't sure who the D-1 guys were and who the pro guys were. It helped me better evaluate."

Woodley transitioned to Defiance in the late 2000s, wearing a number of hats during his time there. It was a lot to manage, but the experience was important for Woodley.

"I think that time there really helped me grow as a coach," Woodley said. "It was a difficult role, don't get me wrong. You're trying to recruit. You're trying to coach. You're trying to mentor young coaches. I still don't believe it was a job. It was a passion of mine. Athletics is a passion of mine."

From 2019 to 2023, Woodley also served as the athletic director at Defiance. While in that role during the COVID-19 pandemic, he began to realize he needed a change of pace.

"I used coaching as my relief from the administrative duties," Woodley said.

Now in his second season with the Renegades, Woodley works primarily with catchers and coaches baserunning. With Woodley in charge of baserunning, Hudson Valley stole 185 bases in 2023, the second most in team history. After years of coaching in the lower levels of baseball, Woodley is living the dream working for the Yankees.

"Again, I said I haven't had a real job in my life," Woodley said. "I'm not sure this is a real job either. It's just so fun to be here. I get to wake up every day, put on pinstripes, and come to the ballpark. Is there anything better?"

Serving the Hudson Valley community is an essential part of the Hudson Valley Renegades mission, and the organization would not be here celebrating 30 years without your support. Each year, the award-winning Renegades Community Program presented by Westchester Medical Center Health Network (WMCHealth), gives back multitudes to our entire community. In 2024, the Renegades are rolling out another season filled with giving back to the Hudson Valley.

Youth Field Betterment Program

The first is the Youth Field Betterment Program, presented by Heritage Financial Credit Union. Each year, front office and Heritage Financial Credit Union representatives come together to renovate a local Little League field. This year's recipient of a renovated field is Lee Town Recreation Park of the East Fishkill Babe Ruth League.

The field was chosen for its ability to provide access to baseball and a place to develop valuable life skills for children throughout the Hudson Valley. The focus of East Fishkill Babe Ruth is on more than just baseball as they seek coaches and volunteers who can set positive examples and act as role models throughout the season and beyond for the children playing.

East Fishkill has also opened its enrollment to children from neighboring communities with baseball programs that have seen their enrollment numbers decline to the point of limiting their ability to continue their programs so that all children have a place to play.

The Youth Field Betterment refurbishment of Lee Town Recreation Park will allow East Fishkill Babe Ruth to continue to provide an enjoyable experience to every child who wants to learn and play the game of baseball from the levels of T-Ball through 13U in both recreational teams and local travel teams.

HOPE Week

2024 also marks the return of HOPE Week presented by WMCHealth, a Yankees community service initiative. Each Yankees minor league affiliate carries out its own HOPE Week, which stands for Helping Others Persevere and Excel. This is the 11th season in which all Yankees affiliates have hosted HOPE Week, continuing a valued tradition. The Renegades HOPE Week will be taking place June 25-30.

On every day of that week, Renegades players, coaches and front office staff will go out in the community and donate time to making the Hudson Valley a better place. In the past few years, the Renegades have executed events at the Castle Point VA hospital, the Fishkill Food Pantry, and the Maria Fareri Children's Hospital at MidHudson Regional Hospital.

The organization that the Renegades are honoring are also brought out to that night's game at Heritage Financial Park to both bring a rewarding experience to those doing good in our community, but also to raise awareness for the causes they are fighting for.

Disability, Dream and Do (D3) Camp

Hudson Valley will also be offering the Disability, Dream and Do (D3) Day Camp once again. Since 2017, the Renegades have held a clinic at the ballpark to benefit children with disabilities. The D3 sports camps were created by Dave Clark and Doug Cornfield. Clark was the only pitcher in professional sports history to pitch on crutches, while Cornfield is a former NCAA medal-winning runner at Georgia, whose child was born without arms. Through donations and sponsorships, these camps are free to campers.

D3 camps bring professional players together with children with special needs, who compete in drills and competitive sports. In 2016, Dave Stevens became involved with D3. Stevens was born without legs, playing minor league baseball and college football. With his help, D3 camps expanded across the United States, allowing kids with disabilities to learn to pursue their dreams. This year's edition of the D3 camp at Heritage Financial Park will take place on Saturday, August 3.

These community programs are just a small sampling of the myriad programs that the Renegades offer on top of monetary, in-kind, and time donations made by the club and its staff. For the Gades, creating magical experiences that become life-long memories for the entire community is not something that begins and ends at Heritage Financial Park.

Ortiz begins his first season as the manager of the Renegades in 2024, returning for a second stint with the Yankees organization after spending the past four seasons as the Quality Assurance Coach for the San Francisco Giants. Before serving on Gabe Kapler's staff in San Francisco, Ortiz served a dual role for four seasons in the Yankees system, serving as an Amateur Scout covering Puerto Rico and a Minor League coach. He was an assistant coach for Rookie-level Pulaski in 2016, and managed GCL Yankees West in 2017 and 2019 and Pulaski in 2018. His Pulaski roster featured six future Major Leaguers on it, including former Renegades Oswald Peraza, Everson Pereira, Ezequiel Duran and Luis Medina.

In addition to his Major and Minor League coaching experience, Ortiz has coached and managed in the prestigious Puerto Rican Winter League for the Gigantes de Carolina and the Cangrejeros de Santurce, a league in which he played in for 16 seasons (1991-93, 1996-2007 and 2012) and was a six-time All-Star.

He began his coaching career after a 15-year playing career in Minor League Baseball, playing all four infield positions in the Boston, Montreal, Cleveland, Los Angeles-NL, Kansas City, Chicago-NL, and Yankees organizations. Ortiz also played for the Puerto Rican National Team in 2010 at the Central American and Caribbean Games. He was drafted in the 34th round of the 1990 First-Year Player Draft by the Red Sox out of Cidra High School in Cidra, Puerto Rico.

Code of Conduct




In order to provide a welcoming experience for all, the Hudson Valley Renegades have implemented a Fan Code of Conduct. Out of respect for fellow guests, players, coaches, and ballpark staff, all guests are prohibited from...

- Trespassing on the playing field at any time
- Interfering with baseballs that are in play
- Throwing or tossing objects
- Using foul, obscene or derogatory language (see below) or gestures
- Misusing or overconsuming alcohol, Including underage consumption
- Behaving in a manner that is disruptive, unruly, or abusive
- Accessing areas of the ballpark without a proper ticket, pass, or credential
- Misuing tickets, passes, or credentials in any way
- Bringing prohibited items into the ballpark

Derogatory language is defined as offensive language concerning a person's race, ethnicity, gender, religion, disability, age, sexual orientation, or national origin. Anyone using such language is subject to automatic ejection from the ballpark.

Violations of the Fan Code of Conduct will not be tolerated and may lead to ejection from the ballpark, a ban on attending future games, or other consequences. Guests who are found to have used derogatory language will be ejected from the ballpark.

Guests are encouraged to report violations of the Fan Code of Conduct to the nearest ballpark staff member. This can be done in person, at the nearest Quest Services location, or directly with Ballpark Security.
