LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox were shutout by the Hartford Yard Goats by an 8-0 final on Wednesday evening. Hartford plated two runs in the bottom of the first against Bowie starter Seth Johnson, who went just two innings. The Yard Goats did most of their damage in their six-run bottom of the fourth, capped off by a Benny Montgomery grand slam. Relievers Trey McGough and Kyle Virbitsky combined for three shutout innings out of the Baysox bullpen, while Houston Roth struck out five in 1.2 innings of one-run ball. Despite collecting 8 hits, including multi-hit games from Samuel Basallo and Dylan Beavers, the Baysox went 0-for-13 with runners in scoring position and left 14 stranded on base.

A GLANCE AT THE GOATS

The Hartford Yard Goats are coming off a 57-76 campaign in 2023, finishing last overall in the Northeast division. The Baysox took two of three from the Yard Goats at Dunkin' Park to open last season in the only meeting between the two teams. The Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, Hartford is led by first-year skipper Bobby Meacham. The Yard Goats roster includes four of the Rockies' top-six prospects, per MLB Pipeline - 2B Adael Amador (No. 1 COL), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 3 COL), IF/OF Sterlin Thompson (No. 5 COL), and OF Zac Veen (No. 6 COL).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Southpaw Mason Albright is tonight's projected starter for Hartford. The No. 22 prospect in the Rockies' system, per MLB Pipeline, Albright started last season at Single-A Inland Empire in the Angels organization, but then was dealt to the Rockies in the Randal Grichuck trade in July. He split the remainder of 2023 between Single-A Fresno and High-A Spokane, posting a 2.40 ERA in 30 innings to close out the season. This will be Albright's Double-A debut. He is a native of Frederick, Maryland, home of the former Orioles' affiliate, the Frederick Keys, and went to high school at IMG Academy in Florida. He features a fastball, cutter, changeup and curveball.

FAMILIAR FACES

The Baysox have a couple individuals returning close to home this week. Both IF TT Bowens and first-year manager Roberto Mercado are Connecticut natives. Before joining the Orioles' organization in 2022, Mercado coached for 17 seasons at New Britain High School and led them to three conference championships, while also serving as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He currently resides in the offseason with his family in the Dunkin' Park area. Bowens is a New London native and played four years collegiately at Central Connecticut State, winning a pair of conference championships, before signing with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent, following the shortened 2020 draft.

WAY OF THE K

Baysox pitching is second the Eastern League in strikeouts through the first few games of the season, with 62 of them through five games. The Baysox have accumulated double-digit strikeout totals in each of the first five games this season, with relievers totaling a league-high 38 punchouts.

LOCK UP YOUR VALUABLES

Both the Baysox and Yard Goats have been running rampant with stolen bases in 2024. Bowie (9/9) and Hartford (13/13) lead the league in stolen bases, and are two of four sides that have yet to be caught stealing and have attempted at least seven steals. Bowie has gone 3/3 so far this week, while Hartford has gone a perfect 7/7.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers ended last season on a tear with the Baysox. After hitting .337 with a .443 OBP in August, winning Orioles Minor Leaguer of the Month for his debut month at the Double-A level, Beavers finished strong. His .321 average ranked second-highest in the Eastern League through the final two months of the 2023 season (min 130 PA), while his .417 OBP led the way. The 2022 first round pick out of Cal enters 2024 as the No. 7 prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline.

BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) Samuel Basallo is coming off a monster season. At just 19 years old, the phenom catcher finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season. Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
