ORTIZ SLUGS WALK-OFF GRAND SLAM, COMPLETES COMEBACK WIN OVER HOOKS:

Abimelec Ortiz crushed a walk-off grand slam and the Frisco RoughRiders scored seven in the bottom of the ninth inning to stun the Corpus Christi Hooks 12-9 on Wednesday afternoon from Riders Field. Down by four in the bottom of the ninth, the Riders (21-14) loaded the bases with no outs. **Tucker Mitchell**, hit an RBI single, **Aaron Zavala** ripped a two-run single and Ortiz crushed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history. In the bottom of the first, Ortiz put Frisco in front with a two-run double to capture a 2-0 lead. Corpus Christi (10-25) then responded in the top of the second when Bryan Lavastida bashed a solo homer, cutting the lead to 2-1. Frisco added insurance in the bottom of the third when Zavala laced an RBI triple to put the Riders up 3-1. The Hooks then scored eight-straight runs from the fourth to the seventh innings. In the top of the fourth, Ryan Wroblewski muscled an RBI triple and Luis Encarnacion rolled an RBI groundout to tie the game 3-3. In the next inning, Pascanel Ferreras reached on an error to score Rowdey Jordan to grab a 4-3 lead. Anthony Sherwin then ripped a double and Wroblewski scored on a wild pitch in the top of the sixth, extending the lead to 6-3. After Frisco's **Keyber Rodriguez** cut Corpus Christi's lead to 6-4 in the bottom of the sixth, Austin Deming cranked a three-run homer in the top of the seventh, stretching the Hooks lead to 9-4. The Riders got one step closer in the bottom of the eighth when **Sebastian Walcott** rifled a solo home run, knocking the Corpus Christi lead to 9-5. Frisco's seven-run ninth and Ortiz's walk-off grand slam secured Frisco's comeback victory. RoughRiders reliever **Florencio Serrano Jr.** (1-1) earned the win, pitching two shutout innings. Hooks reliever Wilmy Sanchez (0-1) picked up the loss, allowing six runs in 1.1 innings. Patrick Halligan, who allowed Ortiz's blast, absorbed the blown save.

HISTORIC OFFENSIVE DAYS:

When the RoughRiders fell to the Hooks 20-14 on Tuesday, they allowed 20 or more runs for the fourth time in franchise history and the first time since 5/1/18 vs. San Antonio (20-4 loss). In that game, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, **Josh Naylor** and **Ty France** all homered for the Missions. The 34 runs were the most combined runs in franchise history and their second time losing while scoring 14 or more runs. It was their first time since 5/16/15 versus Corpus Christi (15-14 loss). The first two games of the series have combined for 55 runs.

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. While on a six-game hitting streak, Ortiz is hitting .520 (13-for-25)/.571/.920/1.491 with four doubles, two home runs and 10 RBIs. On Wednesday, he clubbed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history while driving in six runs. His six RBIs were the most in a game since 2022 (**Josh Stowers**). He is fourth in the Texas League in May average (.375) and OPS (1.132).

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 11 this month, which is fourth in the league and have allowed 14, which is the second-most. Corpus Christi has both hit the most (15) and allowed the most (15) in the Texas League this month.

NO-HITTER NOTES:

The RoughRiders completed their sixth no-hitter in franchise history on Wednesday. It was the third nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history, the first no-hitter since **Joe Wieland** no-hit San Antonio on July 29th, 2011 at Wolff Stadium and the fourth no-hitter against San Antonio in franchise history. It was also the third combined no-hitter in franchise history and first since **Neftali Feliz** and **Trey Hodges** no-hit San Antonio in six innings on August 19th, 2008 at Wolff Stadium.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .339 (19-for-56)/.465/.607/1.072 over his last 17 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (27) and is third in OBP (.434) while leading the league in walk rate (23.9 percent), a mark which also ranks fifth in Minor League Baseball (min. 100 PA). He is currently on a nine-game hitting streak, batting .438 (14-for-32)/.550/.719/1.269 with 15 runs scored, a double, a triple, two home runs, 10 RBIs and eight walks. In May, he is hitting .389/.500/.639/1.139, ranking second in average and third in OPS in the Texas League.

HOOKIN CORPUS:

The Riders have played well against the Hooks this season, going 7-4 against the Astros affiliate. On offense, the Riders are averaging 5.5 runs per game with a .739 OPS. **Sebastian Walcott** (3), **Josh Hatcher** (2), **Luis Mieses** (2) and **Abimelec Ortiz** (2) and have all hit multiple home runs against the Hooks this season. Walcott is now hitting .333 (14-for-42)/.451/.595/1.046 against the Hooks.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first six starts, his 1.99 ERA is fifth in the Texas League. It is also the second-best start to a season through the team's first 32 games (min. six games start) recorded franchise history, only trailing **Justin Grimm** in 2012, who had a 1.60 ERA through seven starts. His 3.9 percent walk rate is the best in the Texas League while 7.80 K/BB is also first.



-Attended South Grand Prairie High School, going 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA, striking out 20 over 14 innings in a shortened 2020 season. He was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University.

-Missed a majority of his freshman (elbow surgery for a broken growth plate) and sophomore (torn meniscus) seasons before returning healthy for his junior campaign...as a freshman, was limited to designated hitter duties on the junior varsity team while unable to pitch due to injury

-Signed his professional contract while on vacation with friends and family in Gulf Shores, Alabama, and went kayaking, fishing and jet skiing to celebrate the new contract.

2025 SEASON

-Enters into 2025 in the 5th spot in the rotation.

2024 SEASON

-Stephan began 2024 in Extended Spring Training with a lower back injury before joining the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Made only relief appearece of the season on 7/9 vs. NWA, coming out of the bullpen behind MLB rehabber Tyler Mahle.

2023 SEASON

-In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.

-He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.

-In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.

-Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.

-Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

2022 SEASON

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

-115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).
