OF/2B Jake Fox is batting .315 (17-for-54) with 4 .315 homers, 13 RBI, 11 walks and a .961 OPS against Lansing in 2024.

LHP Matt Wilkinson's 123 strikeouts are the most in the Cleveland organization through 85 team games 123 since 2005. 5-year MLB veteran Triston McKenzie struck out 115 with then High-A Lynchburg in 2017.

Lake County leads the MWL and ranks 3rd in High-A with 447 446 runs (5.3 per game), its most runs through 85 games since the 2007 Captains scored 482 in this span.

LAST TIME OUT: The Captains fell 2-1 to the Lansing Lugnuts on Saturday, going down 3-2 in this week's series and losing 3 straight games.

LHP Matt Wilkins (2-2) picked up the loss, going 5 innings, allowing 1 unearned run in the top of the fourth and 1 unearned run in the top of the 5th,

FOX ON THE RUN: DH Jake Fox, MLB Pipeline's No. 18 Cleveland prospect, recorded his 2<sup>nd</sup> 3-hit game of the season on Saturday. Fox is batting .407 (11-for-27) over his last 7 games. 13 of his 35 RBI and 4 of his 5 home runs this season have come against Lansing.

MOON LANDING: 3B Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, went 1-for-5 with a Little League home run on Thursday, hitting an RBI triple and scoring on a throwing error by Lansing SS Euribiel Angeles.

Mooney is 1 extra-base hit shy of becoming the 4th Captain in franchise history (2003-present) to record 30 XBH and 30 stolen bases in a season.

GENAO AND LATER: SS Angel Genao, MLB Pipeline's No. 11 Cleveland prospect, has hit safely in 23 of his first 29 High-A games, and his 100 hits across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg are tied for 8th in MiLB. He is the only player in MiLB and MLB with a .330+ AVG, 35+ XBH, and 15+ SB this season.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Captains are 29-17 (.644) at Classic Auto Group Park, he 3rd-best home record in the MWL and 9th-best in full-season MiLB. <u>LC has won</u> ts last 6 home series, with their last loss coming to Lansing on April 16-21.

ONE OF THESE NIGHTS: Lake County's 20 runs on July 5 versus Dayton vere tied for the most in High-A this season, matched by Eugene's 20 at Tri-City on June 4. The Captains tallied 4 franchise records and tied a franchise best with 12 runs in the bottom of the 7th

### **TRENDS & NOTABLES**

COOPER (NEVER) TIRES: C Cooper Ingle, MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, leads the Midwest League with a .333 AVG, and ranks and with a .429 OBP

#### CAPTAINS AVG, OBP, AND OPS THROUGH FIRST 85 TEAM GAMES SINCE 2005 (MIN. 235 PA)

THE BATTLE OF TRENTON: RHP Trenton Denholm (8-2) leads the Midwest League in wins (8) and ranks 3rd in the Midwest League in quality starts (7), 3rd in WHIP (1.05), 6th in ERA (3.45) and is 1 of 2 Midwest eaguers to pitch a 7-inning complete game shutout (Game 1, 5/10 vs. Dayton). Denholm is the fastest Captains pitcher to win 8 games since

TRIPLE ENTENTE: INF Alex Mooney, OF Jonah Advincula and OF Guy ipscomb are the 1st Captains trio to steal 20+ bases in Lake County's first 74 team games of a season since 2012. 4 Captains that stole 20+ ags in 74 team games, 1 of them being current New York Mets SS and 4me MLB All-Star Francisco Lindor.

REAL STEAL: The Captains have stolen 149 bases through their first 834games, their most through the first 85 games since at least 2005. Lake County is tied for 3rd in MiLB with an 87.6% stolen base percentage.

NAVAL POWER: LHP Matt Wilkinson eclipsed 100 strikeouts on June 25 ersus Great Lakes, and now ranks 2nd in MiLB with 123 strikeouts this eason. Among Minor League pitchers with 70+ IP, Wilkinson's 14.44 K/9 are the highest since AAA Memphis/Rookie League Johnson City LHP Rick Ankiel posted a 15.8 mark in 2001.

THE ATLANTIC CAMPAIGN: Since 2021, 11 of Cleveland's draft picks have come from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), including 6 in the 2023 MLB Draft. Of those 11 ACC draftees, 5 have played for the Captains this year (LHP Parker Messick, OF Angel Zarate, 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus, C Cooper Ingle, and INF Alex Mooney), with 5 total '23 draftees being Top 30 Cleveland prospects by MLB Pipeline.

PROSPECTING: Cleveland has experienced a gold rush of prospects, with 5 current Lake County Captains and 6 2023 draftees listed among Cleveland's Top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. The latest is C Cooper ngle, who is MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, replacing 2021 Captain and current Triple-A Columbus Clippers SS José Tena, who graduated from prospect status on June 30.

LANSING CONNECTIONS: Lansing Hitting Coach Kevin Kouzmanoff played for Lake County in 2004, and holds the Captains' single-season ranchise records for batting average (.330), hits (156), OPS (.920), and doubles (35, since tied). Lugnuts Pitching Coach Don Schulze pitched parts of 3 seasons for Cleveland from 1984-86. He was traded to Cleveland along with Joe Carter and Mel Hall for Rick Sutcliffe. And ansing RHP Jacob Watters is cousins with Jason Michaels, who played parts of 3 seasons with Cleveland from 2006-08.

**LAST TIME OUT:** On July 9 versus Lansing in the series-opener, **Zach Jacobs** (ND) picked up the no decision, going 3 innings, allowing 1 run on 3 hits while striking out 2 and walking 3 in the 7-6 win in 11 innings. His last run allowed came on an RBI groundout from Lugnuts 2B **Casey Yamauchi** in the top of the 3<sup>rd</sup>.

**AGAINST THE LUGNUTS:** In 5 appearances (1 start) against Lansing, **Jacobs** is 2-0 with an 0.68 ERA, 13 strikeouts and 6 walks. As a reliever, the right-hander has pitched a combined 10.1 scoreless innings against Lansing, allowing just 4 hits and 3 walks, while throwing 11 strikeouts and posting a 2-0 record with 1 hold.

**LAST 10 APPEARANCES: Jacobs** has posted a 3.21 ERA in 28.0 innings over his last 10 appearances since May 24 vs. West Michigan. He is holding opponents to a .170 AVG during this span, while notching 32 strikeouts to just 10 walks.

MIDWEST LEAGUE RELIEVER RANKS: Among MWL relievers with 30+ innings pitched, Jacobs ranks 1st with a 0.76 WHIP, 6th with a 2.36 ERA, and tied for 15th with 41 strikeouts.

**DOUBLE-DIGITS IN '23: Jacobs** went 10-4 with Single-A Lynchburg in 2023, leading the Cleveland player development system and ranking tied for 1st in the Carolina League with 10 wins. <u>Jacobs was Lynchburg's 1st 10-game winner since current Triple-A Columbus Clippers RHP Triston McKenzie won 12, and current Milwaukee Brewers RHP Aaron Civale won 11 in 2017.</u>

TIME IN TARTAN: Jacobs pitched 3 seasons at the University of California, Riverside (enrollment 26,809) from 2020-22. <u>He was recruited by then-UCR head coach and 2002 World Series</u>
<u>Champion pitcher Troy Percival</u>. Jacobs pitched for the former 4-time All-Star before Percival resigned in 2020. In 3 seasons, made 19 starts, going 3-9 with a 4.47 ERA, 86 strikeouts and 22 walks across 116 innings. <u>Jacobs tossed his 1st complete game shutout in his 3rd career start on February 29, 2020 at St. Mary's, striking out 9 and walking none with 3 hits allowed across 9 innings in the 1-0 win.</u>

### CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains have been promoted to MLB during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. In his 1st MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4th player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1st career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1st player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1st MLB pitch on September 2, 2006. Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

**LHP Raymond Burgos:** On Monday, June 24, **LHP Raymond Burgos** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. **Burgos** made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

**INF Angel Martínez:** On Saturday, June 22, **INF Angel Martínez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Toronto Blue Jays. He started at designated hitter and batted 9<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-3 with 1 strikeout. **Martínez** played 77 regular-season games for the Captains in 2022, hitting .288 with 81 hits, 17 doubles, 3 triples, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 10 stolen bases, and an .861 OPS.

**INF/OF Daniel Schneemann:** On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2<sup>nd</sup> base and batted 8<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

**1B/OF Trenton Brooks**: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1<sup>st</sup> base and batted 9<sup>th</sup> in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

**OF Johnathan Rodríguez:** On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, RHP Cade Smith made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
