Right hander Clevari Tejada will take the ball for his sixth start of the season. Last Sunday at Lakeland, Tejada tossed two scoreless innings, setting the tone for a 2-1 Bardenton win. The outing marked Tejada's quickest turnaround this season, toeing the rubber on four days of rest. Throughout the outing, his sinker sat at 93-94 mph and topped out at 95.
